

## CONDITIONS OF SALE.

---

I. The highest bidder to be the buyer; and if any dispute arise between two or more bidders, the lot so disputed shall be immediately put up again and re-sold.

II. No person to advance less than 1s.; above five pounds, 2s. 6d.; and so on in proportion.

III. The purchasers to give in their names and places of abode, and to pay down 5s. in the pound, if required, in part payment of the purchase-money; in default of which the lot or lots so purchased to be immediately put up again and re-sold.

IV. The lots to be taken away at the buyer's expense, with all faults and errors of description, within one day after the conclusion of the sale; and the remainder of the purchase-money to be absolutely paid on or before delivery; in default of which the Auctioneers will not hold themselves responsible, if lost, stolen, damaged, or otherwise destroyed, but they will be left at the sole risk of the purchaser.

V. Upon failure of complying with the above conditions the money deposited in part payment shall be forfeited; and all lots uncleared within the time aforesaid, shall be re-sold by public or private sale; and the deficiency (if any) arising from such re-sale, shall be made good by the defaulter at this sale, together with all charges attending the same.

VI. All the books which are described in the catalogue as in any way imperfect, and those volumes which are not specified in the catalogue, together with all manuscripts, will be sold with all faults.

VII.
