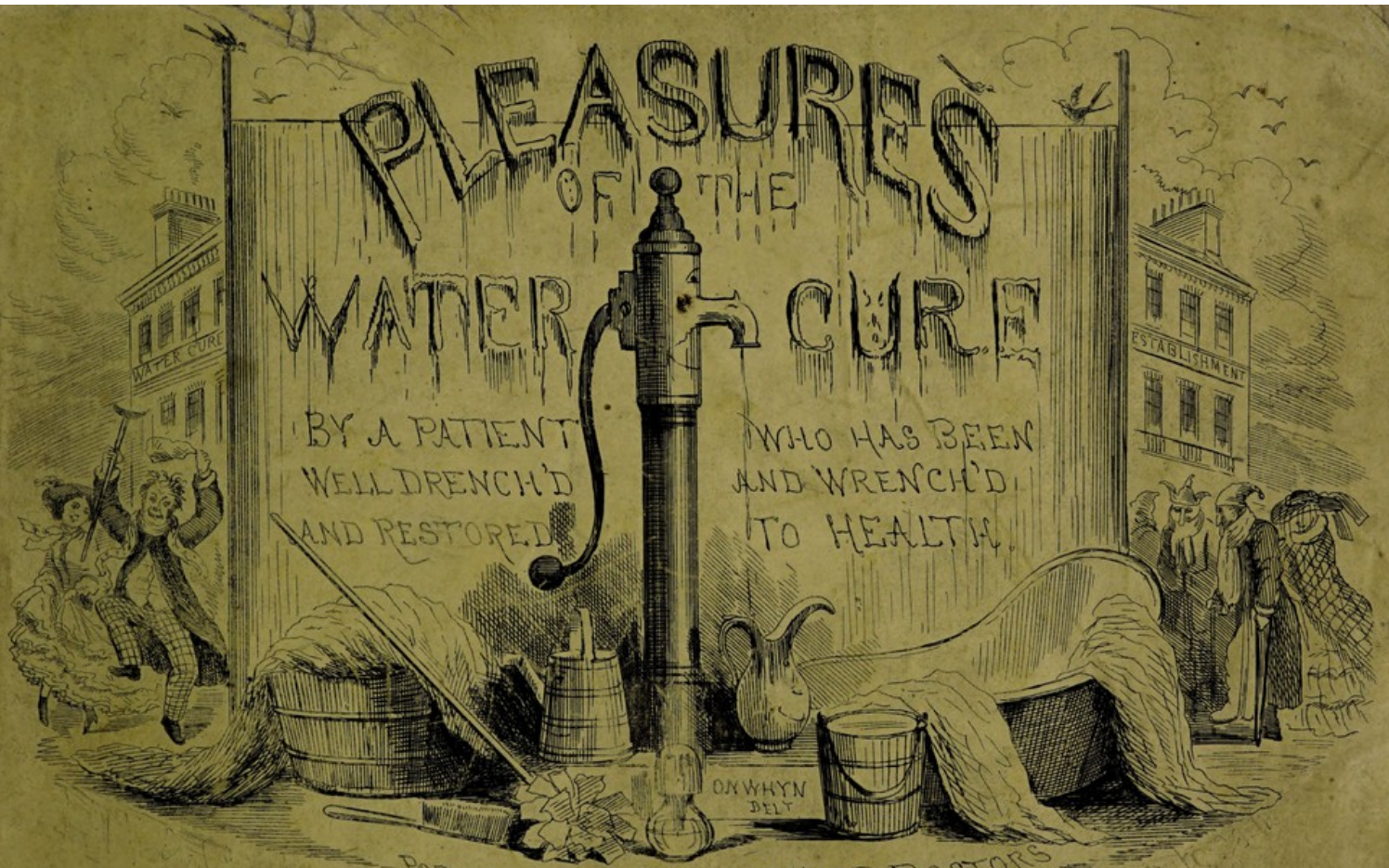

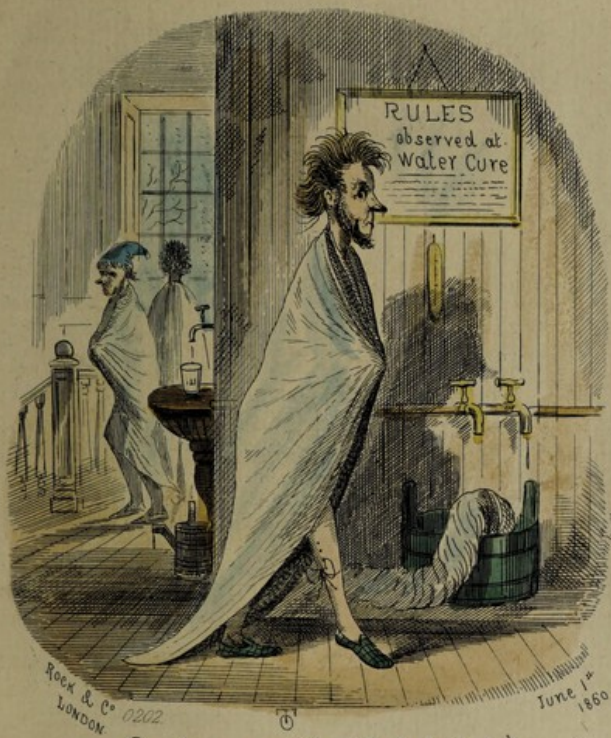
First morning at the Water Cure.

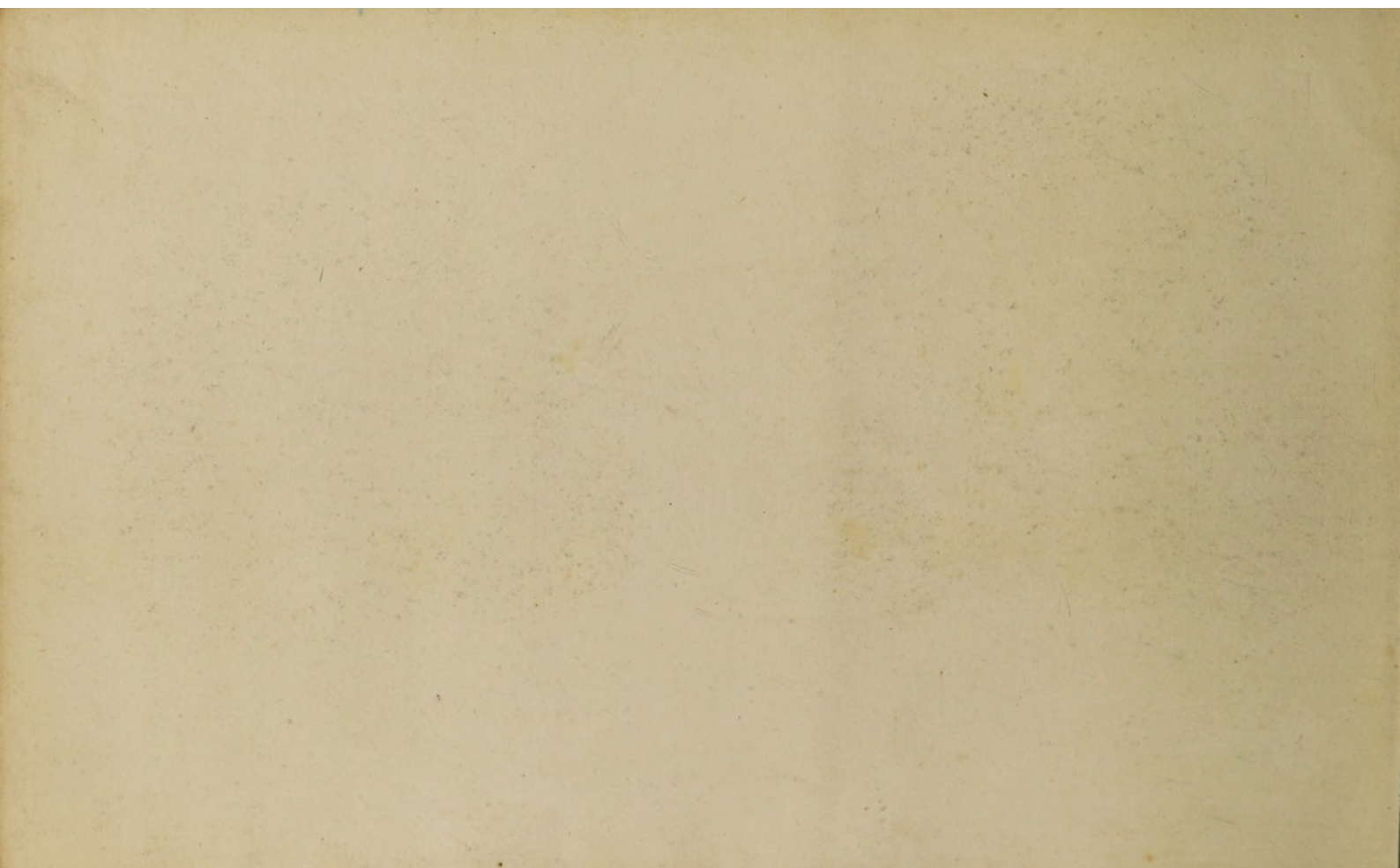

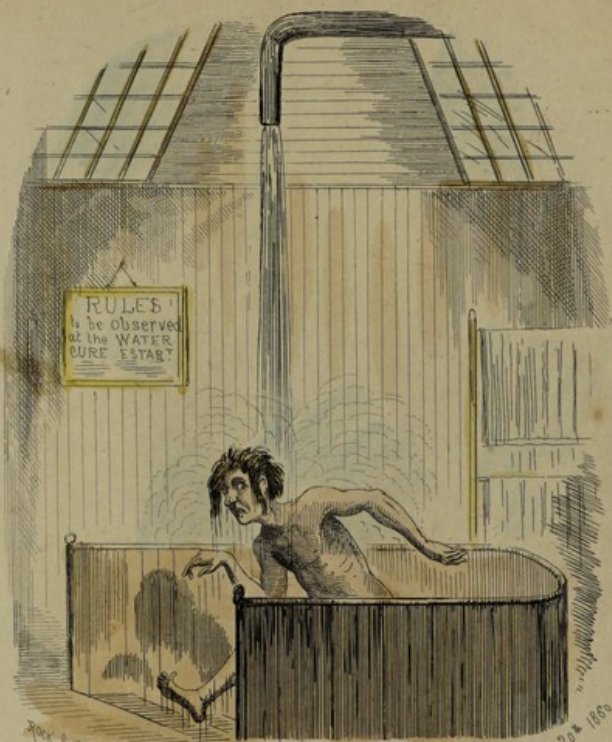






THE RAIN BATH.
