I beg to present my Annual Report for the year ended 31st December, 1942.

Vital Statistics: Area 2,106 acres. Population 4,167. Rateable Value £42,020. Produce of 1d rate £178.10.11. Separate Dwellings 1538. Density 2.7 persons per house.

Live Births: Total 88. Males 54. Females 34, of these 9 were illegitimate:- 8 boys and 1 girl. There were 3 stillbirths.Birthrate 21.11 per 1000.

Deaths: Total 53. Males 26. Females 27. There were 6 deaths (5 male and 1 female) of infants under 1 year. Deathrate 12.71 per 1000.
