just Apprehensions least the Infection might be brought into this Kingdom from the Places so infected, or other Places trading or corresponding therewith, unless timely Care were taken to predent the same: And whereas it has been found by Experience, that the said At is deserble and insufficient for the Purposes intended; and the Penaltics insided by the same not adequate to the Offences thereby prohibited; and some surther Provisions are necessary to be made, in case it hould please Aimighty God to permit these Kingdoms to be a afflicated.

afflided with the Plague : For Remedy thereof, Be it Enafted by the Kings most Excellent Bafeffp, by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Cemporal, and Commons in Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the fame. That during the prefent Infection, and in all future Times, when any Country or Place hall be infeded with the Plague, all Ships, Aeffels, Perfons, Goods, and Perchandizes what foever, coming or imported in fuch Ships or Aeffels. into any Port or Place within Great Britain, or Ireland, or the Iftes of Guernfey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sank, of Man, from any Place to infeded, or from any Place the Inhabitants whereof are known to trade of correspond with any Country of Place adually infeded, of from any Place from whence his Wajeffy, Dis beirs of Successors, by and with the Advice of Dis of Their Privy Council, thall judge it probable that the Infediou may be brought, thill be obliged to make their Quarentine in fuch Place and Places. for fuch Time, and in fuch Manner, as bath been or mall. from time to time, be birefted by Dis Baleffp, Dis Detrs of Successors, by Dis of Their Diber of Divers made in Dis of Their Privy Council, and notified by Proclamation; and that until fuch Ships, Meffils, Perfons, Cods, and Merchandizes, thail have respedively performed, and be bifchar. ged from such Quarentine, no such Persons, Goos, 02 Merchandizes, or any of them, hall come or be brought on Shore, or go or be put on board any other Ship or Geffel in any Place within Dis Majesties Dominions, unless in such Cafes, and by fuch proper Licence, as thall be bireffed or permitted by luch Dider of Diders made by Dis Wafeffy, Dis beirs of Succestors, in Council, and notified, as aforefaid; and that all luch Ships and Cleffels, and the Persons and Sods coming of imported in, of going of being put on board the fame, and all Ships, Cleffels, Boats, and Perfons re. ceiving any Goods or Persons out of the same, chall be subjett to luch Divers, Rules, and Directions concerning Quarentine, and the Prevention of Infection, as have been or hall be made by his Pajetty, his beirs and Successors, in Council, and notified by Broclamations, as aforefato.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforelaid, That during the prefent Infedion, and at all Cimes hereafter, when any foreign Country, or any Part of Great Britain or Ireland hall be infeded with the Plague, It hall and may be lawful to and for any Two Juffices of the Peace of any County, Riding, Division, of Liberty, next to fuch Place where any Ship of Actel Gall be performing Quarentine, or wherein any infested Place, or any Doule, Lagaret, or Place for Performance of Quarentine, Gall be Cituate, or any Lines or Trenches hall be made, as afozelaid, and they are hereby required, from time to time, when any fuch Cown oz Place hall be infeded with the Plague, or any Lines or Trenches thall be made, as aforclato, or any Perfons, Ships. Sodg, or Merchandizes infeded, or obliged to perform Quarentine, thall be put in any Doule, Lagaret, og other Place for Performance of Quarentine, to order the Inhabitants of fuch and to many Parithes, Townships, Uills, or Extraparochial Places about the same respectively, as they that judge necessary; and such Inhabitants are hereby required, in pursuance of luch Dibers, upon Dotice thereof, to keep fufficient Watches by Day and Might upon luch Town or Place fo infeded, and upon luch Lines and Trenches made, as afore. faid, and upon fuch Doufes, Lagarets, Ships, or other Places for Derformance of Quarentine, for luch Time, in luch Banner, and with fuch Mumbers of Matchmen at every Place, as the

And it is hereby further Enacted, That if any Officer or Officers of Dis Majesties Customs, or any other Officer or Officers, Person or Persons whatsoever, to whom it doth or thall appertain to execute any Dider of Diders made of to be made concerning Quarentine, and the Prevention of Infedion, and notified, as aforefaid, or to fee the fame but in Execution, hall be guilty of any wilful Breach or Megled of his or their Duty in that Behalf, every fuch Officer and Derfon to offending thall forfeit his Office or Employment in the Customs, or other Office or Employment, and shall become from thenceforth uncapable to hold and enjoy the fame, or to take a new Grant thereof, and thall also forfeit the Sum of One hundred Pounds; One Doiety thereof to the King, Dis beirs and Successors, and the other Molety to him or them, who thall or will fue for the fame, by Adion, Will, Plaint, of Information, in any of Dis Bajeffies Courts of Record at Westminster, Edinburgh, or Dublin, or in the proper Courts of the Isles of Guernsey, Jersey, Alderney, Sark, 02 Man refpetively.

And whereas Cotton, Sking, and human bair, and certain other Species of Goods and Werchandizes, are more especially liable to retain Infection, and may be brought from Dlaces infeded into other Countries, and from thence imported into Dis Wafesties Dominions in Ships not obliged to perform Quarentine; Be it Enafted by the Authority afozelaid, That during the prefent Infection, and in all future Times, when any foreign Country of Place hall be infeded with the Plague, all fuch Goods and Merchandizes as are or hall be particularly specified for that Purpose, in any Dider or Diders made or to be made concerning Quarentine, and the Prevention of Infedion, and notified, as aforesaid, imported into any Part of Dis Baiesties Dominions from any Foreign Country or Place in any Ship or Wellel whatfoever, thall be fubjed and liable to fuch Diber or Diders made of to be made concerning Quarentine, and the Prevention of Infection, and notified, as aforefaid.

Wares, and Merchandizes infeded, as aforefaid. or so much thereof as shall be necessary for preventing the
