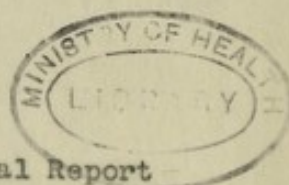

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Gentlemen,

I have the honour to submit to you my Annual Report
for the year ending 31st. December 1925.

All ships arriving were examined for the purpose of
ascertaining their sanitary condition. Seven ships came from
foreign parts :-

2 From OPORTO with slate slabs.

1 From GHENT with Basic Slag.

1 From SUNDSWELL with Timber.

3 From ROSCOFF with Onions.

None of them had a history of disease having occurred on
board during the voyage, and all the crews were in good health
on arrival at Carnarvon Port. No defects were found in the ships;
All parts were clean.

Examination and enquiry as to the presence of rats was done
in every case, but no need of any treatment was found necessary.

No meat, or any kind of food, except onions, is imported
to Carnarvon from foreign ports.

All the coast trade is between Liverpool and Carnarvon.

No vessel from an infected port arrived.

The latrines at the Dock and Harbour were always found
in a satisfactory condition.

Enclosed is an account of the work done by the Sanitary Inspector.
