of Great Britain and Ireland Queen Defender of the Faith Empress of India &c.
To Our Trusty and well beloved Arthur Walter Patrick Iman M.B. Gratting.
We reposing especial Trust and Confidence in your Loyalty Ability and good Conduct do by
these Presents Constitute and Appoint you to be an Officer in the Medical
Department of Our Army from the Sixth day of March 1880 A.D. You are
therefore carefully and diligently to discharge your Duty as such in the Rank of Surgeon
or in such higher Rank as We may from time to time
hereafter be pleased to promote or appoint you to of which a notification will be made in the London
Gazette by doing and performing all and all manner of things thereunto belonging. And you are
to serve and follow such Orders and Directions from time to time as you shall receive from Us or
from your superior Officer according to the Rules and Discipline of War in pursuance of the Trust
herby reposed in you.

Given at Our Court at Saint James' the twentieth day of
March 1880 A.D. in the Forty third year of Our Reign.
