

(a) Dr. Trevor Thomas, the Medical Officer of Health, was called up on the outbreak of War and Dr. C. D. Cardinall has been appointed Acting Medical Officer of Health for the Hatfield Rural District Council.

(b) There are no special matters to report under the headings of "War", "Outbreaks of infectious Diseases", or with regard to "Administrative Measures during the period from 3rd September to 31st December, 1939".

(c) It is to be noted with regret that the Joint Sewerage and Sewage Disposal Scheme for Cuffley and Northaw has been further delayed owing to the War.
