That SAPOLIO did it there isn't a doubt

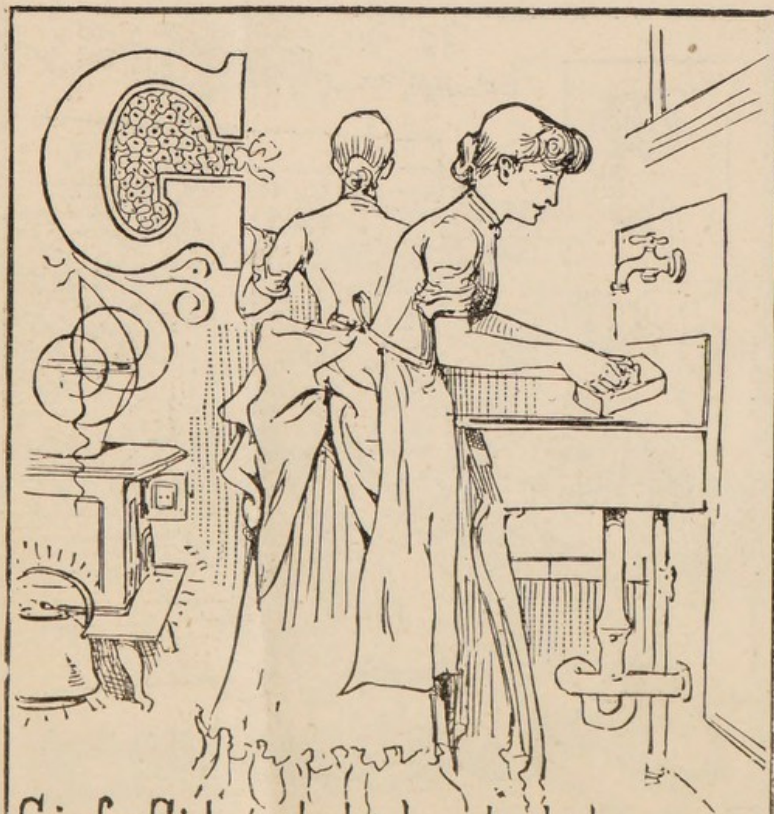
D, is for Dirt, which must vanish and die *

 SAPOLIO cleaned it without and within





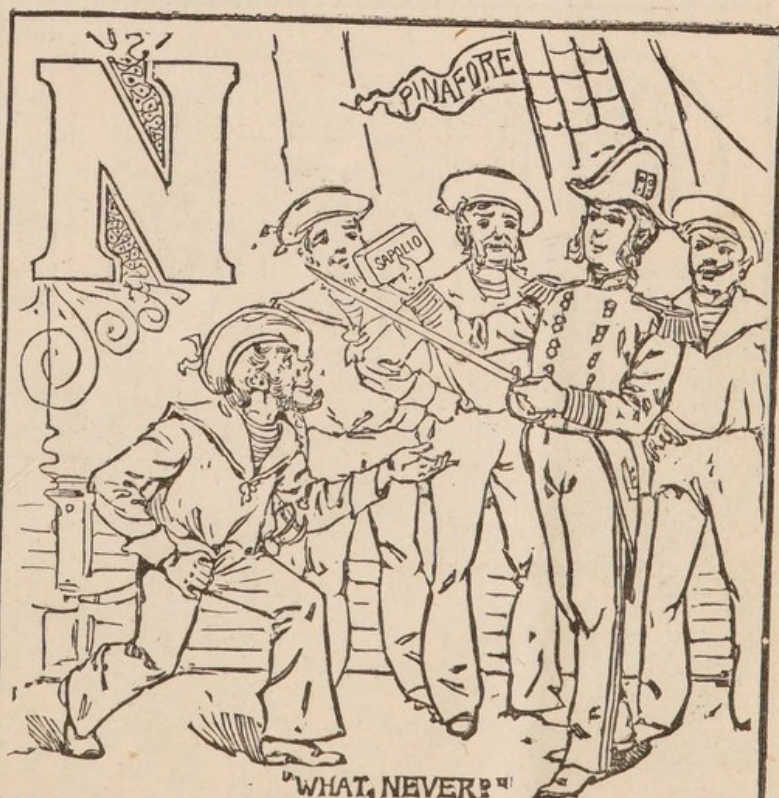
K, is for Knives or for Kettles of brass *

 SAPOLIO'S aid brings us leisure at last



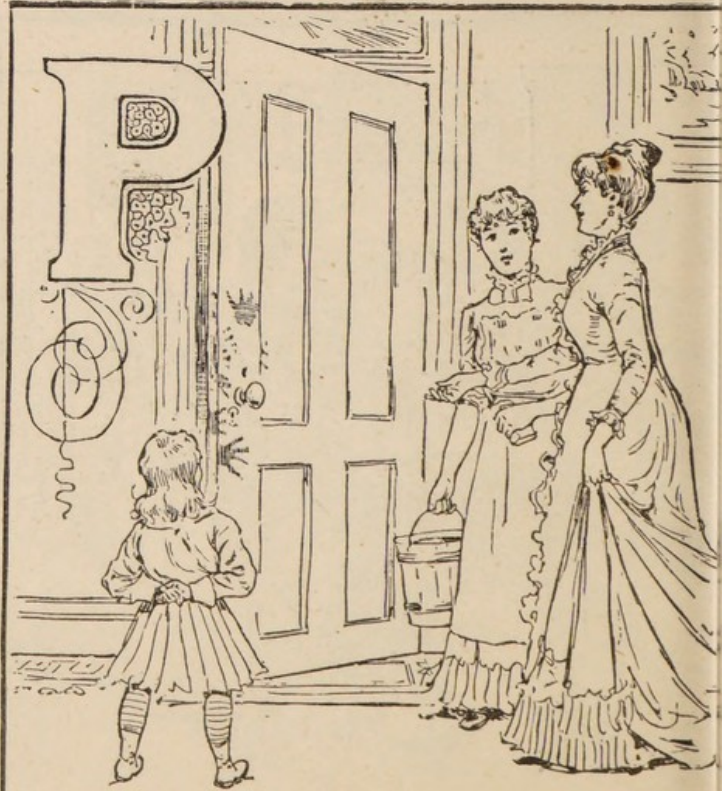
M, is for Marble now white as the snow *

Such a genuine home friend as SAPOLIO has grown



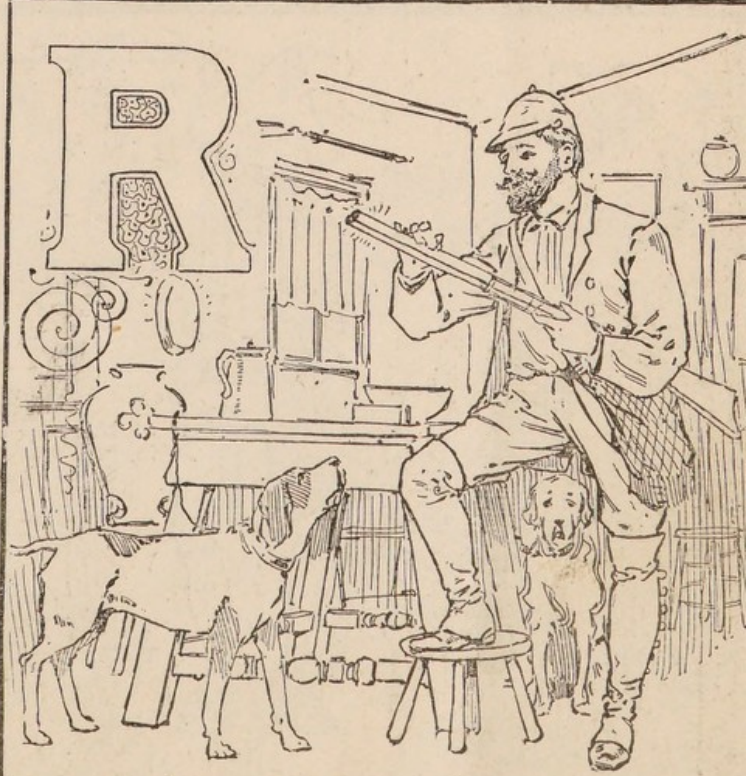
O, is for Oilcloth, indeed it is true *

 Made bright with SAPOLIO as a row of new pins



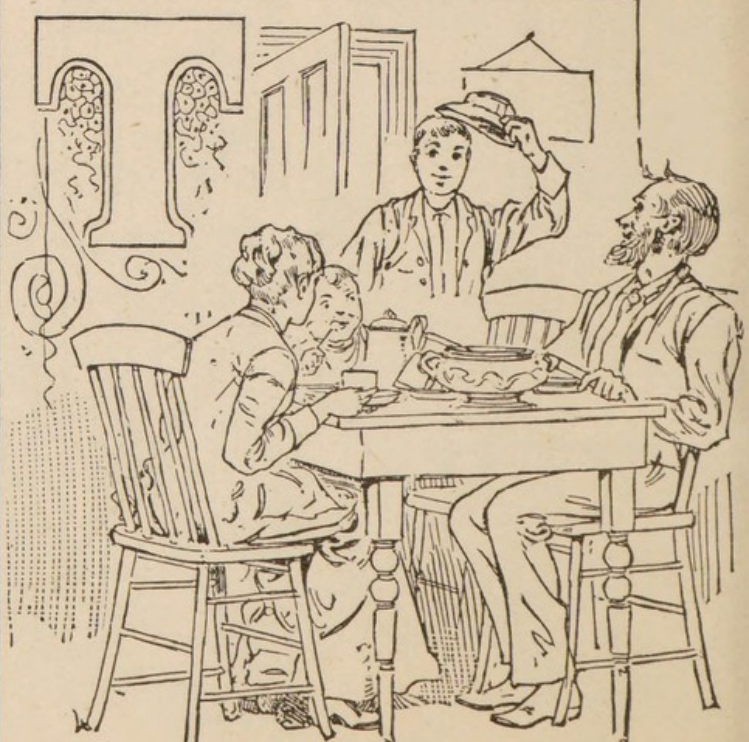
R. is for Rust, which settles to stay ✽

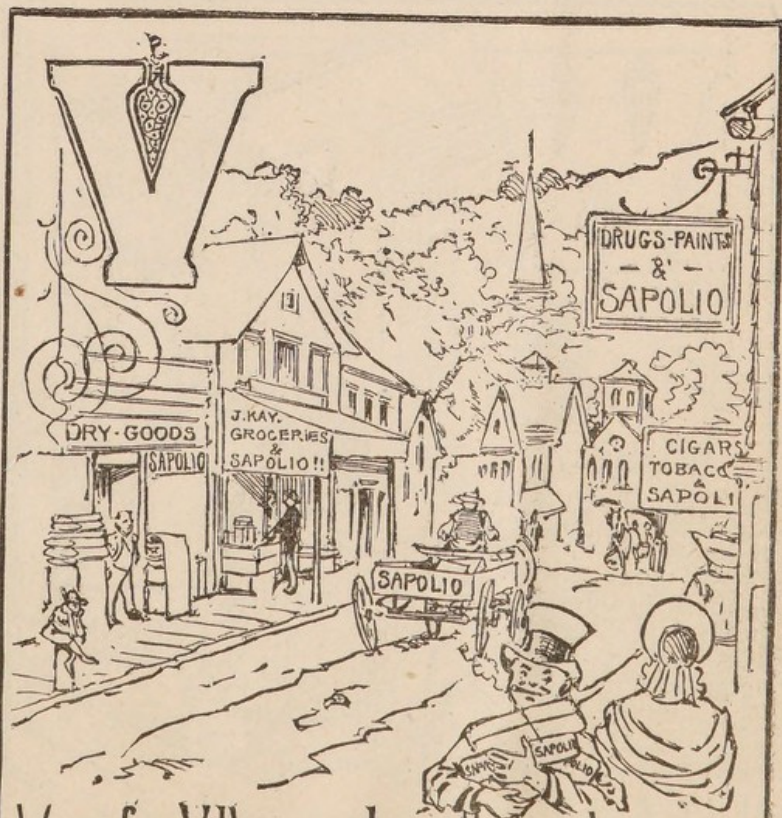

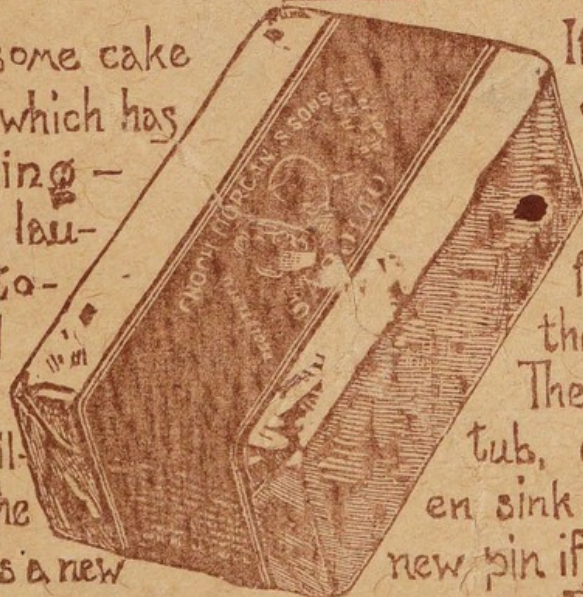
