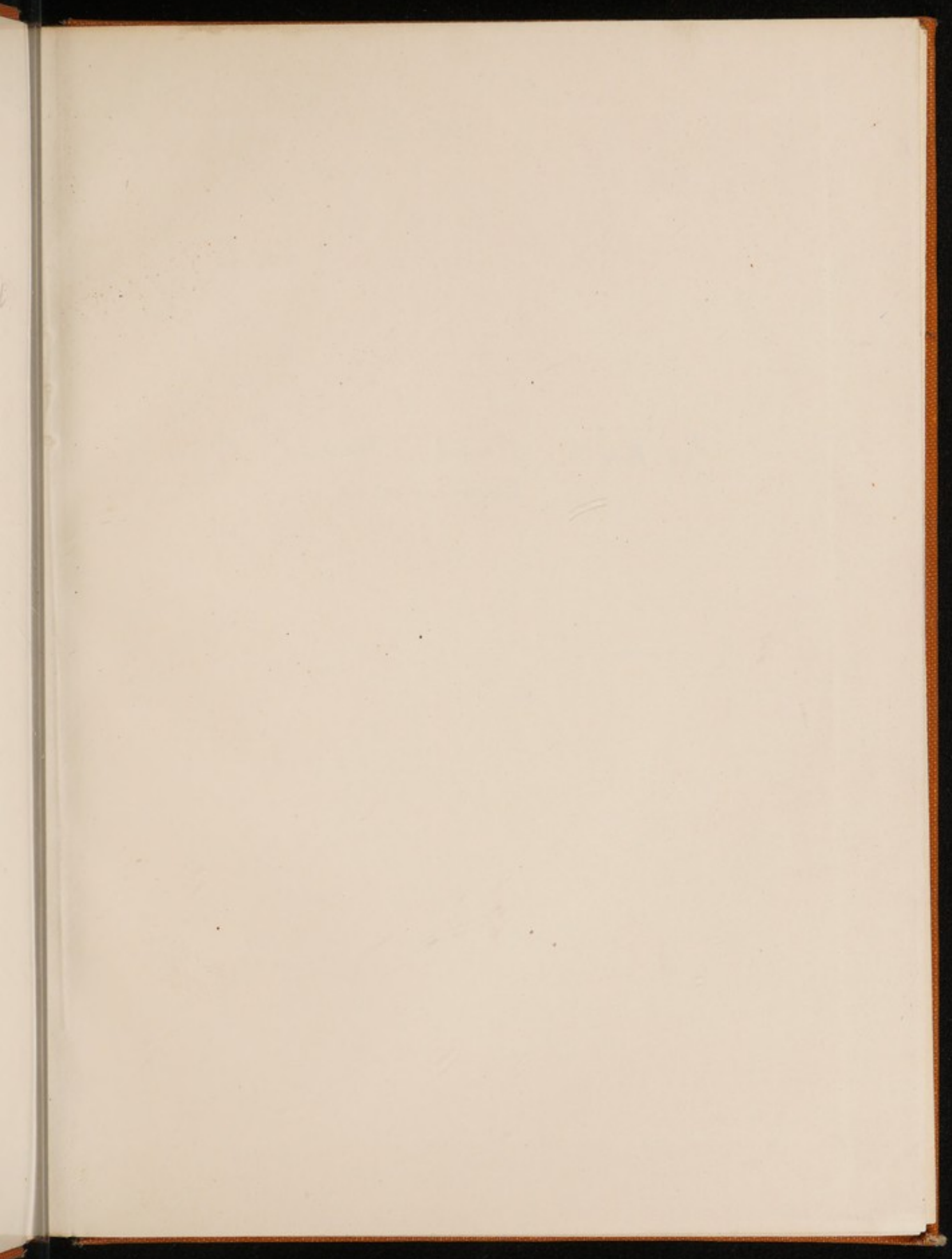

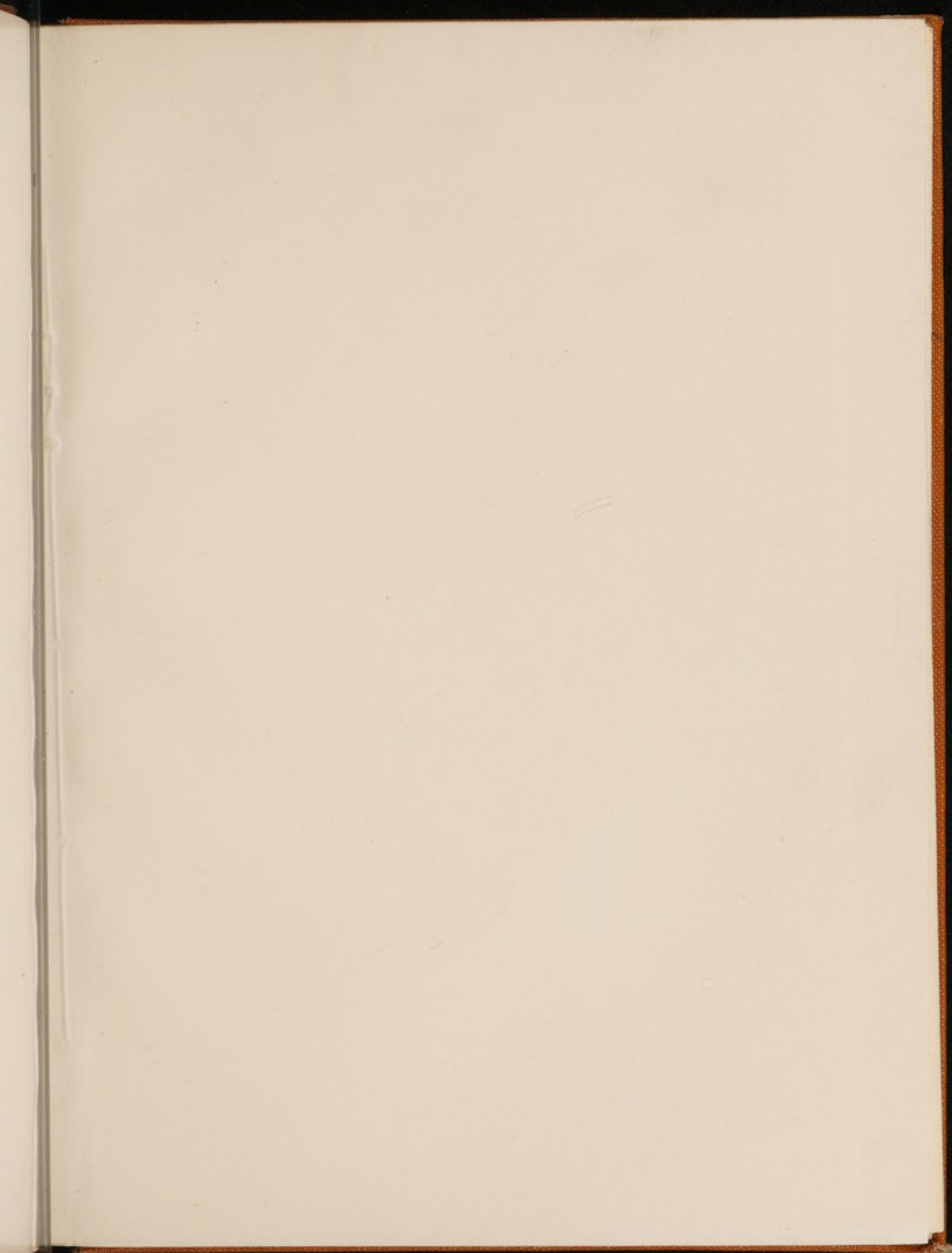

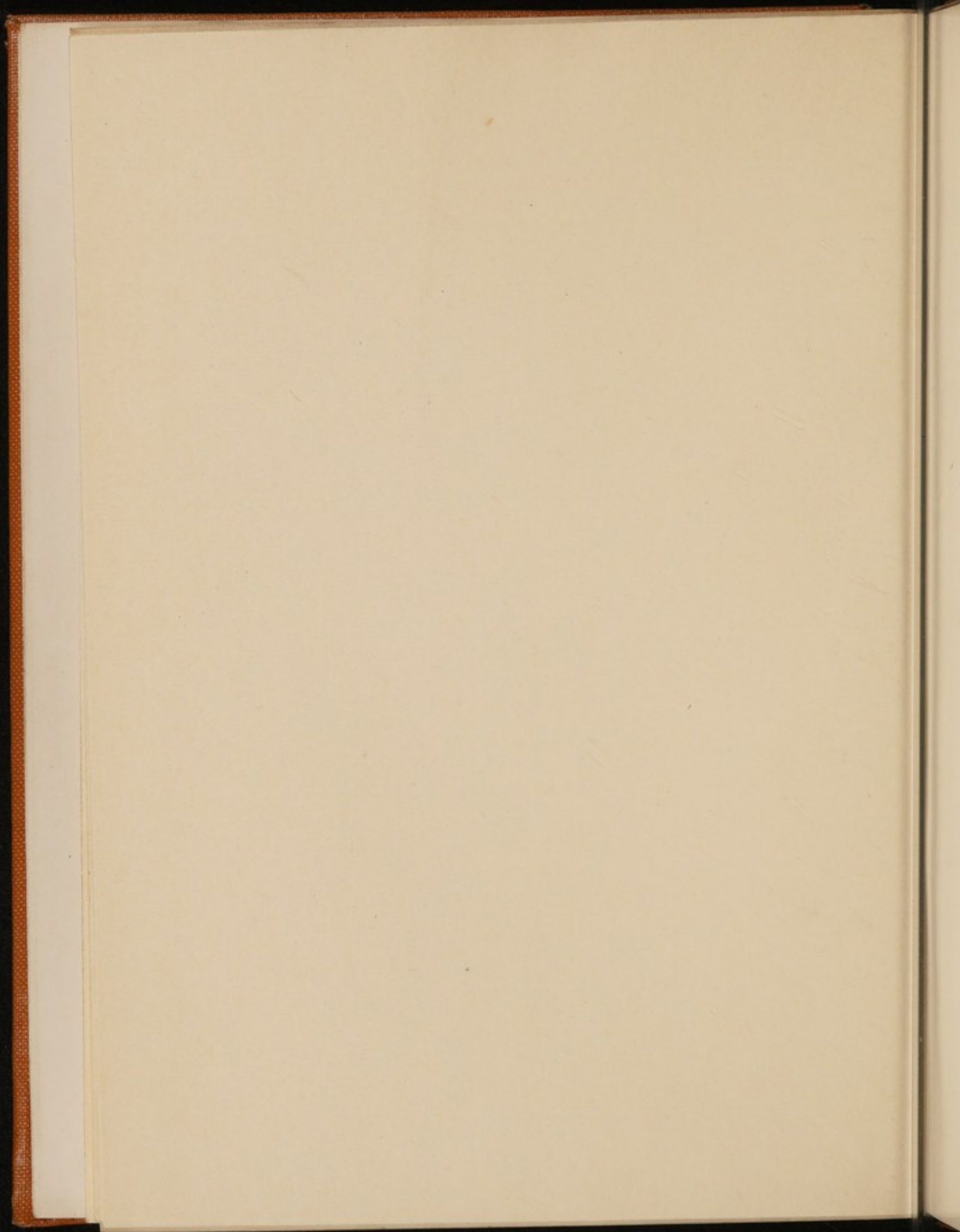

said Hospitalls; The said respective Committees in the said severall counties, are likewise to call the Treasurers for maimed Souldiers, Clerks of the Peace, Treasurers for Hospitalls, and every other person and persons in the said severall counties, who have any moneys in their hands, which ought to be imployed for the maintenance of maymed Souldiers, or of the said Hospitalls, or of the Goals there to an accompt, And are with all convenient speed from time to time to represent the said abuses and defects; and what monies are remaining in any of the said persons hands, to be imployed for the purposes aforesaid, unto the Committee of this House appointed to take consideration of Hospitalls. And it is further Ordered, That the ancient Rates and Levies usually paid for Goals and maimed Souldiers in the said severall counties, be  
from

from time to time assessed and collected as formerly, and be duly paid and imployed for the said uses.

Ordered, &c. That the Committees of the severall counties do take care to provide for the maintenance of such Souldiers as have been maimed in the service of the Parliament, and are of the said severall counties.

Ordered, &c. That the Committee for this House, formerly appointed for Hospitalls, be revived, And that they do sit on Thursday next in the afternoon, in the Exchequer chamber at two of the clock, and so from time to time every Thursday, and at other times as often as they shall think fit; And they are to require an accompt from time to time of the respective Committees in the severall counties, to whom the Examination of the Foundations of Hospitalls in the said counties, and of abuses in placing of persons in any of them,  
and

and the calling of Treasurers, Clerks of the Peace, and other persons who have any money in their hands for the use of any Hospitalls, Goals or maimed Souldiers were referred, of their respective proceedings: And are likewise to give directions for remedying of the said defects and abuses, and for disposing of such moneys for the uses for which the said moneys have been collected or are appointed. And it is further Ordered, That Sir William Lewes, Col: Long, Mr. Dove, Mr. Jesson, Col: Moutague and Mr. Love, are added to the said Committee.
