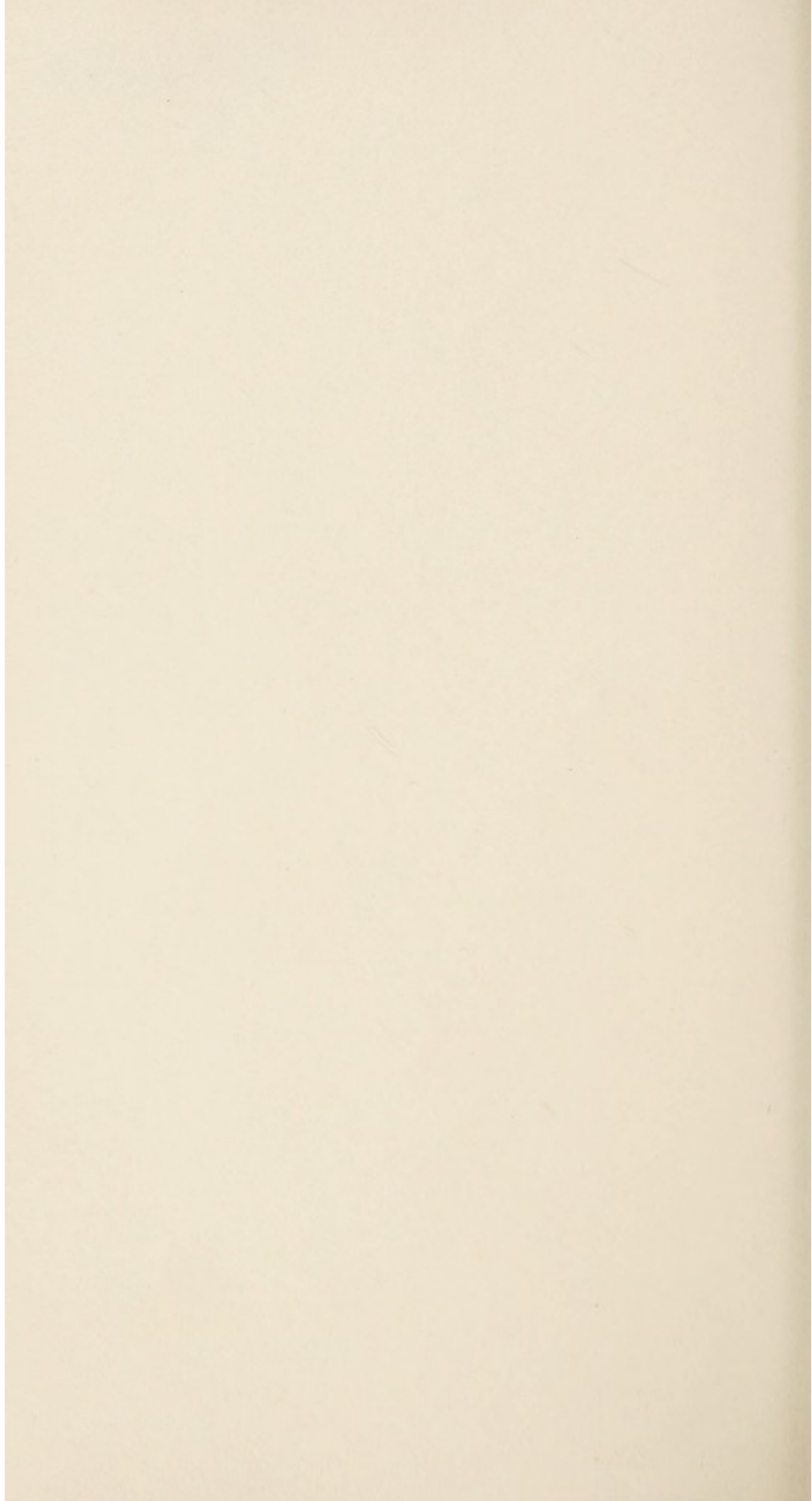

**Y**OU are desired to meet the rest of the GOVERNORS and GUARDIANS of the Hospital for the Maintenance and Education of Exposed and Deserted *Young Children*, on *Wednesday* the 10th Day of *May*, 1780, at the said Hospital in *Lamb's-Conduit-Fields*, at Eleven of the Clock in the Forenoon, to hold the Annual General Meeting of this Corporation, pursuant to the Directions of his late MAJESTY's *Royal Charter*, for the Election of a PRESIDENT, VICE-PRESIDENTS, TREASURER, GENERAL COMMITTEE, and SECRETARY.

At Four o'Clock the same Day will be the Annual Dinner of the GOVERNORS, at the said Hospital in *Lamb's-Conduit-Fields*. And, as a sufficient Number of Waiters will be provided, you are desired to send away your Servant.

N. B. *If you please to take a Ticket for Dinner, the Messenger will supply you at Half a Guinea; or you may be furnished at the Hospital in Lamb's-Conduit-Fields.*



THE  
METHOD OF ELECTION.

**E**LECTIONS are made by Ballot: Two Scrutineers are nominated, and chosen by the Majority of Hands present, before the Ballot begins, which is at Eleven o'Clock in the Forenoon; and at Two in the Afternoon the Ballot shall be closed.

When any Governor offers to vote, his Name is mark'd in the List of Governors, by the Secretary; and he is to deliver the List of the Names of the Persons he votes for, to the Person who presides, who shall immediately put it into a proper Glass.

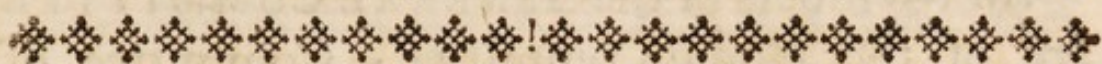
The *President*, Six *Vice-Presidents*, and the *Treasurer*, are first chosen; and they are always of the General Committee.

When they are chosen, fifty-four other of the Governors are elected; who with them constitute the General Committee, for managing and transacting the Affairs of the Hospital the Year ensuing, and till others shall be chosen in their Room.

In the Election, every List containing the Names of more than two Thirds of the Persons which were elected the preceding Year, shall be totally rejected.

All Disputes concerning the Election of this Committee are determined by the Majority of the Governors present.

When the General Committee is chosen, the *Secretary*, *Preacher*, *Reader*, and *Organist*, are also chosen by Ballot.

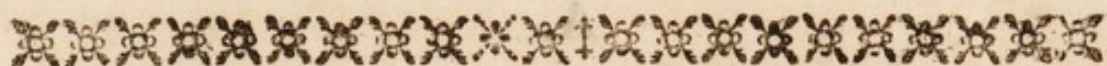

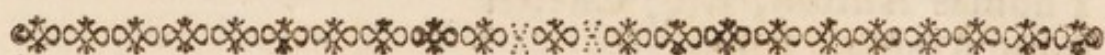

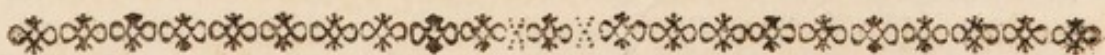
