A very interesting account of this work is given by Anna Comnena, in her history of her Father's Reign. She says Euthymius was a profound grammarian, an admirable rhetorician, and skilled beyond all men in his knowledge of theology. His Panoplia was undertaken at the request of her Imperial Father, who commanded him to refute the errors of every sect of heretics; enjoining him first to state the heretical dogma, and then subjoin to each separately a refutation from the Greek Fathers. Accordingly, this very antient Manucript acquires great additional interest from the corious EXTRACTS FROM CHRYSOSTOM, GREGORY NYSSEN, ATHANASIUS, DAMASCENUS, DIONYSIUS AREOPAGITA, GREGORY, MAXIMUS, BASILIUS, CYRIL, THEODORUS, and others, against the Manichæans, Sabellians, Valentinians, and numerous others.
