AND FURTHER, WE DO for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, Declare and Grant, that you Our said Commissioners, and every of you, shall be only Accountable and Answerable to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, for your own Respective Receipts, Actings or Doings; and not for the Receipts, Actings or Doings of one another; or of the Treasurer hereby Appointed, or to be Appointed.
