With the exception of the Medical Officer of Health, these officials are whole-time officers.

Vital Statistics: Area 2,106 acres. Population 4,443. Rateable Value £35,702. Produce of 1d. rate £134 10s. 9d. Separate families 1,125. Separate dwellings

Live Births: Total 47. Males 19. Females 28. Of these four were illegitimate. There was one still-birth, a female child. Birthrate 10.58 per 1,000.

Deaths: Total 51. Males 21. Females 30. Deathrate 11.47 per 1,000. There were no deaths of infants under one year. There were no maternal deaths from causes associated with childbirth. Deaths from Cancer 11, Tuberculosis of all forms 3.

Health Services: There have been no changes in the general provision of Health Services in the area.

Infectious Diseases: The incidence of notifiable Infectious Disease during 1940 was higher than in the previous year.
