CONDITION OF SUPPLY

Milk is supplied on condition that it is consumed only by the person or persons mentioned on the Application Form. The permit may be withdrawn if the Milk Officer is satisfied that the milk is not being so consumed or is being wasted.

NOTES :

(1) Keep the top part of this form and give the remainder to your Milk Retailer. You will be asked to sign the appropriate certificate for the milk you have received during each month.

(2) If you move into a new district you must

(a) obtain from your Retailer the lower part of this form ;

(b) sign and date the certificate for milk which you have had and hand it to your Retailer ;

(c) take the whole of the remainder of the lower part of this form to the Milk

Officer at the Food Office in your new district who will issue to you a new permit.

(3) If you are away temporarily proceed as in (2) above. A short period permit will be issued to you and this permit will be endorsed and handed back to you. On your return this endorsed permit should be given to your original Retailer.

(4) Except with the direct permission of the Milk Officer your Milk Retailer must not be changed during the period covered by this permit.

INSTRUCTIONS

(1) To be detached and submitted by the Milk Retailer for certification by the Householder on the last day of the month during which milk was supplied.

(2) To accompany, after certification, the appropriate consolidated claim form to be lodged by the Milk Retailer.

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
