**LITTLE SARAH.**—Died, at Madron, on Monday, Miss Sarah Roberts, aged 90 years. Deceased, a local celebrity, known generally as "Little Sarah," is supposed to have been the smallest woman in England, and was only 2 feet 10 inches high. Dwarfs, as a rule, are deficient in intellect, but "Little Sarah" was quite an exception; she was an intelligent woman, and, possessed of an extraordinary memory, could relate the time and manner of every local circumstance that had transpired from her childhood to near the end of her long life.—*Cornish Telegraph*.
