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





# INSPECTION AND SUPERVISION OF FOOD

Forty-nine (49) Samples of "Pasteurised" Milk have been taken during the year. Of these, 46 Samples proved to be satisfactory; the remaining 1 Sample was found to be not efficiently pasteurised. 16 Samples of Ordinary Raw Milk were also taken; 15 Samples proved to be satisfactory, whilst the remaining 5 shewed evidence of B.Coli. # 2... MEAT AND OTHER FOODS

511 visits have been made to the Slaughterhouse and other Food Premises during the year, and 4,878 carcases have been inspected. In all, 5 tons. 5 cwts. 2 qtrs. 44 lbs. of food have been condemned as unfit for human consumption. This weight does not include canned and packeted foods not usually sold by weight.




