Mae'n anrhydedd gennyf gyflwyno i chi yr Adroddiad am y flwyddyn 1962.

Yn gyntaf dymunaf ddiolch a chydabod gwaith rhagorol Meddygon Teuluaidd y Dref a'r cylch, yr Ymelydd Iechyd a'r fydwaig.. Trwy eu llafur a'u gwasanaeth parod bu gyflwr iechyd trigolion y dre mewn safon boddhaol a chanmoladwy.

Ni fu ond deg o ychwanegiad yn rhif y boblogaeth yn ystod 1962. Fe gyrrhaeddwyd y ffigur 3,000 yn 1960, ac yn 1961 cododd wedyn i 3,090. O ganlyniad ceir estyniad mwy sylweddol yn rhif poblogaeth y dre - a chyda cynnydd poblogaeth pob amser daw masnach, gwaith, diwydiant a prysurdeb arbennig i dre ar dyfiant. Teimlir bod y Cyngor yn effro ac yn sylweddoli'r dyfodol newydd hwn ac y ceir ganddynt wasanaeth, gweithrediadau a chynlliniau byw.

Am y tro cyntaf ers 1958 bu ychwanegiad yn rhif y genedigaethau ac er hyn ni fu ychwanegiad i'r rhai a anwyd yn anghyfreithlon. Ni chafwyd un enedigaeth farwanedig. Hefyd ni fu yr un farwolaeth famol a bu darostyngiad yn rhif marwolaethau babanod o dan flwyddoed. Mae hyn i gyd yn gannoladwy iawn.

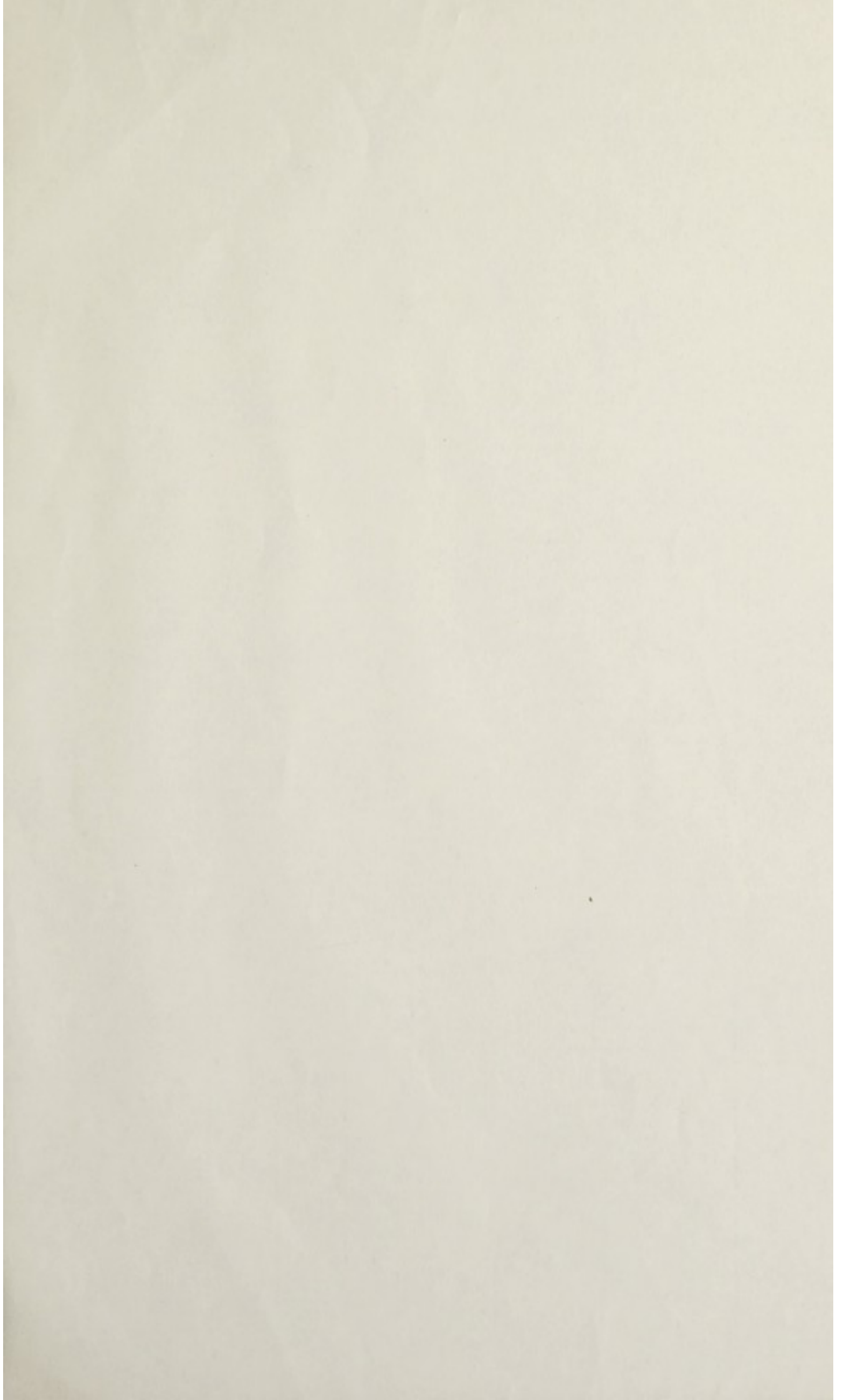
