My dear Pierce

I hasten to reimburse you for the expenses attaching to your immense labour. How little people reflect on the amount of work done for mere love of work.

Never have I been so relieved- he was a dishonest unscrupulous man making an infinity of mischief with other patients and attempting to do so with the friends of other patients. Of course I knew that he was insane and that was his excuse. It was a great sell- he got so well that I was arranging with his friends for leave on trial, but Carsen v. Churchill upset him, and he took on pure insanity of con-

duct. If you have any others-moderate or well-to-do I should be glad to do for them.

Certainly I think that you ought to have any copies you want of the magnum opus. I will phone Adlards on the spot and tell him to keep the type up, as the Annual is sure to order circulation. I have made all preparations to go to Norwich. I have not been off these premises even to the Village since I last saw you! But the scout is fairly kind and amenable to aspirin so far.
