# EIGHTEENTH ANNUAL REPORT,

## **St. George's & St. James's Dispensary.**

ON presenting this, their Eighteenth Annual Report of the Proceedings of the St. George's and St. James's Dispensary, the Committee are enabled to congratulate the Subscribers in general, upon the continued efficiency of their charitable work ; as will appear by the annexed Table.

The number of patients prescribed for during the past year (many of whom were visited) being 1915 : 466 of these afflicted persons, now remain on the Books of the Institution, a very great proportion of the rest having been either relieved or cured. It will be seen that 41,053 individuals have applied for medical or surgical aid since the 17th of February, 1817, when this truly useful Charity was established.

The Committee, before proceeding further, hasten to return their sincere thanks to the Rev. ALLEN COOPER, for the sum of 37*l.* 3*s.* 2*d.*, given to the Fund through his benevolent instrumentality, on the occasion of his

preaching an eloquent and persuasive sermon at St. Mark's Chapel, in February last.

They desire to acknowledge, on the part of the Subscribers, a liberal donation of 10*l.* 10*s.* from T. FORBES BENTLEY, Esq., also the sum of 5*l.* from "A Friend," by the Rev. J. C. WIGRAM, and a similar amount kindly presented by Mr. ROCHFORD. And while they make grateful mention of these fresh acts of generosity, they deplore the great loss sustained by the Charity, in the untimely death of Mr. SNODGRASS, one of its Vice Presidents, and always a munificent and liberal benefactor.

An inspection of the state of the Funds of the Dispensary will show, that the total receipts of the Year 1834, amounted to 518*l.* 19*s.*; whereas the expenditure was 634*l.* 19*s.* 3*d.*

In conclusion, the Committee urgently request the numerous Friends of the Dispensary to aid them in making known, on every suitable occasion, the benefits which such an Institution is calculated to afford, and that as fellow labourers in so good a cause, all may have a share in extending the advantages of a plan, which, at a comparatively small expense, to those who have happily the inclination, as well as the power to befriend, brings valuable relief to the poor and afflicted, in their hour of need.

## REGULATIONS.



I. II. Those giving Ten Guineas at one time, or paying that sum within the year, become Life Governors, with the privilege of having always one Patient on the books, and one lying-in Patient during the year. Subscribers of Twenty Guineas may have two Patients at one time, and give two lying-in Letters in the year ; and so on in proportion for larger donations.

III. Upon payment of a legacy of Fifty Pounds, or upwards, to this Institution, the Executor first named in the Will shall be made a Life Governor.

IV. Any Minister in whose church or chapel the sum of twenty pounds has been collected, by a charity sermon, is an Honorary Governor, so long as he remains Minister of the same church or chapel.

V. At elections, Ladies only can vote by proxy: whilst Gentlemen, to give their vote, must attend the ballot personally; all being Governors three months previously.
