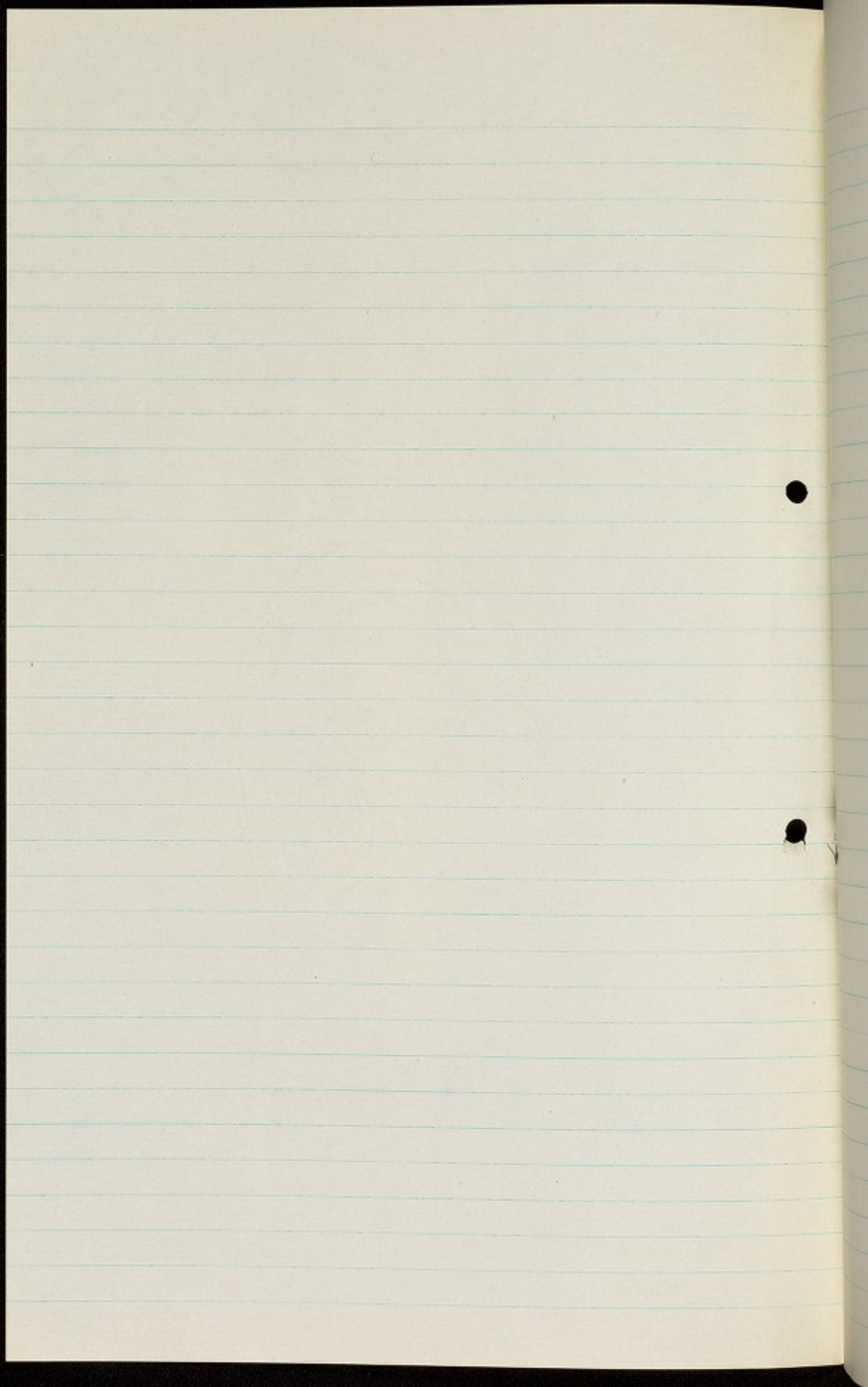

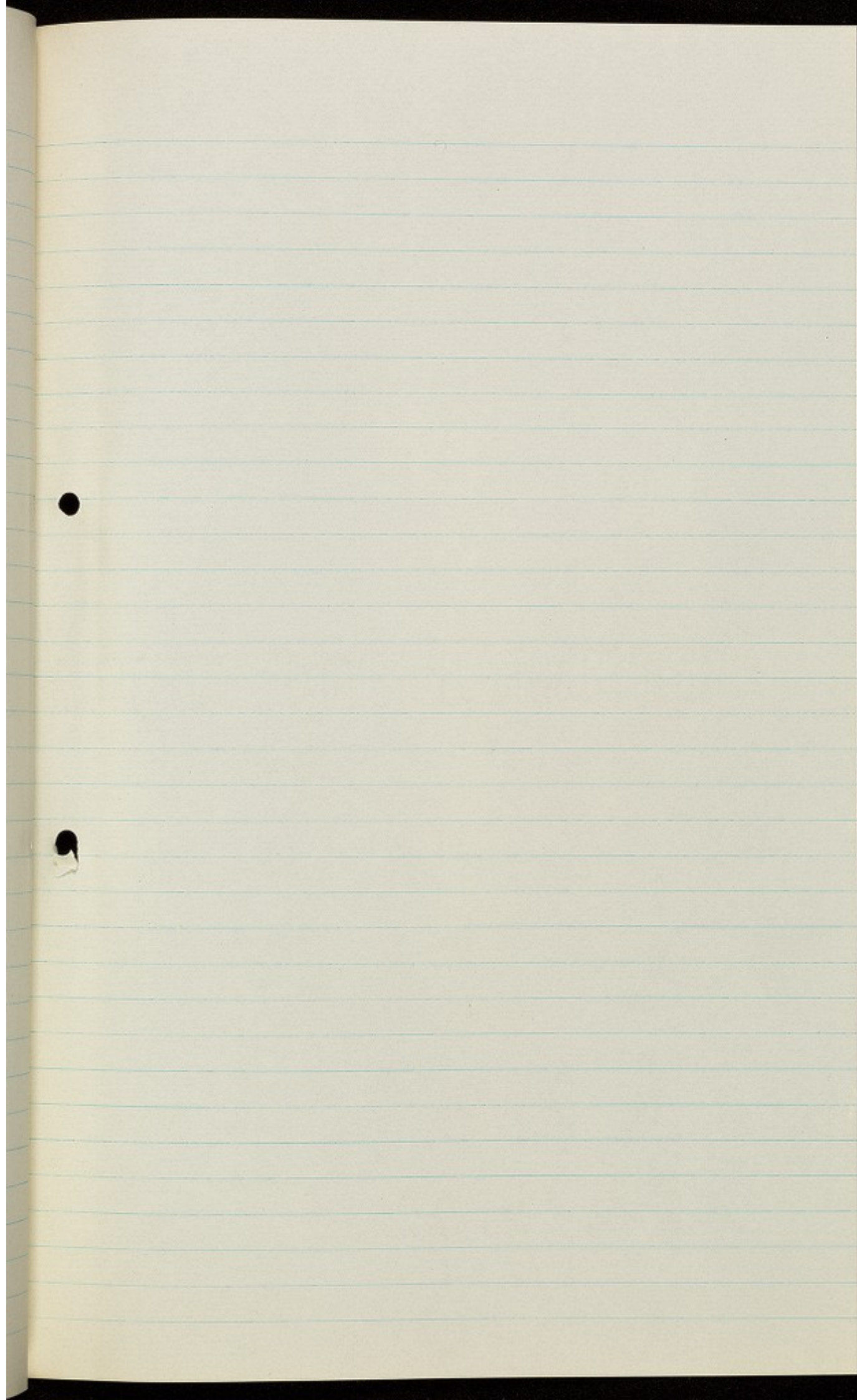

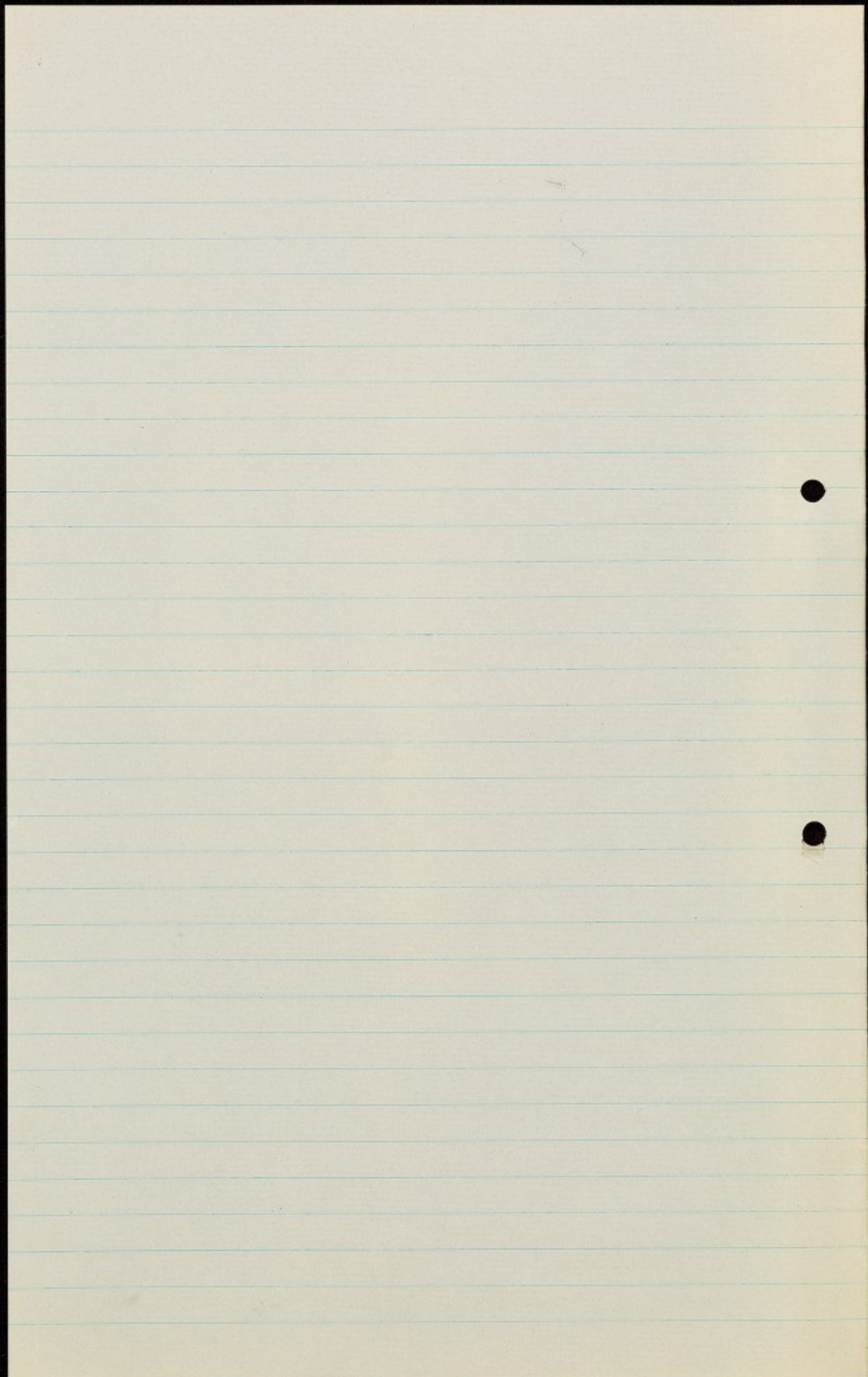
Mother alive - had a nervous breakdown some years ago.

Visited on the 21st by her mother.

Aug 2nd

No improvement, helpless, wet 1 each day - tube fed three times daily - sleeping well at night's.

But all day - cooed about in chair.

" 3 Talking for short time this a.m., soup & taken for dinner, helpless, nervous & depressed since.

Tube fed twice - wet 1.

Slept well during night 6 1/2 hrs.

" 4 Walking & talking at times, says she is waiting for the doctor to tell her to take her food, thinks it better to have the tube feeds a little longer. Tube fed three times.

Watchful & talkative early night, slept 5 hrs.

" 5 Talking for short time this a.m. quiet & helpless then until 5.30 p.m. - taking again for 1/2 an hr. confused & depressed this evening. Tube fed 11. wet 1.

Supper taken well.

Comfortable night, slept well.

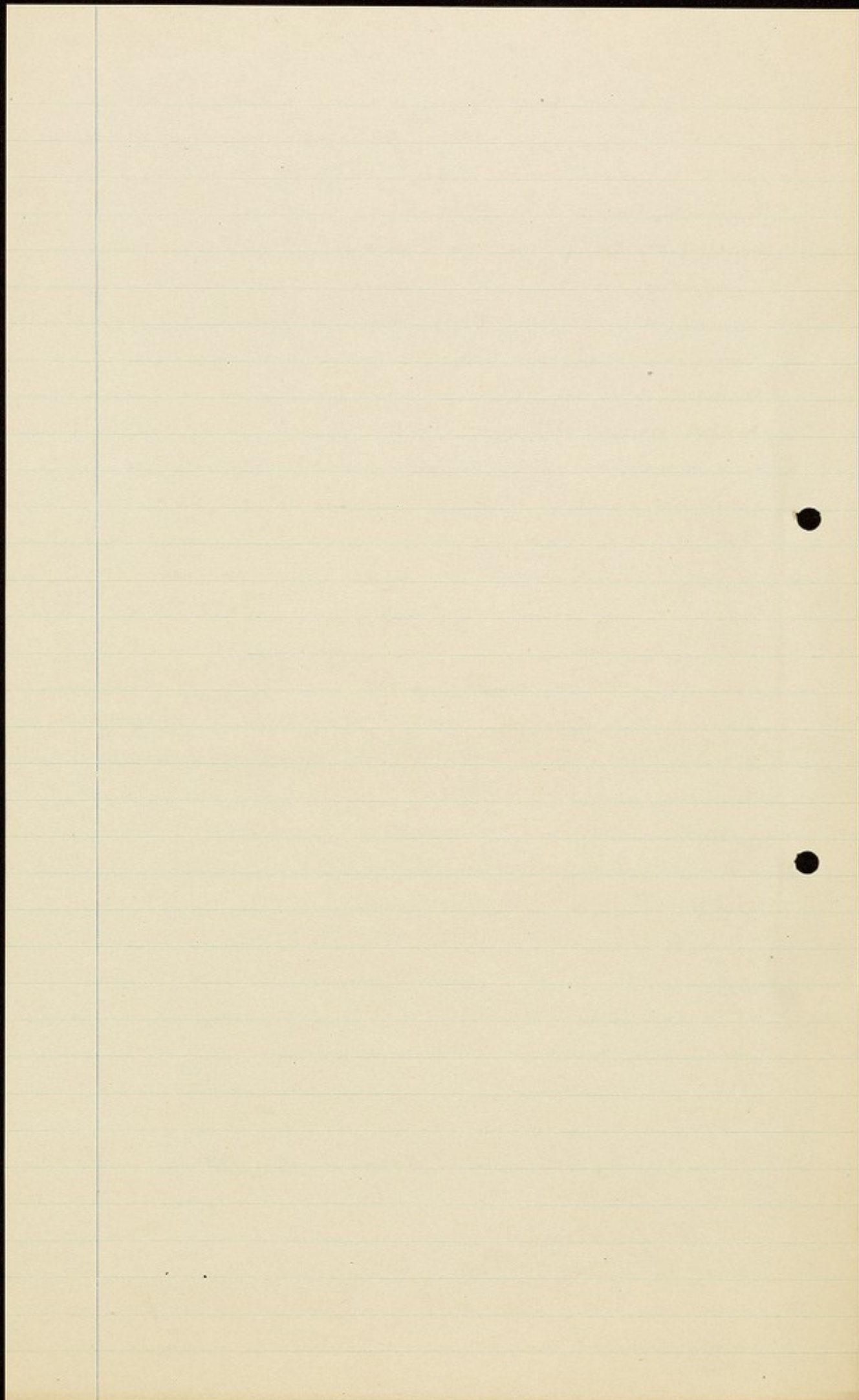
" 6 Talking & walking - deluded about herself to home. Food taken well.

" 7 Changelable, very depressed at times, walked out of front gate from drawing room this afternoon. Food taken well, fed with breakfast to dinner.

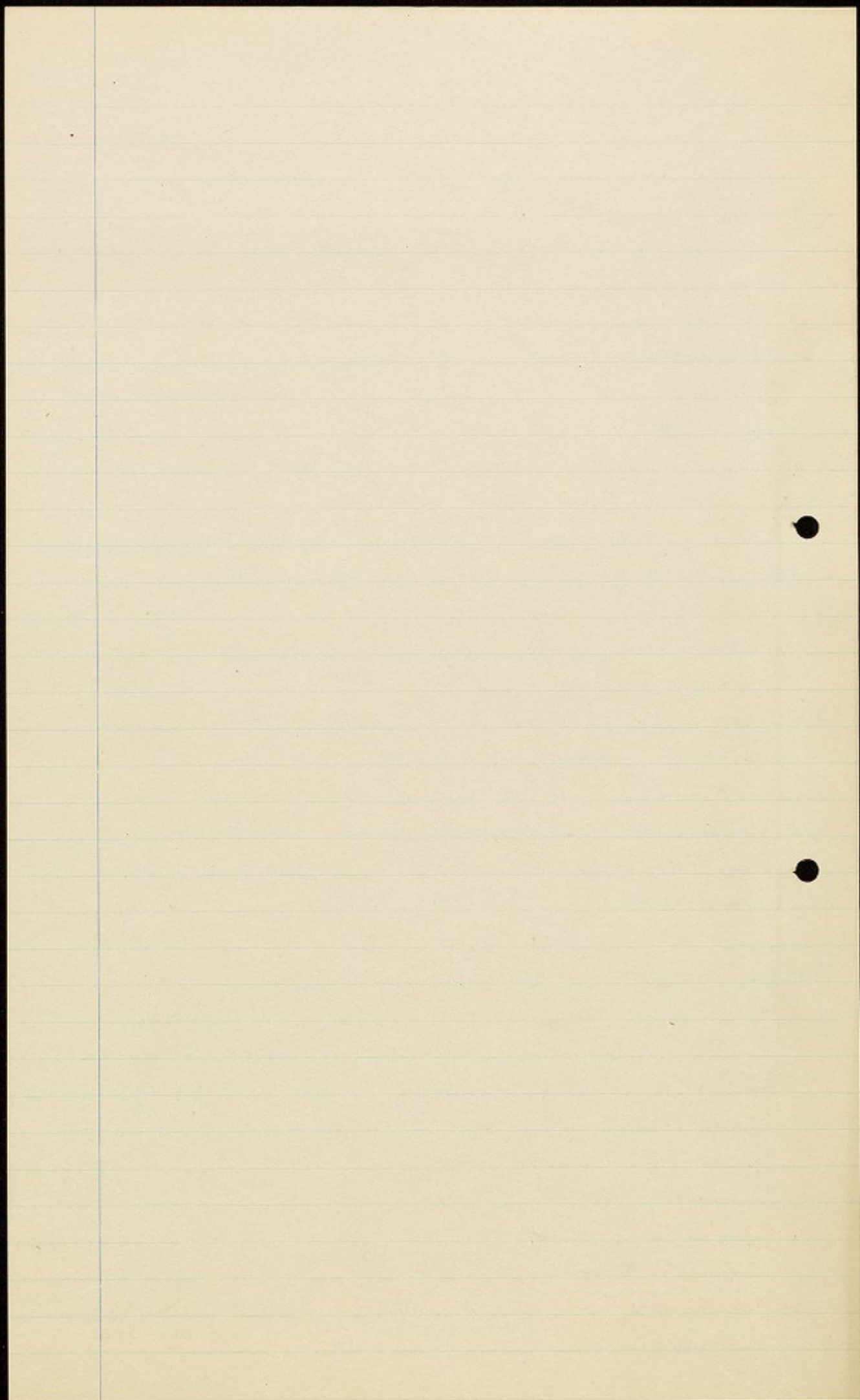
Comfortable night, slept 4 hrs.
