READER.

They might be thought of very little use, and even superfluous, after the publication of Dr. Gronovius's Flora Virginica: but my plan was to give to the English reader a short enumeration of the American plants with English names: At the same time I added some few plants which are but lately discovered, and were not known by Dr. Gronovius. The economical and medicinal uses of some plants are another addition.

Having published a Catalogue of North American animals, my friends thought an enumeration of plants executed in the same manner, would contribute much towards promoting the study of the natural history of North America, and this was my chief motive for publishing this performance, and to join it to the Fauna Americae Septentrionalis.

These two pamphlets together will make a kind of appendix to Kalm's Travels, which might be bound up with one of the volumes: and the frequent quotations of Dr. Gronovius, Sloane and Catesby, in this Flora of North America, shew evidently, that it can be considered as an Index to them, so far as they describe or represent North American plants.

The English names are a very laborious work, and it is evident that I found myself obliged to make many new ones. This proceeded not from the vanity of being equal to this task, but rather from necessity. I have however consulted thereupon the best authors; and the analogy of the German and Dutch dialects, both nearly related to the English.

The utility of these English names is greater than one is aware of at first sight. They enrich the language, and fix those vague denominations of plants which cause so great a confusion and dryness in the study of botany, a science already too much charged with names, and bring it more â la portée of every man who should like to know plants without learning the scientific names and the Latin language. How far I have succeeded in this attempt I leave to the enlightened public to judge of.

In the Catalogue of North American animals are some omitted, and some discovered since the publication that pamphlet, and I therefore found it most convenient to put them here by way of supplement.
