HEREAS by an Act paffed in the laft Seffion of Parliament, intituled, "An Act to enable His Majefty to "make Rules, Orders, and Regula-"tions, more effectually to prevent the "fpreading of the Diftemper which "now rages amongit the Horned Cat-"tle in this Kingdom;" Powers are vefted in His Majefty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, from time to time to make fuch Rules, Orders, and Regulations, or to vary and

repeal the fame, as fhould be judged most expedient and effectual for putting a Stop to, or preventing the spreading of the A 2 faid faid Diftemper : And whereas in purfuance of the faid Powers, His Majefty was pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, on the Twelfth Day of *March* laft, as likewife on the Seventeenth Day of *December* laft, to make feveral Rules, Orders, and Regulations, for the faid Purpofes : And whereas Application hath been this Day made to His Majefty at this Board, to make fome Variations from, and Additions to the aforementioned Orders of Council, His Majefty, upon Confideration thereof, is pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to make the Variations and Additions following, viz.

First, That no Ox, Bull, Cow, Calf, Steer, or Heifer, whether Fat or Lean, be fuffered to pass the Humber and Trent Northward, from the Nineteenth of this Instant January, to the Twenty feventh Day of March next. And for that Purpose, His Majesty's Justices of the Peace of the several Counties, Hundreds, Ridings, and Divisions, through which the said Rivers run, are hereby required to cause strict Watch to be constantly kept to guard all the Bridges, Fords, Boats, and Ferries, upon the said Rivers, and to carry all Offenders herein before the next Magistrate, to be dealt with according to Law.

Secondly, That in all Cafes, where Lean Cattle shall be put out to Pafture, (whether the faid Pafture do belong to the Owner of fuch Cattle, or be hired by him) and that fuch Pafture shall not be found fufficient to feed the Cattle put therein, Liberty be given to the Owners of fuch Cattle to remove them to lome other Patture in the Neighbourhood, though it should happen to lie in a different Parish : But that this Liberty be granted only for fuch Cattle as are in Health, and free from any Diffemper; and that a Certificate of their being fo, must be obtained before their Removal, in like Manner as is required by His Majelly's aforementioned Order of Council of the Seventeenth of December laft, to be obtained upon the driving, or removing, and felling Fatted Cows and Oxen; and that fuch Certificate be delivered to One of the Churchwardens, Overfeers of the Poor, or Conftables, of the Town or Parish to which fuch Beatts shall be to removed, or to fome Inspector appointed by the Juffices of the Peace.

Thirdly, That the Prohibition laid by His Majefty's aforementioned Order of Council, of the Seventeenth of December laft, upon the Removal and Sale of Calves, be taken off from all Fatted Calves, provided they are found and free from any Diftemper, and that Proof thereof be made and certified in the fame Manner and 4 Form, as is required by the aforementioned Order with refpect to Fatted Cows and Oxen. and only to apply all the brane

Fourthly, That in all Cafes where the Churchwardens, Overfeers of the Poor, Constables, and Infpectors, or fome or One of them, thall ftop any Cattle, which by His Majefty's Order in Council, of the Seventeenth of December laft, are prohibited to be removed, and thall carry the Offender or Offenders before fome Juffice or Juffices of the Peace, purfuant to the Directions of the faid Order; fuch Churchwardens and other Officers, or fome or One of them, are hereby authorized, during the Time that fuch Offender or Offenders Ihall be under Examination of fuch Juffice or Juffices, to put the faid Cattle under the Care of fome proper Perfon : And in cafe it fhall appear to the faid Juffice or Juffices, that the faid Cattle are fuch as are prohibited to be removed, by His Majefty's aforementioned Order, and not allowed of by this prefent Order, and are not infected, that then he or they do caufe the faid Cattle to be drove back the fame Way, to the Place or Grounds from whence they were brought, with fome proper. Officer to attend them; or take fuch Order concerning the faid Cattle, as fuch Juffice or Juffices shall judge most proper, according to the Circumstances of the Cafe.

Fiftbly, That inftead of requiring the Oaths of Two Constables, Churchwardens, Overfeers, or Infpectors, to afcertain the Numbers and Values of the Cattle fhot, or otherwife killed flashed and buried, and the having conformed to all the Rules laid down, as directed by His Majefty's Order of Council of the Twelfth of March laft to entitle the Owner or Owners of any fuch Cattle to the Rewards or Recompence thereby promifed; the Oath of One of those Officers shall, for the future be fufficient, where Two of them cannot be had : But in all fuch Cafes, the Owner or Owners of the Cattle shall call One other credible Perfon to be a joint Witnefs with fuch Officer, who is hereby required to make the like Oath, as is directed by the aforementioned Order to be made by the faid Constables, Churchwardens, and others. And His Majefty doth hereby declare, That the Rewards or Recompence promifed by His Majesty's aforementioned Order, shall be thereupon paid to the Owners of the faid Cattle, in the fame Manner, as if the Oaths of Two of the faid Officers had been taken; provided the Magistrate (or in his Absence the Minister of the Parish) who shall take the faid Oaths, do certify as to the Credibility of the faid Perfon.

And

And His Majefty doth hereby firstly charge and command all His Juffices of the Peace, Conflables, Churchwardens, Overfeers, Infpectors, and all Farmers, Cowkeepers, and others, to conform themfelves to what is hereby required; any thing contained, in His Majefty's Orders of Council aforementioned, to the contrary notwithftanding.

And for the better notifying of this Order, it is His Majefty's Pleafure, That the fame be forthwith printed and publifhed, and be also inferted in the next London Gazette; and be likewife read, together with the faid former Orders of Council, in all Parish Churches, Chapels, and other Places set apart for Divine Worship, in the Manner, and at the Times prescribed by the Act of Parliament aforementioned.
