A macroscopic examination of rats caught is carried out whenever possible by the Medical Officer and Port Health Officers. There were no rats sent for bacteriological examination during the year.

Arrangements have been made, when necessary, for the deratting of ships by means of Hydrogen Cyanide to be carried out by a commercial contractor, Mesars. Hivey Fumigation Co., Ltd., 15 Cheapside, Liverpool.

It has not been found necessary to earry out any rat-proofing of ships during the year.
