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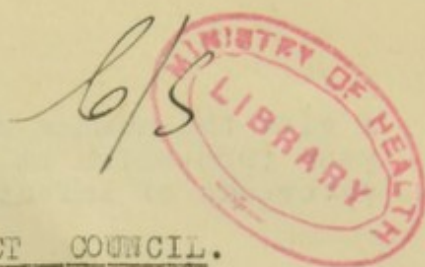

INTERIM REPORT OF THE MEDICAL OFFICER OF HEALTH

Year Ended December, 31st. 1941.

To the Chairman and Members of the Crook and Willington
Urban District Council.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Ministry of Health Circular No. 2604 of March 24th. states that the annual report of the Medical Officer of Health for 1941, is to be prepared on the lines indicated in circulars 2314 and 2067 dated 26th. March, 1941 and 19th. July, 1940, respectively.

I am further instructed not to publish complete tables of local populations nor to make any mention of activities in connection with War time industrial, military or other developments such as extensions to water supply, sewerage works or other public utility undertakings.

The health of the neighbourhood continued to be good during the whole of 1941. There was a marked reduction in the number of cases of measles, diphtheria and scarlet fever. The birth rate is 15.69 as compared with 14.76 the previous year, the death rate on the other hand, is 12.81 as compared with 14.61 the previous year.

I wish to thank all the Council officials for their help, and especially Mr. Omand, Mr. Ayton and Mr. Cummings. I also wish to thank you, Ladies and Gentlemen, for your continued interest and encouragement.
