"Windsor, Tuesday.—Yesterday evening, after the Queen had retired from the dining-room, a message was sent from the Castle, requesting the attendance of the Liliputian Dwarfs, who were engaged to perform at the Theatre in the Evening and during the present week. This Liliputian Family—consisting of three persons, who stand three feet high; Maria Brockstedt, eighteen years, two feet eight; and their brother Christian, thirteen years, two feet four inches, and who weigh sixteen pounds—were immediately repaired to the Castle, attended by their interpreter, and were ushered into the presence of her Majesty, in the great drawing-room. There were also present his Royal Highness Prince Albert, her Royal Highness the Duchess of Kent, the Royal Highness the Duke and Duchess of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha, their eldest son, the Countess of Wintchester, Lady Stanley Howard, and other distinguished personages. The Dwarfs and the Duchess of Kent conversed with the Dwarfs, and were much amused by their intelligent replies; Brockstedt and his sister afterwards waited before the Royal party, to the great amusement of all present. They afterwards performed a series of dances by command of her Majesty, and returned to the Theatre."
