## SECTION C.

### Health Services.

(1) PUBLIC HEALTH STAFF.

Medical Officer of Health (part time). One Sanitary Inspector, also part time. Associate Member of Sanitary Institute.

(2) AMBULANCE FACILITIES.

(a) For Infectious Cases.

All cases are sent to Colchester, and the Colchester ambulance fetches the cases.

(b) For Accident Cases and Non-Infectious Cases.

The Ambulance run by the Voluntary Aid Detachment of the Red Cross Society has proved itself adequate for the needs of the district.

(3) NURSING IN THE HOME.

*General.* Two district nurses are available.

*Infectious Diseases.* No facilities for nursing infectious diseases exist.

(4) CLINICS AND TREATMENT CENTRES.

There is a Maternity and Child Welfare Centre under the West Suffolk County Council, and attended by the County Medical Officer of Health.

There is also a School Clinic run by the School Medical Officers of the County.

(5) HOSPITALS.

No change since these were last reported upon.
