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R E P O R T , 1870.

DURING the fifty-two weeks of the year 1870 (terminating on Saturday, 31st December, 1870), the Returns of the Local Registrars record 19,146 births and 16,099 deaths within the Borough of Liverpool.

Of the births, 9,682 were males, and 9,464 were females ; making the total Birth-rate of the Borough equal to 36·9 per 1,000.

The distribution of the births in the different wards and districts of the Borough has been arranged in the following Table :—

Of the 16,099 deaths, 8,254 were of males, and 7,845 of females ; 9,300 occurred in the Parish, and 6,799 in the Out-townships.

The Death-rate of the Borough was equal to 31·1 per 1000, or to nearly 1 per 1000 less than the average rate which had prevailed during the previous ten years. The Death-rate of the Parish was equal to 33·3, and that of the Out-townships to 28·5 per 1000 of the estimated population.

If the relative number of males and females are still pretty near what they were between the two census periods of 1851 and 1861, then the Birth and Death-rates of females in 1870 were respectively 35.7 and 29.6, and those of males 38.3 and 29.6 per 1000 of the estimated population of the same sex.

We are able, from the returns made by the Registrars as to the residences of persons dying in the Workhouses and Hospitals of the town, to classify 1,562 of the deaths in these establishments under the wards and districts from whence the patients were removed, viz., 418 under Scotland Ward, 256 under Vauxhall Ward, 183 under St. Paul's and Exchange Wards (Dale Street District,) 283 under St. Anne's and Lime Street Wards (Islington District,) 40 under Castle Street and St. Peter's Wards (Great George's District,) 149 under Pitt Street and Great George's Wards (St. Thomas's District,) 135 under Rodney Street and Abercromby Wards (Mount Pleasant District,) 67 under the Out-Townships of Everton and Kirkdale, 17 under that of West Derby, and 14 under those of the Toxteths. This will, however, still leave unclassified 875 deaths of persons whose previous residences were either unknown or are not specified.

The results of the alterations occasioned by a re-arrangement of the deaths in the wards and districts from whence the patients were removed will be shown in the following table, from which a calculated rate of mortality per 1,000 of the estimated inhabitants has been made.

The above rates must be regarded as mere approximations ; this is especially the case in respect of the mortality rates of Vauxhall Ward, St. Paul's and Exchange Wards, Castle Street and St. Peter's Wards, Pitt Street and Great George Wards, where the calculation is made upon a supposed annual decrease of population ; and in Lime Street and St. Anne's Wards, where the increase of population is estimated on a very small decimal of 00·6 per cent.

The Registrar-General's weekly reports enable us to compare the mortality of Liverpool with thirteen of the large towns of Great Britain ; and as the density of population ought to be considered in every comparison of the sanitary condition of towns and cities, it has also been included in the following table :—

The average age at death of the inhabitants of the Borough during the twelve months of the year 1870 was 22 years, in the Parish 24 years, and in the Out-Townships 20 years. The following table shows, as might have been expected, that the average age was lowest during the third quarter, or during the months of July, August, and September, when the diseases of childhood, or at least Infantile Diarrhoea, were most rife.

The deaths of infants below the fifth year of their age amounted to 8,148, and thus comprised 50·6 per cent. of the whole deaths. There were at the last census 60,760 children under five years of age within the Borough of Liverpool, and the number may now be estimated at 70,837; therefore, their mortality in 1870 was equal to 11·5 per cent. 4,952 infants, or 25·8 per cent of all the children born within the Borough of Liverpool, died before attaining the age of twelve months.

The first of the following tables shows the districts where infant mortality was relatively and absolutely greatest; the second table illustrates the influence of age on the death rate of the Borough; and the third table places, in one connected view, the pathological history of the death registry.

The Registrar's returns show that there were 11 deaths (6 of women and 5 of men) above the age of 90, viz., 1 female at the age of 91, 1 male and 1 female at the age of 93, 3 males at the age of 95, 1 male and 1 female at 96, 1 female at 98, 1 female at 99, and 1 female at 102. This last person was an inmate of the Workhouse; her previous residence was No. 9, in No. 12 Court, Oriel Street, and she was the widow of a labourer.

ZYMOTICS.

Zymotic diseases occasioned 4731 deaths during the year 1870, and thus accounted for 29.3 per cent. of the total mortality within the Borough of Liverpool during the same period. This was nearly one per cent. more than the proportional rate of Zymotic deaths to deaths from all causes during the preceding decennial period. The following table shows the localities and the periods of their fatal prevalence:—

TYPHUS AND INFANTILE REMITTENT FEVER.

These diseases accounted within the Borough of Liverpool for 572 deaths, or for 369 in the Parish and 203 in the Out-townships; the rate of their mortality was equal to 1.1 per 1000 per annum of the estimated population; their per-cent-age rate relatively to deaths from all causes was 3.1 during the first, 3.3 during the second, 3.2 during the third, and 4.3 during the fourth quarter of the year. Their deaths included 298 males and 274 females;

213 persons below the age of 15; 101 between the ages of 15 and 30, and 258 above the age of 30.

Every form of continued fever (with the exception of Relapsing Fever) is included under the generic term of Typhus; but the Registers of Deaths attribute 25 cases to gastric fever, 56 to typhoid fever, 35 to enteric fever, 7 to continued fever, 2 to brain fever, and 218 to typhus. Under the term of fever there were registered 173 deaths, under that of febris 14 deaths, and under that of febricula 15 deaths. The deaths registered under the term of infantile remittent amounted to 27.

The following tables are in themselves sufficiently explanatory; the first compares the averages of fever deaths during the preceding ten years with those during 1870; the second table shows the districts of the town and the periods of the year in which fever was most fatally prevalent; the third table marks in streets the habitats of the disease; and the remaining tables the occupations and social positions of its victims.

RELAPSING FEVER.

Relapsing Fever occasioned 355 deaths, or 203 in the Parish, and 152 in the Out-Townships. The rate of its mortality was equal to 0·68 per 1000 of the estimated population of the Borough; its per-cent-age rate relatively to deaths from all causes was 2·2, and relatively to deaths from Zymotic diseases was 7·5.

TUBERCULAR DISEASES.

This group of diseases includes Phthisis, Scrofula, Tabes Mesenterica and Hydrocephalus. They occasioned 2166 deaths in the Borough of Liverpool during the year 1870, of which 1169 occurred in the Parish, and 997 in the Out-townships. The death-rate was 4·1 per 1000 of the estimated population; their per centage death-rate relatively to deaths from all causes was 13·4.

The following Tables sufficiently explain themselves. The first and second show the localities and periods of the year in which Phthisis and other Tubercular diseases were most fatally prevalent. The third is a statistical resumé of the death records of all Tubercular diseases, and also of Phthisis (separately) during the last twenty-three years.

The Select Vestry are kind enough to forward to my office a daily list of the cases of Typhus Fever attended by the Parochial Medical Officers, and a monthly list of the cases of Zymotic diseases, of Tubercular diseases, and of sickness from other causes, which have occurred in the twelve districts of the Parish.

The daily list enables the Health Committee to take action for the purification of the houses, and I am able from the other to classify the districts and streets in which sickness has prevailed.

These show that the average number of persons suffering from Fever (including therein Typhus, Continued, and Relapsing Fevers) at one time in hospital during the year 1870 was 493, and their per centage death-rate 5·4; the average number of Simple Continued Fever Cases at one time in hospital (from July 23rd) was 25, and their per centage death-rate 4·1; the average number of cases of Relapsing Fever at one time in hospital (from July 23rd) was 901, and their per centage death-rate 4·3; the average number of cases of Small Pox at one time in hospital (from October 22nd) was 29, and their per centage death-rate 19·5; the average number of cases of Scarlatina at one time in hospital during the whole year was 3, and their per centage death-rate 14·0; the average per centage death-rate of Measles was 7·8.

The number of persons in receipt of Parochial Relief on Saturday, the 2nd July, was 14,134, or 1,710 less than at the corresponding period of 1869, and the number on Saturday, the 31st December, was 15,372, or 801 less than on the same period of 1869.

LODGING-HOUSES.

The Health Committee have, since the passing of the Sanitary Act, 1866, ruled that as far as possible all registered lodging-houses should have a day apartment for the accommodation of their lodgers, and that all houses where single rooms were occupied by day and night should be registered as sub-let. The space required for a night lodger in a registered lodging-house is 300 cubical feet, while the space in a sub-let house for each adult is 350 feet. The effect of this arrangement is to lessen the number of registered lodging-houses.

There were on the register 1,149 lodging-houses at the end of 1869, and 1,134 at the end of 1870. This difference was occasioned by the removal of 293 old licenses and the addition of 278 new ones. The visits to lodging-houses are both by day and night. The lodging-houses of the better class, and especially those provided only with single beds for each person, and only with the number of beds equivalent to the number of lodgers allowed, are not visited at night except on grave suspicion or on complaint, or in the case of foreign lodging-houses, where there is a large influx of emigrants. The night visits are pretty nearly restricted to the low districts and tramp houses. The number of day visits paid during the year was 34,823, and the night visits 5,706. The number of lodging-houses found overcrowded on the night visits was 27; the number of informations laid for breaches of the bye-laws was 92, with the results of fines in 70 cases to the extent of £19. 17s., in sums varying from 1s. to 20s. and costs. The number of lodging-houses found dirty was 267; notices were served to limewash and cleanse.

It is necessary frequently to visit houses which are not licensed either as lodging or sub-let houses, especially when emigration is brisk, or at race times. There were 976 such visits paid during the day, and in 62 of the cases where suspicion was confirmed they were followed up by night visits. A tenant harbouring lodgers is not taken before the Justices for the first offence, but is noticed to apply to have his rooms measured and licensed. There were 280 such notices issued during the year, but in only 3 cases did the tenants refuse to comply ; they were brought before the Justices and fined. A bye-law requires that every case of infectious sickness in a lodging-houses should be at once reported to the Medical Officer of Health: 164 cases of fever occurred in lodging-houses ; in 156 of the cases the patients were at once sent to hospital, the remaining 8 being members of the keepers' families, were not removed ; 4 of these latter died. In all cases of fever or infectious disease the bedding was at once removed to the disinfecting apparatus, and the rooms purified and cleansed ; in the 8 cases where the patients remained the licenses to receive lodgers were suspended by the Medical Officer. No lodger died from fever in a registered lodging-house ; but not including the four cases of fever, there were 107 deaths from non-contagious diseases in lodging-houses, of which 79 belonged to the keepers' families and 28 were lodgers.

SUB-LET HOUSES REGISTERED UNDER THE SANITARY ACT OF 1866.

The number of sub-let houses on the Registry at the termination of 1869 was 7,539 ; the number registered during 1870 was 1,264, making the total on the register on the 31st December, 8,803. The number of visits paid during the night was 11,270, and during the day 57,342, with the result of finding 1,458 rooms overcrowded. In addition to overcrowding, the offence (though not punishable in sub-let houses) of permitting adult males and females not married to occupy the same room, comes under the notice of, and is entered in the books of the Inspectors. There were 615 rooms thus indecently occupied by 923 males and 1,032 females, besides having also in these rooms 545 children between the ages of 5 and 13 years.

Informations were laid against 868 chief tenants for permitting overcrowding in rooms with the following results :—10 were fined 1s. ; 478 1s. and 1s. costs ; 1 fined 2s. 6d. and 1s. 6d. costs ; 1 fined 2s. 6d. ; 189 fined 2s. 6d. and 2s. 6d. costs ; 58 fined 5s. and costs ; and 14 fined 10s. and costs, making a total of fines levied during the year of £133 11s. 6d. Of the remaining 117 cases, 16 informations were withdrawn, the tenants having abated the overcrowding ; in 101 cases the tenants were acquitted—the majority because it was the first offence, and the remainder because of their poverty, and their promise not again to offend.

WORKSHOPS.

Visits are paid to all workshops upon receipt of complaints. 50 visits have been paid during the year, and in 23 cases where there was a breach of the Saturday half-holiday the employers were brought before the Justices and fined in penalties varying from 1s. to 40s. and costs. The amount of fines was £13 14s. 6d.

BAKEHOUSES.

1,207 day visits and 1,837 night visits have been paid to Bakehouses during the year. 23 informations were laid for working young people below the age of 18 years, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. In 18 cases penalties varying from 1s. and 1s. costs to 40s. and costs, and making a total of £8 0s. 6d. were inflicted. In 5 cases the employers were acquitted, being the first offence. 96 Bakehouses were found dirty and notices were served to limewash and cleanse them.

LICENSES FOR CATTLE.

During the year 1870, 79 applications for Licenses to keep 737 cows were made to and granted by the Health Committee ; these, in addition to premises previously licensed, make up the number to 545 shippsons, containing 5,422 cows. 52 shippsons, containing 574 cows, have been given up during the year, leaving the number of shippsons on the Register 493, containing 4,848 cows. In 63 of these shippsons, pigs are also allowed to be kept ; in 56 of them, only 2 pigs each ; in 6, 4 pigs ; and in 1, 5 pigs.

72 applications were made during the year to keep pigs in styes separate from and unconnected with shippsons ; 41 of these applications, for keeping 121 pigs, were granted. The total number of premises or styes now licensed in the Borough (excluding shippsons) is 281, for keeping 879 pigs.

THE DISINFECTING APPARATUS.

The number of Articles sent to the Disinfecting Apparatus during the year amounted to 66,865.


