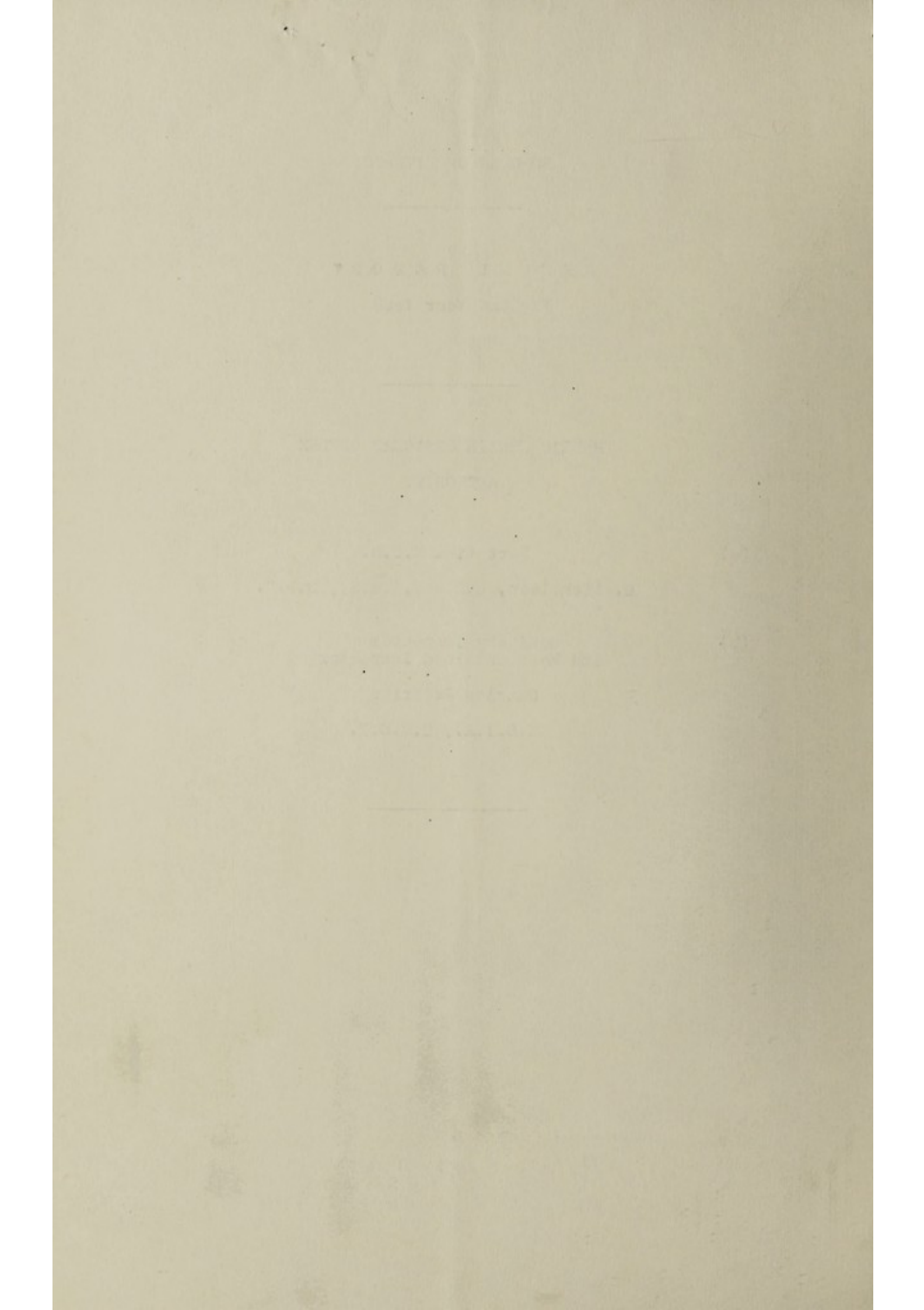

The following table shows the number of influenza cases and deaths reported in the District of Columbia for the year ending 31st December, 1921. The total number of cases reported was 50,000, and the total number of deaths was 5,000. The percentage of total cases reported in the District of Columbia was 50%, and the percentage of total deaths was 10%.

General Provision of Health Services for the Area.

- (1) Nursing in the Home. No change.
- (2) Domiciliary Midwifery is carried out by the two district nurses.
- (3) Laboratory Facilities. There are two in the Area - The County Laboratory and that connected with the Royal Devon & Exeter Hospital.
- (4) Hospitals. The old Joint Board Isolation Hospital has now been taken over by the Regional Hospital Board for the reception of recovery cases. Belmont Hospital the converted workhouse is now the chronic sick hospital for both Borough and Rural District. Infectious cases are sent to Whipton Isolation Hospital where accommodation is very adequate.

Tiverton and District Hospital deals with Surgical, Medical and Maternity cases. There are 50 beds, 11 of which are devoted to Maternity cases. Bookings are carried out by the County Medical Officer.

A Tuberculosis Clinic is now held at the above Hospital twice monthly.

- (5) Institutional Provision for Unmarried Mothers. None in the Area.
- (6) Ambulance Facilities. No change.
- (7) Clinics and Treatment Centres:-

Out-patient departments (under control of the Local Authority) - School Minor Ailments, Friday morning, 9 to 10 a.m. Wednesdays, S.M.O. in attendance, 9 to 12 noon.

Maternity & Child Welfare Centre. This Centre is open weekly on Wednesdays, 2 to 4 p.m.

Ante-natal Clinic at the Tiverton and District Hospital on Tuesdays, 3 p.m.

The Mothers and Children have had supervision and advice both at the Welfare weekly by the Medical Officer and the Health Visitor, and in their houses by the Health Visitor. Simple treatment has been given where considered sufficient, in other cases the mothers were referred to their private doctor for treatment.

The Orthopaedic Clinic was held on 49 Tuesdays during the year - 24 sessions by the Surgeon and 34 by the after-care Sister.

Some of the elder patients have been trained at St. Loye's College for the Disabled, in connection with the Clinic, the aim being the complete rehabilitation of the patients.

Prevalence of and Control over Infectious and other Diseases.

Scabies. Only an occasional case required.

Diphtheria Immunization. Vaccination procedure administered by County Council and a Clinic is held for this purpose on three Wednesdays each month. The majority of cases are dealt with by local doctors at their surgeries. The percentage of children immunised is highly satisfactory.

Examining this table, it will be observed that during the past four years, although 349 applicants were granted tenancies, the total number of applicants on the Waiting List was reduced by only 100.

Further, by the end of 1952, the number on the waiting list had grown to 303.

It would therefore appear that building at the present rate of approximately 150 houses per annum, will require 7 years to wipe out the waiting list.

#### Slum Clearance.

No appeal was lodged against the Clearance Order in respect of Pinkstones Court and the premises have been acquired by the Borough Council and the families rehoused. Unfortunately, it has been decided not to demolish the houses on the site for the time being.

#### Meat & Food Inspection.

Both ante-mortem and post-mortem inspection of all animals received for slaughter at the Council's Abattoir was carried out, a total of 4767 animals.

Approximately 9½ tons of meat and offal was condemned as unfit for human consumption; and over 1 ton of tinned and other foodstuffs voluntarily surrendered at local food shops.

#### Sanitary Circumstances of the Area

##### Water Supply.

- (1) The water supply for the Town has been satisfactory in quality and quantity.
- (2) Bacteriological examinations have been made at regular monthly intervals of the treated water going into supply. Water from the Allers supply (source springs at Norwood Common, supplemented by pumping from River Exe) is both filtered and chlorinated. Water from the Warnicombe supply is only chlorinated.
- (3) The waters have no plumbo-solvent action.
- (4) No contamination during year.
- (5) The number of dwelling houses in the Borough and population supplied from public mains are 3234 houses, 11,210 population. The water is piped in direct to approximately 2,694 houses, whilst approximately 540 houses are supplied by means of stand pipes. These latter houses being situated principally in Courts.
