Why use a condom?

HIV can be passed on when blood or semen get into the bloodstream.

But remember...

Condoms can sometimes slip off, or break. Check it now and then, and change it if you need to.

Getting a condom on (and off):



As soon as the penis gets hard place a rolled up condom on the tip.



Squeeze out the air condom (to make room for any cum), and unroll the condom to the base of the penis.



Use plenty of waterbased lubricant such as KY jelly or Bodywise Liquid Silk on the outside of the condom.



onto the base of the condom firmly (to stop any cum leaking), then pull out. Use each condom only once.
