SECTION IV - INLAND BARGE TRAFFIC

There is no inland barge traffic within the district.

SECTION V - RATER SUPPLY

- (1) Source of supply for (a) the district upland surface and deep borchole.
 (b) the town's water supply is available at the dockside and is used for shipping.
- (2) Bixteen samples of the mains water supply in the vicinity of the docks were taken during the year by the Parness Water Board for bacteriological examination The results were satisfactory.
- (3) Precentions taken against contamination of hydrants and hosepipes -Hydrants and hosepipes are protected and stored in a water shed when not in use.
- (4) There are no waterboats in use at the Port.

SECTION VI - PUBLIC HEALTH (SHIPS) HEGHLATIONS, 1966

- (1) List of Infected Areas (Regulation 6). A list of infected areas is prepared and amended by the Medical Officer of Health from the official list of infected areas. The list is amended weekly and copies are delivered by hand to H.M. Customs and Excise Officers and Trinity House Pilots.
- (2) Radio Messages. Arrangements have been made with Scaforth Radio Station and the G.P.O., to send and receive messages from ships entering the Port. The Rarbourmaster's office at the Port is equipped with V.H.F., radio and contact with ships about to enter the Port can be made through this medium.
- (3) Notifications otherwise than by Madio (Regulation 14(1)(b)). Telephonic Communication from Shipping Agents.
- (4) Mooring Stations (Regulations 22 to 30).

Within Docks : An inner mooring station near Buceleuch Bridge within Hamiden Dock has been established as a mooring station for all unhealthy ships arriving at Marrow. On arrival of an infected ship or a suspect ship, the vessel is taken to the designated mooring station.

- (5) Arrangements fori-
 - (a) Hospital accommodation for infectious discesses (other than smallpox). rrangements have been made to receive seamen suffering from infectious discase to be admitted to Devonshire Road Isolation Hospital, which is within the Borough.
 - (b) Surveillance and follow up of contacts. The surveillance and follow up of contacts is carried out by the Medical Officer of Mealth and the Public Mealth Inspectors.
 - (c) Cleansing and disinfection of ships, persons, clothing and other articles. Equipment and staff are available to carry out cleansing and disinfection and such work is carried out under the supervision of the Fort Health Officers.

The times of the clinic are as follows:-

The clinic is open daily for advice and treatment.

- (1) Vessels from foreign ports are examined for rodent infestation during routine general inspections and a number are systematically inspected for this purpose as a result of applications for the issue of De-ratting Examption Certificates. Sufficient staff are available to carry out systematic inspections whenever necessary.
- (2) No rodents were sent for bacteriological examination during the year.
- (3) Deratting is carried out in the case of minor rodent infestations by the staff of the department under the supervision of a Fort Health Officer, using poison baits and/or traps. Arrangements have been made for the deratting of ships to be carried out by means of Hydrogen Cyanide, when necessary, by a conmercial contractor, Hivey Fumigation Co., Ltd., 15 Cheapeide, Liverpool.

SECTION XVI - MISCHILAROUS

Arrangements for Dealing with Maritime Dealarations of Mealth

A blank Maritime Declaration of Health Form in handed to the Master of every ship approaching the Port as soon as the Filot boards. On arrival at the Port, the completed form is inspected by the Customs Officer of Port Health Officer, wheever is first aboard.

Boarding of Vessels on Arrival

Vessels arriving from infected areas or when a measage has been received regarding sickness on board are always boarded by a Sustons Officer and Port Health Officer together. Other vessels are usually boarded by a Sustons Officer in the first instance.

Restrictions on Boarding or Leaving Ships

Instructions have been given to the Harbour Authorities, tradespeople and other persons in the habit of visiting ships at the Port to keep clear until the ship is free from control.
