## Food and Drugs Act, 1955

In January, 1960, at Menai Bridge Magistrates' Court the Anglesey County Council prosecuted Messrs Arthur Oven & Son, Ltd., Butchers, Llangefni, for selling meat comprising legs of lamb, and pickled beef, alleged to be unfit human consuption, to Neuborough County Primary School.

The charge we respect of the legs of lamb was dismissed, and the firm were fined £30 in respect of the pickled beef.

They were also fined £10 for the publication of misleading advertisement (invoice) in respect of meat supplied to Llangoed County Primary School.

- 1. <u>NEWBOROUCH VILLACE</u>: Individant houses connections to the Public Sever continue to be made.
- <u>BRYNSIENCYN VILLAGE</u>: As in Newborough properties continue to be connected to the new sever.
- <u>STAR, PENMYNYDD</u>: The construction of this scheme was completed and it became operative in March, 1960 to serve the Council's housing estate and several Private properties.
- <u>GAENTER & HOLLAND AR S:</u> The construction of a scheme to serve these two villages was started during the year.
- 5. DIYRAN, MALLTRAETH, HIR ON & BETTEL: Consultations and other preparatory work in respect of these schemes continued during the year.

With regard to the Duyran scheme the consultations are those prior to the commencement of the actual construction, and the Malltracth, Eethel and Hermon are advanced towards the Public Inquiry Stage.

6. <u>LLANFAIRFULL, UPPER VULLACE</u>:- Consultations and other preliminary work proceeded and it was hoped that the contract could be commenced during 1961.

7. <u>LLANDEGFAN</u>:- The Council's consulting engineers are proparing a comprehensive scheme for the severage of most of this parish.

### REFUSE DISPOSAL

Both house and trade refuse is now collected once a fortnight. This more frequent service has been made possible by the purchase and bringing into use during the year of a new Dual-tip Refuse Collector.

There are now two tips available, a new one was, during the year, brought into use at Llangaffo, and which is used during the summer months; the one at Porthanel during the wint r.

Thereois a workman employed fulltime at the tip and the work is, as far as practicable, being carried out in accordance with the recommendations of the Ministry of Health.

Difficulty is experienced in obtaining suitable and sufficient soil or other similar covering material which is considered essential in ensuring a full and proper control of the tipping operation and to prevent possible nuisance, but the best use is being made of the materials available.

# RENT ACT, 1957, - CERTIFICATES OF DISREPAIR

During the year only 2 applications were received for Certificates of Disrepair and 1 was granted, one undertaking given by a landlord to carry out the necessary work was accepted.

Since the Rent Act, 1957, became operative only 14 Certificates of Disrepair have been grontedeto tenants of dwelling-houses within the district, and having regard to the number of houses in the district obviously in need of repair it is difficult to suggest the reason for this The Act had as one of its main objectives the putting into and keeping in repair of rented houses, and I would submit that in the Aethwy area at least it has not produced the desired effect, and whether or not it is due to tenants being unaware of the provisions of the Act, or whether or not the procedure involved is too complicated for them to understand it is difficult to say. The Act also was intended to encourage owners of dwelling-houses to repair their property and receive a fair return on their expenditure.

# Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1960.

OTHER DY AD HOUST OF THE SOUND

The annual survey of caravans and camping sites conducted at the peak period of the holiday season revealed that there were 197 caravans in Aethwy in 1960, some of them sited without Planning Permission. The Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1961 became operative from the 29th August 1960, its main purpose was to introduce a licensing system to be operated by local authorities, to regulate the establishment and operation of caravan sites and secure improved conditions on sited by requiring good standards of layout, equipment and maintenance.

Only one licensed site in Aethwy complies with the standard requirements, but it is hoped that in time all sites will become equipped with the necessary facilities, as undoubtedly a need exists to cater for this type of hooiday which appears to be becoming more popular.
