

INFECTIOUS DISEASE.

The usual Table (II) is appended showing the number of Notifications of acute Infectious Disease and the number of cases of Tuberculosis.

Four cases of Diphtheria and 2 of Scarlet Fever only occurred, compared with 5 of Diphtheria and 15 of Scarlet Fever in the previous year.

DIPHTHERIA IMMUNISATION.

Immunisation is being actively carried out in all the Schools in the District.

TUBERCULOSIS.

Three cases of Pulmonary and 1 of Non-Pulmonary Tuberculosis were notified as compared with 2 of Pulmonary and two of Non-Pulmonary in the previous year.

MINOR INFECTIOUS DISEASE.

Measles became epidemic in July and continued to the end of the year. The disease was mild in type and there were no deaths.

Of the 179 Notifications received, 18 only represented evacuees.

Hostel. A Hostel has been established in the Town of Selby providing accommodation for 17—for the reception of Children difficult of management.

Children suffering from Scabies and Septic Skin conditions are accommodated in a Sick Bay at Snaith in the Goole Rural District, and cases of mild illness are sent to the Sick Bay in Fulford or Tadcaster.

CIVIL DEFENCE.

Deaths. Buildings to serve as temporary Mortuaries have been earmarked and the requisite equipment has been obtained.

Food. Arrangements are being made for dealing with gas contaminated Food Stuffs. Volunteer personnel have been obtained and trained in gas, and permission is being sought to purchase certain necessary equipment. Vehicles have also been earmarked. Food Stuffs requiring treatment will be removed into Selby.
