NATURAL AND SOCIAL CONDITIONS

The year 1964 brought little variation in the health and livelihood of the townspeople. The town as a health, holiday and tourist resort still retains its popularity.

There is a gradual increase in the number of people who retire to the town at the end of their working life comprising professional people and farmers. An increase in moderate priced new houses would be of advantage to the town to satisfy this demand.

The townspeople were fully employed throughout the year and unemployment of employable men and women was negligible. There is a large amount of part time employment of married women and old age pensioners.

The efforts of your Council to stop the loss of people to the larger areas of population brought no results so far as industrial or other employment of the young people is concerned.

The population of the town varies very little in numbers from the past years and there was no excessive mortality or epidemics and the health of the townspeople was generally good.

Climatological Conditions. The climatological conditions of 1964 were as detailed in the following tabulation which includes comparisions with previous years:-

The winter period at the opening of the year was mostly dry, cold and dull. Snow fell in the middle of February and caused certain transport difficulties. The summer months were changeable May, June and August were the best of the months. The autumn was dry and mild.

Weather conditions could not be said to have any adverse affect on the health of the townspeople.

Occupations. There was no appreciable change in the occupations of the townspeople to that indicated in previous reports. There are a large number of comutors from the surrounding villages and hamlets who are engaged in the Hotels, Offices and Shops. The majority travel by private car, public transport being both inadequate and limited in the number of services.

The holiday and tourist trade of the town had a successful summer season and on occasions the holiday maker failed to obtain accommodation.

SANITARY CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE AREA

WATER SUPPLY.

The purification and clarification of the water, as taken from the River Ithon, was satisfactory throughout the year. Quality was good and quantity sufficient.

The main source of supply remained the River Ithon and purification as previously reported.

Chlorination has been maintained to give a free chlorine content of between 0.2 and 0.5 p.p.m. after 30 minutes contact. Tabulated list of Analyst's Reports are given in Table 3.

It will be noted that at the end of July the sample was reported as being unsatisfactory. Investigations were carried out to trace the source of contamination which was eventually traced to the opening of a sluice valve between old filter beds and Llanfawr Reservoir.

Chemical Analysis No samples for chemical analysis were dispatched during the year.

Waterworks Improvement

The Consulting Engineer appointed to submit a scheme for the improvement of the River Intake Pumping Station submitted his outline scheme in January of the year. The Report recommended the construction of sedimentation tanks and other works of improvement at an estimated cost of £50,420.

The Engineer's Report was forwarded to the Ministry of Housing and Local Government for the observations of the Engineering Department.

At the April meeting of your Finance and General Purposes Committee you decided to proceed with the scheme and to make application to the Radnorshire County Council for a contribution towards the expenditure. Arising from discussion with the Wye River Authority variations were eventually made in the scheme and in the September a scheme estimated to cost £62,400 was submitted to the Ministry and application made for loan consent to borrow this amount.

In the November an Engineer of the Ministry of Housing and Local Government visited the town to investigate the proposals for the modernisation of the Pumping Station.

At the end of the year the approval of the application to borrow was awaited from the Ministry.

Contamination by Lead No direct action has been taken in connection with . contamination by lead. There are five known water service pipes to properties which are in lead tube. Sodium carbonate (Soda Ash) is added to the water before filtration for pH control.

The tabulation shows a decrease on the 1963 figures of 6,240,000 gallons. The consumption is still high as compared with the national average.

No extensions to mains were carried out.

SWIMMING POOL. Theswimming pool operated by the Council was maintained to a satisfactory standard.

The water supply to the pool of 133,000 gallons capacity is taken from the domestic water supply and the pool replenished as necessary. The water is treated by straining and filtration, sterilization being by injection of chlorine. Alkali as sodium carbonate is added as necessary.

The circulation of the pool water is over a period of 10 to 12 hours and from the opening of the pool at 1st June to closing at end of September the filtration plant was kept in continual operation.

Twice daily tests were made with comparator for free chloring and alkalinity. The reports on samples taken for bacteriological analysis are as under:-

OBSERVATIONS: The bacteriological condition of this water was generally satisfactory.

DRAINAGE AND SEWERS.

- 1. Drainage No difficulties were experienced on the sewage systems during the year.
- 2. Sewage Disposal The modernised disposal works was completed by the winter of the year and put into operation.

Rivers and Streams Inspection of rivers and streams in the Urban District were carried out. No action on pollution was necessary.

Public Cleansing (i) The collection and disposal of household refuse has continued on the same principle as other years. No variation in collection of domestic properties once each week and twice each week from certain trade and hotel premises has been necessary.

The difficulties arising at the Incinerator Site due to accumulation of tins, glass and clinker became more aggravated and during the year you approached the neighbouring rural and urban authorities on the possibility of joining together to organise a suitably sited tip where modern equipment could be used for soiling over and controlled tipping properly carried out.

The result of this enquiry brought no satisfactory results. You then advertised in the local press inviting farmers who had low lying ground suitable for reclaiming to come forward. No satisfactory arrangement arose from this investigation.

Enquiries were sent out for the hire of tin balers and disposal of coloured glass with no positive results.

(ii) The collection and sale of salvaged materials comprising waste paper, broken glass, bottles and scrap iron and tins has continued.

During the year you disposed of:-

30 tons 5 cwts. of waste paper 13 tons 5 cwts. of cullett 14 tons 7 cwts. of scrap iron

Common Lodging Houses There are no common lodging houses in the Urban District.

FOOD.

Food Hygiene The enforcement of the food hygiene regulations was carried out by inspection and circulation of posters supplied by the Ministry of Food.

Special inspections were made of the kitchens and food preparation establishments of the four large hotels.

No prosecutions were found necessary.
