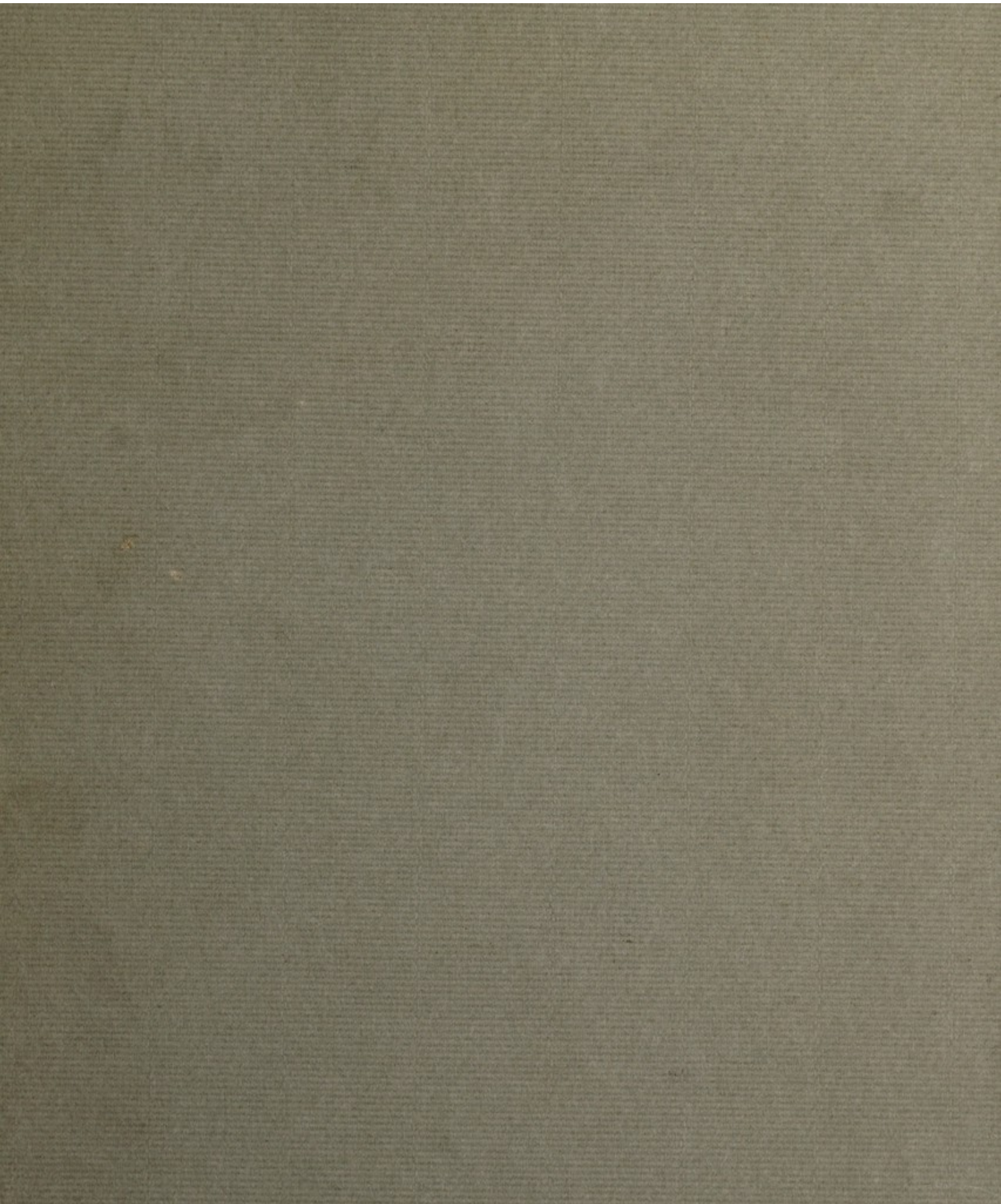

MEDICAL knowledge is of all kinds the most fugacious and difficult to be fixed. The immense multiplicity of facts which crowd the memory of the experienced practitioner, defies the most retentive powers. It has been correctly observed, that a Physician never makes use of more than ten years' experience, and beyond that, *forgets* as much as he *learns*. A common place book supplies in a considerable degree this defect so universally felt and complained of. Every medical man, whether pupil or practitioner, is constantly meeting with some fact or observation, which it would be of use to him hereafter to recur to, and yet it would be in vain to trust the recollection of it to his memory alone. This is peculiarly true of successful extemporaneous prescriptions, and of curious cases and unexpected recoveries, and facts disclosed by the examination of morbid parts after death.

The following work is intended to furnish a convenient depository of this fleeting and ephemeral knowledge; and it is hoped that it will be made useful, not only to practitioners themselves, but likewise to the public, by enabling any one to communicate the results of his experience with comparatively little trouble.
