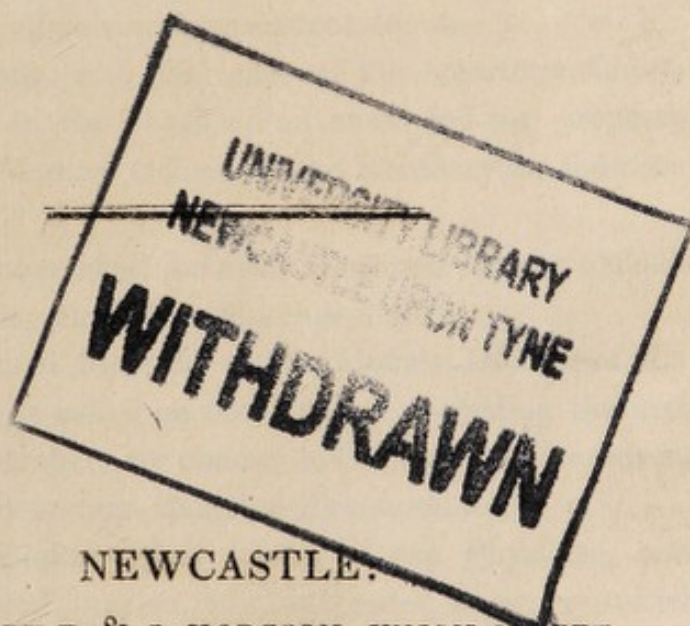

Resolutions, &c.

At a meeting of the Medical Officers of the Newcastle Infirmary, called to consider the propriety of establishing a Medical Library in that Hospital, the following Resolutions and Rules were proposed and agreed to:—

I.—It is highly expedient to establish such an Institution, both with the view of affording facilities for study to the Profession at large, and for fixing for the reception of presents and bequests an eligible and permanent depot.

II.—The Books, with the leave of the Quarterly Court, shall be placed in the Physician's Room, and the property invested in the Medical Officers of the Infirmary for the time being.

III.—The Room shall be open from two to four o'clock every day, Sunday and Thursday excepted.

IV.—An Annual Meeting of the Medical Officers of the Infirmary shall be called on the Monday preceding the first Thursday in October, to choose a Committee, Treasurer, Librarian, and Secretary, examine Accounts, &c.

V.—The Committee shall consist of one Physician, one Surgeon, and the Librarian, who shall meet, or be consulted concerning the Books recommended, &c. on the 24th of every month.

VI.—The Librarian shall have the charge of the Library, and shall keep a Register of all applications for Books and

Pamphlets, and of all delivered out to Members or returned by them. And as soon as any Book or Pamphlet is brought into the Library, it shall be given to him whose application stands first on the list. He shall also examine the Books returned, and inform the Committee of any damage they may have suffered, in order that Fines may be inflicted at the discretion of the Committee, where needful.

VII.—The Committee shall be allowed to sell, for the purposes of the Library, any Books of which they have obtained duplicates.

VIII.—A Catalogue of all the Books and Pamphlets shall be kept in the Library, and such as are received as presents, shall have the Donor's name inserted.

IX.—Any person may become a Subscriber to this Library on compliance with the following Rules: none of which, or of the preceding, can be altered or expunged, but at a Meeting of the Medical Officers of the Infirmary.

Rule 1.—Every Subscriber must pay an Annual Subscription to the Treasurer of one guinea, unless he be a Student, when he is required to pay half-a-guinea, on or before the first Monday in October.

2.—Any Subscriber who does not pay his Subscription within the time specified, shall be considered as having virtually ceased to be a Subscriber.

3.—Any Subscriber shall be allowed to receive out of the Library one Book or Pamphlet at a time, and keep them according to the following Regulations, viz.—In the town and immediate vicinity, all Books in octavo and under may be kept a fortnight;—those in quarto three weeks;—and those in folio a month. But in the country, each of the forementioned Books may be kept six days longer than above specified.

4.—Two or more Books, if not new, may be taken out together, but must be returned in the time allowed for one;

and no book can be taken out a second time by the same person till the expiration of a week after its return.

5.—Whoever detains Books or Pamphlets longer than the limited time, shall forfeit two pence a day for every Book or Pamphlet so detained; but no such Fines shall rise higher than five shillings, or the value of the Book or Pamphlet, which shall in every instance be returned.

6.—Any Subscriber taking away any Book or Pamphlet, without the knowledge of the Librarian, shall no longer be accounted a Subscriber.

7.—Any Subscriber taking away a Book or Pamphlet from the Library, shall be answerable for the full value of it; and if he should lose or damage it, shall make such remuneration as shall satisfy the Committee.

8.—No Dictionary or Book of Plates shall be taken out of the Library without the leave of the Committee—and under conditions at their discretion.

9.—Any Subscriber may recommend Books in a Book kept in the Library for that purpose.

The Subscribers are requested to observe, that it is by no means intended that the Room, where the Books are deposited, should be a Reading Room, in the ordinary acceptance of that term, but that the Books should be merely applied for, or occasionally consulted, within the specified hours.
