Hereas upon the Lords meeting after their late Receffe, finding that there are many Petitions depending in the House, and conceiving that many more may come in, which may occasion the repair and attendance of divers of His Pajesties Subjects at this place : their Lordships have thought sit, and accordingly have ordered it, That because of the danger of Infection, and because there are many publike businesses of great importance in agita-

tion, which concern the fafety and weale of the Kingdom, that all private business be deferred and put off till the thirtieth of November next. whereof their Lordchips do hereby give publike notice to the whole Kingdom, to prevent the charge and trouble which others wife the Petitioners might be put unto in repairing hither.
