CONDITIONS OF SALE.

I.—The highest bidder, is in due time, to be the purchaser. If any dispute arise between two or more bidders, the lot so disputed shall, at the decision of the Auctioneer, be put up again and re-sold, which shall be a final settlement of any disputed lot. The Auctioneer reserves to himself the right to refuse the bidding of any person he pleases.
