DURING the fifty-two weeks of the year 1869 (terminating on Saturday, 1st January, 1870), the Returns of the Local Registrars record 18,668 births, and 14,744 deaths within the Borough of Liverpool.

Of the births, 9,467 were males, and 9,201 were females; making the total Birth-rate of the Borough equal to 36.6 per 1,000.

The distribution of the births in the different wards and districts of the Borough has been arranged in the following Table:—

Of the 14,744 deaths, 7,588 were of males, and 7,156 of females; 8,797 occurred in the Parish, and 5,947 in the Out-townships.

The Death-rate of the Borough was equal to 28.9 per 1000, or to 3 per 1000 less than the average rate which had prevailed during the previous ten years.

The Death-rate of the Parish was equal to 31·6, and that of the Out-townships to 25·8 per 1000 of the estimated population.

If the relative number of males and females are still pretty near what they were between the two census periods of 1851 and 1861, then the Birth and Death-rates of females in 1869 were respectively 35·3 and 27·4, and those of males 38·1 and 30·6 per 1000 of the estimated population of the same sex.

We are able, from the returns made by the Registrars as to the residences of persons dying in the Workhouses and Hospitals of the town, to classify 1,320 of the deaths in these establishments under the wards and districts from whence the patients were removed, viz., 352 under Scotland Ward, 186 under Vauxhall Ward, 153 under St. Paul's and Exchange Wards (Dale Street District,) 253 under St. Anne's and Lime Street Wards (Islington District,) 39 under Castle Street and St. Peter's Wards (Gt. George's District,) 126 under Pitt Street and Gt. George's Wards (St. Thomas' District,) 129 under Rodney Street and Abercromby Wards (Mount Pleasant District,) 52 under the Out-Townships of Everton and Kirkdale, 24 under that of West Derby, and 6 under those of the Toxteths. This will, however, still leave unclassified 852 deaths of persons whose previous residences were either unknown or are not specified.

The results of the alterations occasioned by a re-arrangement of the deaths in the wards and districts from whence the patients were removed will be shown in the following table, from which a calculated rate of mortality per 1000 of the estimated inhabitants has been made. This re-arrangement makes a difference in the returns of the Registrars, and by crediting 68 deaths in the Parish Workhouse to the Out-townships, it makes an alteration of 0.2 per 1000 in the rate of mortality :—

The above rates, in the ninth year since the census, must be regarded as mere approximations ; this is especially the case in respect of the mortality rates of Vauxhall Ward, Paul and Exchange Wards, Castle and Peter's Wards, Pitt and Great George Wards, where the calculation is made upon a supposed annual decrease of population ; and in Lime and St. Anne's Wards, where the increase of population is estimated on a very small decimal of 00.6 per cent. The rate of deaths in the Parish Workhouse is estimated on the population of the whole Parish, and not of the Borough.

The Registrar-General's weekly reports enable us to compare the mortality of Liverpool with thirteen of the large towns of Great Britain ; and as the density of population ought to be considered in every comparison of the sanitary condition of towns and cities, it has also been included in the following table :—

The average age at death of the inhabitants of the Borough during the twelve months of the year 1869 was 23 years, in the Parish 24 years, and in the Out-townships 20 years. The following table shows, as might have been expected, that the average age was lowest during the third quarter, or during the months of July, August, and September, when the diseases of childhood, or at least Infantile Diarrhoea, were most rife.

The deaths of infants below the fifth year of their age amounted to 7,319, and thus comprised 49·6 per cent. of the whole deaths. There were at the last census 60,760 children under 5 years of age within the Borough of Liverpool, and the number may now be estimated at 69,672; therefore, their mortality in 1869 was equal to 10·5 per cent. of the whole. 4,461 infants, or every fourth child born within the Borough of Liverpool, died before attaining the age of twelve months.

The first of the following table shows the districts where infant mortality was relatively and absolutely greatest; the second table illustrates the influence of age on the death-rate of the Borough; and the third table places, in one connected view, the pathological history of the death registry.

The Registrar's returns show that there were 13 deaths (9 of women and 4 of men) above the age of 90, viz., 3 males and 1 female at the age of 91, 1 male and 1 female at the age of 92, 2 females at the age of 93, 1 female at 97, and 2 males at 98, 1 female at 103, and 1 female at 107. This last person was an inmate of the Workhouse; the female aged 103 was the widow of a seaman, had resided all her life in Liverpool, and died in a court called Moffatt's Place, Hilbre Street.

ZYMOTICS.

Zymotic diseases occasioned 4233 deaths during the year 1869, and thus accounted for 28.7 per cent. of the total mortality within the Borough of Liverpool during the same period. This was nearly one per cent. less than the proportional rate of Zymotic deaths to deaths from all causes during the preceding decennial period. The following table shows the localities and the periods of their fatal prevalence :—

TYPHUS AND INFANTILE REMITTENT FEVER.

These diseases accounted within the Borough of Liverpool for 783 deaths, or for 542 in the Parish and 241 in the Out-townships ; the rate of their mortality was equal to 1.5 per 1000 per annum of the estimated population ; their per-centage rate relatively to deaths from all causes was 6.3 during the first, 6.1 during the second, 4.6 during the third, and 4.3 during the fourth quarter of the year. Their deaths included 421 males and 362 females ; 198 persons below the age of 15 ; 175 between the ages of 15 and 30, and 410 above the age of 30.

Every form of continued fever is included under the generic term of Typhus; but the Registers of Deaths attribute 21 cases to gastric fever, 99 to typhoid fever, 30 to enteric fever, 4 to low fever, 4 to continued fever, 1 to brain fever, 1 to bilious fever, 1 to relapsing fever, and 475 to typhus. Under the term of fever there were registered 86 deaths, under that of febris 13 deaths, and under that of febricula 20 deaths. The deaths registered under the term of infantile remittent amounted to 28.

The following tables are in themselves sufficiently explanatory; the first compares the averages of fever deaths during the preceding ten years with those during 1869; the second table shows the districts of the town and the periods of the year in which the fever was most fatally prevalent; the third table marks in streets the habitats of the disease; and the remaining tables the occupations and social positions of its victims.

SCARLATINA

Assumed during the last six months of 1869 within the Borough of Liverpool the gravity of an epidemic. It accounted during the year for 1,042 deaths, or for 519 in the Parish, and 523 in the Out-townships. The rate of its mortality was equal to 2 per 1000 per annum of the estimated population. Its rate relatively to deaths from all causes was 2.6 per cent. in the first quarter, 4.6 in the second, 7.8 in the third, and 13.1 in the fourth quarter of the year ; its annual rate relatively to all deaths was 7.0 per cent.

The first of the following tables gives a statistical history of the mortality of Scarlatina during the year 1869 ; the second is a record of the streets of the Borough wherein 3 or more deaths occurred from Scarlatina ; and I have

added a third table, showing the position of Scarlatina within the Borough of Liverpool during the previous twenty years. This latter table will not be without much interest to those who study the difficult and hitherto inexplicable problem connected with the epidemic recurrence of those classes of Zymotic disease which are especially dependent for their propagation on infection and contagion.

TUBERCULAR DISEASES.

This group of diseases includes Phthisis, Scrofula, Tabes Mesenterica and Hydrocephalus. They occasioned 2107 deaths in the Borough of Liverpool during the year 1869, of which 1198 occurred in the Parish, and 909 in the Out-townships. Their death-rate was 4·1 per 1000 of the estimated population; their per centage death-rate relatively to deaths from all causes was 14·3.

The following Tables sufficiently explain themselves. The first and second show the localities and periods of the year in which Phthisis and other Tubercular diseases were most fatally prevalent. The third is a statistical resumé of the death records of all Tubercular diseases, and also of Phthisis (separately) during the last twenty years.

The Select Vestry are kind enough to forward to my office a daily list of the cases of Typhus Fever attended by the Parochial Medical Officers, and a monthly list of the cases of Zymotic diseases, of Tubercular diseases, and of sickness from other causes, which have occurred in the twelve districts of the Parish.

The daily list enables the Health Committee to take action for the purification of the houses, and I am able from the other to classify the districts and streets in which sickness has prevailed.

The following are the streets in which six or more cases of Typhus, or three or more of Scarlatina, have occurred during the year.

These show that the average number of persons suffering from Typhus at one time in hospital during the year 1869 was 104, and their per centage death-rate 14·0; the average number of Measles cases at one time in hospital was 10, their per centage death-rate 17·3; the average number of Scarlatina cases at one time in hospital was 3 and their per centage death-rate 27·7.

The number of paupers in receipt of relief on Saturday, 26th June, was 15,584, or 1080 less than at the same period of 1868, and the number on the 25th December was 16,173, or 461 less than in the corresponding period of 1868.

SANITARY WORK.

The two following Tables show the extent of work which has been done under the orders of the Health Committee in respect of the conversion of Privies into Water Closets. The first table carries it down to the termination of the year 1868; the second table refers to the work done during the year 1869.

Under the term "Court Privies" are included all Privies in the common area of Courts or Alleys, and not placed within the separate yards of houses. In all such cases the conversion ordered by the Health Committee has been into trough water-closets.

LODGING HOUSES.

The Health Committee have, since the passing of the Sanitary Act 1866, ruled that as far as possible all registered lodging-houses should have a day apartment for the accommodation of their lodgers, and that all houses where single rooms were occupied by day and night should be registered as sub-let. The space required for a night lodger in a registered lodging-house is 300 cubical feet, while the space in a sub-let house for each adult is 350 feet. The effect of this arrangement is to lessen the number of registered lodging-houses.

There were on the register 1161 lodging-houses at the end of 1868, and 1149 at the end of 1869. This difference was occasioned by the removal of 349 old licenses and the addition of 337 new ones. The visits to lodging-houses are both by day and night. The lodging-houses of the better class, and especially those provided only with single beds for each person, and only with the number of beds equivalent to the number of lodgers allowed, are not visited at night except on grave suspicion or on complaint, or in the case of foreign lodging-houses, where there is a large influx of emigrants. The night visits are pretty nearly restricted to the low districts and tramp houses. The number of day visits paid during the year was 33,282, and the night visits 6135. The number of lodging-houses found overcrowded on the night visits was 63 ; the number of informations laid for breaches of the by-laws was 163, with the results of fines in 137 cases to the extent of £40 10s. 6d., in sums varying from 1s. to 40s. and costs. The number of lodging-houses found dirty was 240 ; notices were served to limewash and cleanse.

It is necessary frequently to visit houses which are not licensed either as lodging or sub-let houses, especially when emigration is brisk, or at race times. There were 915 such visits paid during the day, and in 78 of the cases where suspicion was confirmed they were followed up by night visits. A tenant harbouring lodgers is not taken before the Justices for the first offence, but is noticed to apply to have his rooms measured and licensed. There were 347 such notices issued during the year, but in only 6 cases did the tenants refuse to comply ; they were brought before the Justices and fined. A by-law requires that every case of infectious sickness in a lodging-house should be at once reported to the Medical Officer of Health. In 2 cases the tenants having neglected to make the required report, were fined 10s. and costs. 43 cases of fever occurred in lodging-houses ; in 36 of the cases the patients were at once sent to hospital, the remaining 7 being members of the keepers' families, were not removed ; 5 of these latter died. In all cases of fever or infectious disease the bedding was at once removed to the disinfecting apparatus, and the rooms purified and cleansed ; in the 7 cases where the patients remained, the licenses to receive lodgers were suspended by the Medical Officer. No lodger

died from fever in a registered lodging-house; but, not including the five cases of fever, there were 91 deaths from non-contagious diseases in lodging-houses, of which 70 belonged to the keepers' families and 21 were lodgers.

SUB-LET HOUSES REGISTERED UNDER THE SANITARY ACT OF 1866.

The number of sub-let houses on the Registry at the termination of 1868 was 6,267; the number registered during 1869 was 1,272, making the total on the register on the 31st December, 7,539. The frequency of day or night visits to these houses depends on the suspicions occasioned by the character of the neighbourhood; and it is seldom that rooms not found overcrowded on the first visit are again subjected to any night inspections. The number of visits paid during the night was 9,365, and during the day 55,190, with the result of finding 867 rooms overcrowded. The average extent of overcrowding may be estimated by the fact that 2,718 adults and 860 children were found sleeping in rooms the cubical area of which was 705,380 feet; so that the average cubical space for each individual was 197 feet; but if two children under 15 years of age be reckoned as one adult, the cubical space for each adult would be 224 feet, or 126 feet less than the very restricted amount which on account of the smallness of the rooms the Council are constrained to demand. Of course an average of overcrowding gives little or no idea of the extent or intensity of the evil in individual cases. In addition to overcrowding, the offence (though not punishable in sub-let houses) of permitting adult males and females not married to occupy the same room, comes under the notice of, and is entered in the books of the Inspectors. There were 365 rooms thus indecently occupied by 649 males and 691 females, besides having also in these rooms 139 children between the ages of 5 and 13 years.

Informations were laid against 549 chief tenants for permitting overcrowding in rooms, with the following results:—11 were fined 1s.; 324, 1s. and 1s. costs; 1 fined 2s. and 2s. costs; 10 fined 2s. 6d.; 111 fined 2s. 6d. and 2s. 6d. costs; 21 fined 5s. and costs; and 1 fined 10s. and costs, making a total of fines levied during the year of £72 17s. Of the remaining 70 cases, 16 informations were withdrawn, the tenants having abated the overcrowding; in 54 cases the tenants were acquitted—the majority because it was the first offence, and the remainder because of their poverty, and their promise not again to offend.

Reference has been made to the smallness of sub-let rooms, or, in other words, of the houses of the labouring classes, and the two following tables will not be without some interest in illustration of this.

WORKSHOPS.

The Medical Officer is constrained by further experience to express his opinion that the above Act, however beneficent in intention, is not only impracticable in its machinery but inequitable in its effects. He has, however, since July, 1869, desired his chief Inspector, Mr. Wilson, to visit and report upon all cases of which complaints, anonymous or otherwise, have been received. 80 visits have been paid, and in 15 cases where there was a breach of the Saturday half-holiday, the employers were brought before the Justices and fined in penalties varying from 1s. to 20s. and costs. All these several employers have since applied for and received permission from the Secretary of State to substitute other arrangements for the Saturday half-holiday.

BAKEHOUSES.

Since July, 1869, the inspection of bakehouses has been undertaken by the Medical Officer's staff; 859 day visits and 1258 night visits have been paid to them. 34 informations were laid for working young people below the age of 18 years between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. In 29 cases, penalties varying from 1s. and 1s. costs to 60s. and costs, and making a total of £14 13s. 6d., were inflicted. In 4 cases, the employers were acquitted upon pleading ignorance of the law, and in one case it was ruled that the young person was a domestic servant and only occasionally employed in the bakehouse. 47 bakehouses were found dirty and notices were served to limewash and cleanse them.

LICENSES FOR CATTLE.

During the year 1869, 119 applications for Licenses to keep 1298 cows were made to and granted by the Health Committee; these, in addition to the premises licensed during 1868, make up the number to 466 shippsons, containing 4685 cows. In 56 of these shippsons, pigs are also allowed to be kept; in 49 of them, only 2 pigs each; in 6, 4 pigs; and in 1, 5 pigs.

208 applications were made during the year to keep pigs in styes separate from and unconnected with shippsons; 79 of these applications for keeping 211 pigs were granted. The total number of premises or styes now licensed in the Borough (excluding shippsons) is 240, for the keeping of 758 pigs.

THE DISINFECTING APPARATUS.

The number of articles sent to the Disinfecting Apparatus during the year amounted to 21,054, or to 4,415 more than in 1868, and 16,451 more than in 1867. This is very gratifying evidence that the benefits derived from these establishments are becoming better known to and more fully appreciated by the people.
