An Act for Granting to His Majefty an Impofition upon all Tobacco and Sugar Imported between the Four and twentieth day of *June* One thouland fix hundred eighty five, and the Four and twentieth day of *June* One thoufand fix hundred ninety three.

Most Gracious Sovereign.



E your Majesties most Dutiful and Loyal Subjects the Commons Assembled in Parliament, for a further Supply for the Repairs of the Naby, and Provide-

ing Stores for the Navy and Ordnance, and payment of the Debt due to His late Majellies Servants and Family, and F 2 other

other Pour Dajefties weighty and im= portant Occasions, have Chearfully and Unanimoully giben and granted unto Pour Dajelty an Aid and Affistance to be Railed and Levied upon all Tobacco and Sugar to be Imported into Pour Da= jefties Kingdom, according to fuch Rates, and during fuch Time, and in fuch Manner and Form as herein after followeth. And we do humbly befrech Pour Dajefty that it may be Enacted : And be it Enact= ed by the Kings most Ercellent Bajelty, by, and with the Advice and Confent of the Lozds Spiritual and Tempozal, and of the Commons in this prefent Parlia= ment Allembled, and by the Authouty of the fame, That for all forts of Lobacco; as allo for all forts of Sugar, which at any time after the Four and twentieth day of June, in the year of our Lozd Due thousand fir hundled eighty and fibe, and befoze the Four and twentieth day of June, which thall be in the year of our 12020 God Dne thousand fir hundred ninety and thie, thall be Imported into England or Wales, oz the Lown and Post of Berwick upon Tweed, there thall be duly answer= ed and paid to his Dajelly the farther Rates and Duties hereafter mentioned (that is to fay) for all forts of Tobacco of the Growth and Production of any of Dis Majeflies Plantations, Iflands oz Territozies in America, Three pence for every Pound weight thereof, above what IL

it now pays; and for every Bound weight of Spanish oz Fozeign Tobacco, not of the English Plantations, Sir pence above what it now pays; And for all Muscovade Sugar of the afozefaid Blantations. Ifland, Landsoz Territories, One far= thing the Pound Weight above what it now pays; and for every yound weight of Sugar of the English Plantations, made fit for Common ule or Spending, Thee farthings above what it now pays; And for every pound weight of Muscovade Sugar of Brazile oz any other Foreign part not of English Plantations, One half veny above what it now pays; and foz all Panele Sugar, Die half penny the Pound weight above what it now pays; and for every Pound weight of Fozeign white powder Sugar, Due penny farthing above what it now pays; And for all foreign Sugar Imported in the Loaf, Thick pence the pound weight above what it now pays: 2111 which Duties to be paid for any the Commodis ties aforefaid Imported as aforefaid, fall from time to time, and at all times du= ring the continuance of this Act be levied on the Confumptioner of the faid Commodifies in England oz Wales, oz Town of Berwick upon Tweed, to be paid in man= ner following; (that is to fay) The Importer, Derchant, Planter or other that thall Import the faid Gods, if he be a Retailer, Consumptioner of Shop= (F Reever

Reéper dealing in those Commodities, the Duties afozesaid shall be paid and satisfied by such Impozter, Shop-keeper, Retailer oz Consumptioner upon the Impozting oz Landing of his oz their Gods, and befoze he oz they be permitted oz suffered to carry away his oz their Gods from the Custom-house oz other place in the Pozt in which they may happen to be Landed oz brought on Shoze.

And be it further Enacted, That every Derchant of Importer that is not a Retailer, Confumptioner oz Shopkeeper, dealing in those Commodities after En= try of his of their Goods by Bill under his or their bands, or the band of fuch perfon from whom he or they thall engage to be aufwerable prefently, before he or they be admitted or vermitted to have any Marrant to receive his of their Goods out of the Ship, of from the Mater-fide, Mall become bound unto his Maielty with one 02 moze fufficient Sureties, 02 procure Two other perfons to become bound to his Majetty in fuch Sums of Money as thall amount to the value of the Duties hereby impoled upon his or their Goods, with Condition, That he of they thall not and will not deliver, oz caufe oz fuffer a= ny of the faid Gods to be delivered unto any of the Buyers thereof, oz put oz deli= vered into the Cultody oz Policiion of a= ny Retailer, Confumptioner, oz Shop= keeper dealing in the faid Commodities, befoze

before fuch time as the Duty imposed by this Act upon his or their faid Goods be first duly paid and fatisfied, or that in cafe he thall not Sell oz Erpozt the fame before the expiration of Eighteen months from the Importation thereof, that he will pay all and every the Duties impo= fed by this Act, and that every Derchant oz other Impozter of any the Commodi= ties liable to the Duties imposed by this An after he hath entred his Gods, and given 2Bond as aforefaid, Mall after= wards upon Sale of all of any part of the same under his own hand, or the Hand of fuch perfon for whom he or they thall be responsible, Certifie in Writing the Quantity and Quality and Weight of his Goods fold, with the Pame of the 2Buyer, who bringing and delivering of the fame to the next Office appointed for the Collection of this Duty, chall then and there pay the Duties aforefaid, of the Goods to Certified to be fold unto the Df= ficer appointed to receive the fame, who thereupon thall give him a Receipt for fuch his Duties paid, and a Certificate to be left with the Derchant Importer of the papment of the fame, and no Derchant Im= porter aforefaid, before his Receipt of fuch Certificate of Payments of the Duties as afozefaid, chall deliber oz caufe to be De= libered, noz Buyer noz any other perfon receive all of any fuch Goods, upon pain of forfeiture of double Duties impoled by

by this Act, oz the value of the Gods fo delivered and received; which Fozfei= ture the faid Impozter and Receiver that each of them be liable unto.

And be it further Enacted, That a Barter, Truck, o2 Erchange of one Goods fo2 another, shall to all intents and purposes be deemed and reputed a Sale, and the Duties presently paid fo2 both Commodities, if they be both liable thereunto, o2 fo2 such of the Commodities as are liable, upon pain of fo2feit= ing by the Parties Bartering, Truck= ing, o2 Erchanging, as in case of not paying the Duties fo2 the like Goods up= on the Sale of them.

Provided always, That where the first Buyer of Receiver of the faid Godsin Truck, 2Barter oz Erchanger Does buy oz receive the faid Gods with intent to Erport the fame, in fuch cafe the Importer thall certifie in writing, the Quantity and Quality, and weight of the Gods Sold of Bartered, with the Pame of the Buy= er, oz 2Barterer, 10ho bzinging and beli= bering of the fame unto the Chief Officer oz Officers, in the next Office appointed for the Collection of this Duty, Mall then and there enter into 250nd with Sure= ties and Penalty of double Duties as aforelaid, to Erport the lame bona fide within the space of four months, who thereupon hall gibe him a Certificate of fuch Bond Entred, into the which Certificate, tje

He Mall deliber to the Derchant Jupoz= ter, and by vertue of the fame, receive Poffellion of the Gods; and fuch Certi, ficate being produced by the Importermall Difcharge his Account for fo much, as if the Duties had been paid, the which 2Bond for the Exportation of the Gods fo Entred into, thall again be Difcharged and Clacated by the Certificate of his Dajefties Searcher, oz Under Dearcher in the Port of London, and of the Searcher of any other of the Dut-Ports, certifying the Shipping of the fame, and the Der= chant of Derchants Dath that the fame have not again bein re-landed in England 02 Wales, 02 Town of Berwick upon Tweed; For which Dath and Certificate no fre is to be taken.

And be it further Enacted by the Authouty aforefaid, That the Commission= ers, oz chief Managers and Collectors appointed for the Collecting of this Duty respectively, and in their leveral and re= fpect ve Offices once every Their months without fail, oz oftner if they thall fee caufe, thall take care for the Balancing and Adjusting of the Derchants their Import Accounts, by calling them, and requiring them and every of them, to bring and deliver to them respectively a particular Account of all the Goods and Derchandize liable to this Duty, Which that be then remaining in his of their hands at the time he of they thall be fo called 劧

called upon, and required; And if any fuch Derchant, Jupozter oz other per= fon thall upon notice given him of them, or upon notice or fummons left at his or their usual place of abode of habitation, warning him oz them thereunto, refule or neglea to give in fuch Account for the space of Fourteen Days after such notice, warning, of fummons as aforefaid, Eve= ry fuch Berchant og Impozter hall then be liable to the Payment of the full Duty of all the Goods he hall fand duly Charged within his of their Import Account, and thall pay the fame within Fourteen days next after following, at the furthelt; D2 in default thereof every fuch ger= chant Importer thatt forfeit double the balue of all the Duties of fuch Goods as fall be found refting and remaining on his Impost Account, and hall ever after be incapable of taking up any Gods liable to this Duty, in any Post of this Realm, for his own, or any other ule, without Payment down of the Duty of fuch Goods, as if he were a Retailer, Con= fumptioner, oz Shopkeeper dealing in fuch Goods ; 2But if fuch Jupozter Chall upon Demand, oz within Fourteen Days after, gibe in fuch Account as afozefaid, then the faid Commissioners, Collectors, oz chief Managers of this Duty may (if they fee caufe fo to do) appoint Due oz moze Officer oz Officers to Enter into all the Cellars, Warehouses, Store Cellars,

oz other places whatfoever belonging to fuch Importer, to Search, See, and Try by taking an Account of the quanti= ty and quality of the Gods and Der= chandize therein remaining, whether fuch Importers Remainder do agree with his Account, or no, and to make Report thereof to the faid Commissioners, of Col= leaois respectively; Which Report of fuch Officer oz Officers, in cafe of Differences between the Remainder and Account of fuch Derchant, mall be reputed, taken and efteemed for the true and juft remain= der, according to which the faid Commif= fioners of Collectors mall proceed in ma= king up his Account: And then such Amporter making Dath before the faid Commiffioners, Collectors, or chief Da= nagers of this Duty respectively, that the Goods and Merchandize, remaining, viewed by the Officer oz Officers afoze= faid, and all other Gods Shipt out by him oz others, by which his Account is to be Difcharged, were all and every part and parcel of them fuch Goods and Der= chandize as had been bona fide formerly Imported by himfelf, and Entred in the Office appointed for the fame, and there Charged on his proper Import Account, and that the faid Gods and Derchan= dizes found to remaining had not been fold oz altered, either Directly oz indirectly, in their property fince the first Juppoz= tation and bringing in of the fame into this

this Realm, the faid Commiffioners, Col= lectors, or chier Managers of this Duty; thall fettle and adjust the aforefaid Im= porters Accounts accordingly; But if a= ny Derchant Importer atorelaid thall refule to permit any Dificer of Dificers Authoused by Marrant from the Com= millioner of Commillioners for the Col= leating of this Duty in the day time, to Enter into oz Search his oz their Cellars, Marchoules, Storchoules, Store-Cellars, of other places, and to take an Ac= count of the quality and quantity of his and their Goods therein remaining, Ebe= ry fuch Derchant Mall for every fuch re= fulal, fozfeit Dne hundzed pounds; and if permitting Entrance and Searchas afozefaid, mall neverthelefs refuse to make Dath that the Goods and Merchandize bie wed and feen, and the wn unto the Df= ficer and Officers as afozefaid, oz Shipt out as aforefaid, were all of them Jm= ported by himfelf from beyond the Seas, and Entred upon his Jimport Account in the Difice appointed for this Duty, and without any alteration of property, all and every fuch Goods full be efteemed and reputed the Goods and Derchandize of fome other then fuch Importer, and therefore not at all to be reckoned in Difcharge of his Account; And if fuch Der= chant hall make Dath, and pet hall neglect of refuse for the space of Fourteen days following after the doing thereof, to pay

pay and fatisfie such Duties as by this Act shall be due and payable thereupon, every such Importer his Bond given upon Entry of those Goods which he found wanting, shall be returned into the Erchequer, there to be Profecuted according to the course of Law, and shall not afterwards upon his or their Importation of Goods into any Port of this Realm, be permitted to take up, Land, or Lay on Shore his or their Goods before Payment down of the full Duties by this Act Imposed unto the Officer appointed to receive the same at the Port where his Goods shall arrive or be brought in.

Provided always, And it is hereby De= clared, That the Importers Accounts thall be discharged by Erportations by him made, for which he thall produce Certificate under the hands of his Maje= flies Searcher of Under-Searcher, in the Port of London, and of the Searcher of any other of the Dut-Ports, Certifying the Shipping out of the same, And his or their Dath that the same have not been again Re-landed in England, Wales, or Town of Berwick upon Tweed.

Provided allo, That every Importer who chall be Retailer, Confumptioner, or Sho pkeeper, dealing in the Commodities aforefaid, who are to pay down the aforefaid Duty upon such his Importation, chall upon his Exportation of the faid Commodities, within the space of T Eighteen

Eighteen months next after such his Importation, be Repaid the Duties so by him paid down upon his Importation of the same, by the Officer appointed to Receive the said Duty.

And forasimuch as the Commodities aforelaid are liable to Damage on the Seas, And whereas by the Act of Tonnage and Poundage, and the Rules and Instructions for Collecting his Maje= lites Duties arising thereby. It is directed that Allowance be made for Damage by Salt=water or otherwise.

Be it further Enaged by the Authority aforelaid, That no Importer of the Commodifies chargeable by this Act, chall be charged for any greater Proportion of the Goods herein mentioned, duly Entred at the Custom-House, then what shall remain Peat after such Allowance or A= batement.

And foralimuch as the Commodities a= forelaid are liable to walke and decay, during the time they may remain in the hands of the Importer, before the Sale or Exportation of the fame, the aforelaid Commissioner or Commissioners, Collect= ors, or chief Danagers of this Duty, are hereby Imporbered and Authorized to make such further Allowance for the fame, as to their Indoments shall feem meet, considering the Circumstances of the Commodities, and the time of their lying by in considering of all Dama= ors,

ges; want of Weight, Diminut on, of Prejudice whatloever that may happen to the faid Commodities : Provided such Allowance creed not Eight Pounds per Cent. in the whole, for all Caules whatsover.

And whereas it is Provided, That this Duty be Collected on the Retailer, Con= fumptioner, oz Shopkeeper Ttading in the faid Commodities Importing the fame, oz on the firft Buyer not Ervozting the fame, as is before declared : 2Be it fur= ther Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That in cafe the Merchant oz others Jm= porting the fame (who shall be admitted to receive Pollellion of his Gods on Se= curity, as aforefaid) mall not clear his or their Import Account, either by Sales or Erportation, as aforefaid, within the Term of Eighteen Months, from the time of the Importation of the faid Gods; he of they the faid Importer or Importers hall be charged with the Duty Impoled by this Aa on the Com= modifies aforefaid, and Anfwer and Pay the fame as if the faid Gods had then ben Sold for Retail, although the faid Gods mall fill remain without any Alteration of Property in his or their Bands; Any thing in this Act to the contrary not with= ftanding; Provided always, That in fuch Caufe Allowance be made for Mafte and Decay in the manner already probided foz.

And

And to the end that all Importers, Merchants, and perfons concerned in the Payment of the Duties aforelaid, may know to whom, and where to pay the fame, and to make Entry of their Gods, in manner as by this Act is intended ; It is hereby Enanco, That his Majelly may from time to time fominate, Com= millionate, and Authozize fuch Commif= fioner oz Commiffioners, Collectoz oz Col= lectors, or other Dfficer or Dfficers, as be thall think fit to Manage, Collect and Levy the faid Duties in every Port of the Kingdom, which faid Commissioners, Collectors, or other Dfficer or Dfficers fo appointed, thall duly attend at the Cu= ftom houfe, oz other place publickly ap= pointed in the Post of Place to which he oz they thall be refpectively appointed at the usual hours and times in which the Officers of the Cuftoms to oz ought to attend, and there thall Do and Grecute whatfoever ought to be Done and Erecu= ted on his of their parts purfuant to the Truft reposed in him oz them, according to the true intent and meaning of this Art.

And be it further Enacted by the Au= thosity afosefaid, That no Perchant os Perchants, os any other Perfon os Per= fons Whatfoever Entring any Gods, Wares and Perchandizes from beyond the Seas, that are liable to the Duties im= pofed by this Act, thall Enter his os their Com=

Commodities in any other then the Mame of the true Impozter of the faid Commo= dities; 1202 Chall make ule of any Manie of any Person whatsoever to Colour his oz their Goods, whether it be with oz without the confent of fuch perfon, upon pain of forfeiture of double Duties on fuch Gods to found or discovered to be Entred of Coloured contrary to the true meaning hereof. And for the better Le= bying and Collecting all and every of the faid Duties imposed by this 21ct, and pre= benting the many Frauds and Deceits which may be had and used by evil difpo= fed perfons, and undue practices to elude this Act, We it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That no Gods, Mares of Derchandizes liable to the Du= ties by this Act imposed, thall from and after the faid four and twentieth day of June in the year of our Lozd Dne thou= fand fir hundred eighty and fibe, during the continuance of this Act, be discharg= edoz laidon Landout of any Ship, 2Bot= tom, Doy, Bark, Lighter, Boat of Aeffel whatloever, oz put off from any Wharf, Key, oz Place, oz Land into any Ship, 2Bottom, Doy, 2Bark, Lighter, 250at oz other Aeffel whatfoever, but only in fuch manner and at fuch times and places, and no otherwife then the faid Gods oz Derchandizes may oz ought to be Unflipped, Unladen og put into any Ship oz other Aleffel to be laid on Shoze

oz Laden, put off from Land into any Ship oz other Aleffel by bertue of and according to the true intent and meaning of the feveral Laws and Statutes made and Enaced for the payment of his Da= fefties Cuftoms and Sublidies of Ton= nage and poundage, and for Collecting and Levying the faid Duties; And for prebenting Frauds, and regulating #= bufes in his Dajefties Cuftoms, and all the Claules, Penalties and Forfeitures mentioned in the aforefaid Aas against Mallers of Ships, Wharfingers, Seamen and 2Boatmen, Carmen and Porters, thall be to all intents and purpoles in full force touching and concerning any of the Gods and Derchandifes mentioned in this Act, and the Duties impofed there= upon (as well in relation to their Land= ing at their Importation as at the Load= ing of the fame at Exportation, as alfo for their carrying at any time Coali wife from one Post to another) as if the fame were herein particularly and at large Recited ; And the Commiflioner oz Commissioners, Collerroz oz Collerrozs, Df= ficer oz Officers appointed as afozelaid for the Collecting of this Duty, are here= by impowerd for the better Collecting the Duties hereby imposed, and therein a= boiding all frauds and undue practices, with all the Powers and Authouties the Commiffioners, Collectors or Officers of the Cuttom-houfe have, og may have, by vertue

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That all Penalties and forfeitures incurred by vertue of this An, Mall and may be recovered by Action of Debt, 2Bill, Plaint oz Information in Dis Dajeffies Court of Erchequer, og in any of his Majefties Courts of Re= cord at Westminster : And that one Doiety of all penalties and forfeitures herein mentioned thatt be to the Kings Dajetty, his beirs and Succeffors, and the other Doiety to fuch perfon oz perfons as thall Sue for the fame, wherein no Elloign, Protection or Ilager of Law Gall be al= lowed, or any more then one Imparlance; Brobided always, That no perfon or perfons mall Sue for the aforefaid pe= nalties oz fozfeitures but fuch Dfficer oz Officers as thall be appointed by his Majefty, oz by any Authozity derived from him for the management of his Cu= ftoms, of the Duties impoled by this Art. And be it hereby allo Enacted, That all Dfficers, Deputies, Clerks oz Serbants which thall have any Office of Emptoy= ment in the Managing, Collecting of attending upon the Collection of this Duty, thall before their Entring upon their respective Offices, Trufts oz Em. ployments, take their respective Coppozal Daths for the due and faithful Erecution and Discharge to the best of their know= ledae

40 ledge and power of the several Trusts and Employments committed to their Charge befoze the Commissioners oz Thief . Managers of the Cuitoms of this Duty, oz befoze the Cuftomer oz Comptroller in any Dut-Port of the Ringdom : And if any Commodity feized for any Dffence committed against this Act, shall be claimed by any Person whatsoever, or any Personal Information thall be brought or commenced against any perfon for the recovering of the Duties or For= feitures granted by this Art, the Onus probandi, of the proof whether the Duties thereof be paid or fecured, chall lie upon the Claimer, oz Defendant, and chall not be incumbent on his Dajelty, oz any 1020= fecuto2 02 Informer on behalf of his Dafefty oz himfelf; provided fuch Seizure oz Information be made or brought by Dfficers of perfons imployed in his Majellies Cuftoms, oz the Duties ariling by vertue of this Act.
