I have the honour to submit to you my annual report for the year ended 31st December 1952.

No vessel arrived from foreign ports, the trade being mainly reshipments from other ports in the British Isles.

Infectious Diseases. No cases were notified during the year.

Food. No meat or foreign food was imported.

The oyster bed on the Anglesey side of the straits has been discontinued for some time, and remains suitable for further use.

The mussel bed at Tan y Foel has also been discontinued due to the adverse Bacteriological reports.
