

PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY.

Practically the whole of the houses in the Borough are supplied from the Corporation mains. A few isolated farms and about 5 houses in the built-up areas obtain water from private wells.

The main supply is hard. Galvanised iron service pipes are used and no difficulty is experienced due to plumbo_solvent action.

The supply is constant, and a full supply for domestic purposes was maintained throughout the year, but restrictions were imposed on the use of hose pipes for garden watering, etc. for a period.

The main sources are being Ohlorinated by means of an emergency Ohlorinating Appavatus and the contract for the installation of a permanent Ohlorination Plant was commenced during the year.
