At the inquest, which was held yesterday by Mr. Troutbeck, at the St. Martin's Vestry Hall, a doctor who had made a post-mortem examination said that the deceased suffered from heart disease. The stomach was full of undigested food. Deceased had only three teeth, and was unable to mastically and the undigested food had pressed upon the heart. Artificial teeth "might have saved his life." The jury returned a versite of death from heart disease.
