



THE FOLLOWING ARE THE

GENERAL RULES OF THE ASSOCIATION.

I.—This Association shall be called "The Belfast Juvenile Association, Auxiliary to the Ulster Society for promoting the Education of the Deaf and Dumb, and the Blind."

II.—The Association shall consist of Annual Members, a Treasurer, and Secretaries.

III. The object of the Association shall be, to collect Funds in aid of the purposes of the Parent Society.

IV.—Every person, approved of by the Committee, and who shall collect the sum of Ten Shillings annually, shall be a member of this Association.

V.—At every election for Pupils, each member shall be entitled to one vote for the first Ten Shillings, and one vote for every additional Five Shillings contained in the sum paid to the Treasurer.

VI.—The business of the Association shall be managed by a Committee of not more than thirteen Members, a Treasurer, and Secretaries (who shall be Members of Committe ex-officio), to be chosen annually, three of whom attending shall constitute a quorum. The Committee to have the power to fill up vacancies; and it shall be a special object with them to endeavour to form Branches in the several Schools in Belfast, for the purpose of furthering the objects of the Association.

The Funds of this Association will be applied exclusively to the education, maintenance, and clothing of Deaf and Dumb Boarders, and of Blind Pupils, as Day Scholars, at the Institution, who shall be elected by the Members of the Association, at special Meetings to be convened for the purpose, prior to which printed lists of the several Candidates will be furnished, and each member shall have the privilege of voting according to the amount of his or her collection, as per Rule V.

Collecting Cards may be obtained by applying to the Secretaries personally, or through any individual already a Member.

MINUTES

PROCEEDINGS OF THE THIRD ANNUAL MEETING

OF THE MEMBERS AND FRIENDS OF THE JUVENILE ASSOCIATION,

Held in the New School-Room of the Fisherwick-Place Church, on Friday, the 15th November, 1839.

REV. JAMES MORGAN IN THE THE CHAIR.

At half-past six o'clock, about 240 Collectors and friends assembled at tea; after

which, the collections were paid in to the Treasurer.

At eight o'clock, the room was opened to the public, and filled by a respectable audience; when the Report of the Proceedings of the Committee for the past year

was read by the Secretary.
It was moved by Master Francis Calder, seconded by Master James Bris-

Tow, and unanimously resolved-

That the Report now read be received and printed, with such appendix as the

Committee may deem necessary.

As it appeared by the Report, and Abstract of the Treasurer's Account, that the state of the Funds would warrant the admission of two additional Pupils, a Ballot was then taken for the election of two out of the fifteen eligible Candidates, when Eliza Ingram and John M'Namara were declared duly elected.

The Chairman then drew the attention of the meeting to the fact, that, before the return of the next Annual Meeting, two of the rejected applicants would be past the age at which they could be received into the Institution; and took occasion therefrom to recommend, that a General Meeting of the Association should be held on the next Easter Monday, in a tent in the Botanic Gardens, if the Managers would allow; and that, in the meantime, the Collectors should use their best exertions to raise funds sufficient to pay for the admission of these children.

The Chairman also read a statement of the case of a child, in Coleraine, aged seven years and ten months, whose name could not, therefore, be placed on the list, but who would be then eligible, and whose claims on Christian sympathy were

particularly strong.

The Rev. W. HAMILTON proposed that some friends should unite at once to endeavour to provide for these peculiar cases; but after some conversation, this motion was withdrawn, when it was unanimously agreed that the suggestion of

the Chairman should be acted upon.

It was then announced to the meeting that Collecting Boxes had been prepared, and were ready for distribution, at the close of the meeting; and that they were intended to aid in carrying into effect the suggestion of the Committee, brought forward in their report; namely, that in addition to the subscriptions as heretofore received and registered on the cards, members should exert themselves to obtain small donations, even of a penny from each person, for these Boxes.

It was then moved by Master GEORGE HILL, seconded by Master MURPHY, and Resolved unanimously: ---

That the following young gentlemen be the Office Bearers for the ensuing

year .- (For List see page 2.)

During the evening, the Rev. John Martin conducted an Examination of the Ten Pupils formerly elected by the Association, and their answering seemed to afford general satisfaction.

Hymns were also sung by some of the Blind Pupils of the Institution, and about ten o'clock, the meeting separated, a benediction having been pronounced

by the Chairman.

REPORT.

In proceeding to render an account of the stewardship committed to their trust at your last Annual Meeting, the Committee of the Juvenile Association desire to commence by ascribing praise to a gracious God, who has preserved them in safety during so long an interval, to meet you here this evening, and would seek the union of your silent thanksgivings with their's, inasmuch as ye have been recipients of the same goodness; that together, the incense of our heartfelt gratitude may ascend to the mercy-seat on high, perfumed with the merits and intercession of our adorable Redeemer, and draw down upon us at this time, in rich abundance, the blessings of God's Holy Spirit. And may you ever realize, by sweet experience, that your labour is a labour of love; that it is more blessed to give than to receive; and that, whilst you are engaged in watering others, by the benefits you are enabled to confer, you may yourselves be watered by influences purer and more precious far.

Your Committee trust, that in the review of the past year, they may recognize the favour of the Divine blessing resting upon the interests of your Association. Many valuable friends have espoused your cause: and wherever efforts have been made to extend the sphere of your operations, your Committee have met with the greatest liberality; and they desire here especially to acknowledge the kind reception which they invariably experienced, when, in obedience to your injunctions, measures were taken to extend your Association among the respectable schools in town. To the Principals of these Seminaries your Committee feel much indebted, for the permission granted to their Deputations to visit at the schools those who had formerly been enrolled as Collectors, and for the opportunities afforded, at the same time, for bringing before the other pupils the claims which we advocate, in the hope, that they too might be induced to unite in the furtherance of so good a cause.

During the past year, Deputations have visited your Auxiliaries in the Royal Belfast Academical Institution, (with which the branch formerly in the Rev. William Hamilton's Academy is now neces-

sarily combined), in the Belfast Academy, in Mr Blain's Seminary, and in Miss Henderson's.

Many of our former Collectors had, of course, ceased to be connected with these establishments, since last year; some having gone to business, others to their professions, and some separated by other causes: but your Committee trust, though this be the case, and though, in one sense, these friends may be passing away from the scenes of their more youthful engagements, that yet they will not suffer their connexion with this Association to cease, but that the seeds of tender interest in behalf of the Deaf and the Blind, which have been implanted during their fellowship with us, may be affectionately cherished, growing with their growth, and increasing as their years increase; so that, wherever their lot be cast, they may, throughout all after life, remain zealous and steadfast friends of the Ulster Institution.

During the last year, new Auxiliaries also have been formed in Mr Bullick's, Miss Bankhead's, and Miss M'Brair's Seminaries, with much prospect of success.

In most of these instances, it was thought right that all your pupils should accompany the Deputations, in order that the Collectors might thus, in the most forcible manner, be reminded of the responsibilities which they had already incurred, and be stirred up to fresh and increased efforts. How far these appeals have been successful, the result of this evening's meeting will principally shew. But your Committee cannot conclude this part of their Report, without recording their conviction, that much more may be yet accomplished by their successors in the further carrying out of this plan.

In the Seminaries which have already embraced your cause, there remain many young ladies and gentlemen who have not yet joined our ranks. It is believed, that not a few have been discouraged from taking collecting cards, under the impression that, so many are already engaged in this work, they would have no chance of success. It is most desirable that this erroneous impression should be removed, and that all should understand, that it is not so much from the largeness of individual collections, (though this is by no means to be despised), that we look for increased income, as to the union of numbers. Surely few in our schools could be found, who are prepared to affirm, that in 365 days, they could not collect 240 pence; yet one half of these pence would suffice to constitute a member, and entitle to a

vote. How gratifying and cheering would be the result, if each young person who could, would collect even that small amount. Let any one who is disposed to make the attempt in earnest, just try what they can do among the circle of their own family and friends, and at the end of the year they will themselves perhaps be surprised at the fruit of this simple effort. But this subject will again be adverted to, before closing the Report.

Of your Pupils, your Committee are glad in being able to furnish a pleasing and encouraging account. By the good blessing of God, all have been preserved in health and strength during the entire year. Not one of them has been confined by sickness a single day. To the very judicious treatment adopted by their kind teacher, this gratifying result may, under the Divine blessing, be mainly ascribed; and when it is remembered, that almost all Deaf mutes possess hereditary and native tendencies to delicacy of constitution, and that all your pupils, except one, have been suddenly transplanted from a country to a town life, from active to comparatively sedentary habits, it will be better understood how parental and unremitting must be the care and attention which have so successfully combated with these difficulties.

The pupils who were elected last year are, Jane Mellon, Mary Douglas, Eliza and James McCleery, and Margaret Jane Moore. With the exception of the last named, all these have made satisfactory progress. Margaret is exceedingly dull and inexpert. Although she entered the school in February, her progress, either in work or literature, is not equal, with the same pains on the part of her teachers, to what some have made in a month. The other four can all make and distinguish the written and printed, the one-handed and two-handed alphabets; can converse by signs with their teachers, and with the other members of the household on ordinary occurrences, and know a small number of common words and short sentences.

Sarah Armstrong, Samuel Carrigan, and Isabella Moore, elected in November, 1837, have made respectable proficiency. In none of them does the mind seem to be below the ordinary standard, and each excels the others in some department of learning. Sarah excels in knowledge of languages, Isabella in knitting and sewing, Samuel in signing and penmanship. They can all write letters to their friends; they know the names and uses of most common objects, and a little of the history of creation and redemption.

Robert Gilliland, and Louisa M'Connell, your earliest pupils, elected in May, 1837, are spared to meet you once more, and we hope their examination will convince you that their time has been well employed.

Some of you know their progress, by personal conversation with them, and the fact, that they are able to converse on several subjects, asking and answering questions, in a free and legible style of writing, must be peculiarly gratifying to you, who have, under God, been the means of rescuing them from a condition almost on a level with the beasts that perish, and conducting them to this state of civilization and improvement. Robert is fond of writing to his friends; while Louisa, as her parents reside in town, occupies more of her leisure hours in other useful matters. During the past year, she has improved in the knowledge of washing, cookery, sewing, and knitting, and is learning sampler stitch. Both Robert and Louisa know the Lord's Prayer, and some other simple forms of devotion, so that either of them can guide their fellow-mutes in social prayer, expressing each sentiment both by words and by signs. They have some knowledge of the order of creation, of the fall of man, and of the ten commandments: the distinction between the mineral, vegetable, and animal kingdoms, the food, clothing, use, and habits of animals. They are now learning the principal events in the Gospel history, and from some of them are able to deduce lessons, doctrinal and practical.

Your Committee think it right to notice these particulars, as a public examination, from many causes, does not always afford the best means of judging respecting the actual proficiency of the pupils—and they find few persons prepared at all to appreciate the difficulties with which the Teacher of the Deaf mute has to contend.

Mr Martin possesses, in an eminent degree, the happy art of making the children attend to their duties, more in love, than from compulsion. They all seem to enjoy both their work and their play. Before and after school hours, he frequently takes them to visit the Museum, and the Botanic Garden, (the managers of which have kindly granted free access to the pupils of the Institution) also, to the different shops and manufactories, and other objects of interest in the town and neighbourhood. About these they converse in their own way, with as much zest as children possessing all their faculties, and present at such times a most interesting and touching contrast to the sad state of the uneducated mute. The girls appear

before you in clothes, all, except their shoes, made by themselves, under the superintendence of their work-mistress, Miss Martin;—and all the children are accustomed to take part in household duties. On the whole, your Committee feel pleasure in expressing themselves perfectly satisfied with the intellectual, moral, religious, and physical treatment which your pupils continue to receive from the Rev. Mr Martin; indeed, the kindness they experience from him, is more like that which a parent is accustomed to bestow upon his own children, than what they might expect to receive from a person to whom they were lately total strangers.

It now only remains to notice the state of your funds. Your Committee are happy in being able to report a considerable increase upon the income of last year. The collections then paid in amounted to £114 4s. 9d., while the sums paid in this evening amount to £207 7s. 5d.* It now rests with you to determine, after the Treasurer's account has been read, whether or not you will proceed to the election of any of the candidates at present seeking admission. In any event, there is forced upon us the sad necessity of rejecting the greater number of those now imploring our assistance. When will the time arrive that you shall be spared this melancholy duty? for trying indeed is the case, when Christians are compelled to refuse the instruction that alone can make wise unto salvation to poor little heathens in their own land, perishing for lack of knowledge, and they too, shut out from almost every other avenue to improvement.

Whenever your Committee turn their attention to the subject of finance, which has so important a bearing upon the topic just adverted to, they cannot help being specially impressed with one feeling, which is this—a feeling of great regret that you should not bear the interests of the Deaf mute, and of the Blind, upon your hearts during the whole year, as you do during the last month of the year. Were this only done, it might be confidently asserted, that the sad necessity which we now deplore would be completely obviated, and that, instead of rejecting so many out of the list of candidates this evening, you would enjoy the delightful satisfaction of throwing open the doors of your Institution to these fifteen applicants.

Your Committee think this a fitting opportunity to remind you of a fact which has already been mentioned to many now present. A lady in Edinburgh, whose heart must have been filled with the spirit with which we long to see you more fully imbued, has, by a sustained and persevering effort, raised for the Institution for the Deaf and Dumb there, and by contributions not exceeding one

penny, from any one person, at one time, no less than £370;* and thus a sum much greater than the fruits of the combined exertions of two hundred collectors, for twelve months, has been raised by one lady, in penny pieces alone. There are few here who will not have thought of the, in some sense, noble effort made by the people of London, as recorded in our histories, who, when one of their influential friends was, as they conceived, unjustly amerced in a large sum, resolved, as an evidence of their attachment and of his deserts, to pay the whole fine in pence, no one being permitted to contribute more than a penny.

Now let there be among you some such noble combination of effort, during the year which is to come, should God spare you. Let the welfare and salvation of the poor Deaf mute and helpless Blind of our province be set before you, as a higher, more philanthropic, more benevolent object far, than that which sufficed to inspire with the enthusiasm, to which we have alluded, the breasts of the people of London; and on the records of the history of the Deaf and Dumb of Ireland, let it be inscribed in letters of gold, that great things, which we cannot venture to anticipate, have thus been accomplished.

Your Committee trust that this suggestion will not be received in vain, and in this hope have prepared a number of boxes, which may be placed upon the chimney pieces of your parlours, and thus, being constantly before your eyes, may remind you of the hints now given. These boxes are ornamented with a very appropriate and tasteful sketch of two of the pupils, which has been drawn and presented in the handsomest manner to your Association, this week, by Signor Piccini, an Italian Artist, practising his profession in this town. The little Deaf and Dumb Girl, you will recognize as one of your own pupils, and it may be hoped that the tout ensemble will have sufficient interest to prevent its being considered an unbecoming object for your mantel pieces—and that it may possess this, and many other attractions to propitiate a favourable and conspicuous place from those who rightfully take charge of such arrangements.

In conclusion, your Committee would commend themselves and you to the care of that God who has hitherto caused your feeble efforts to prosper, praying that He would ever make His face to shine upon you, and bless you; and that He, without whom nothing is strong, nothing is holy, would pardon what His pure eyes may have seen wrong in our past efforts, and graciously accept, through Jesus Christ, of whatever may have been done, with a single eye to His glory.
