CONDITIONS OF SALE.

I.—The highest bidder, if in due time, to be the purchaser. If any dispute arise between two or more bidders, the lot so disputed shall, at the decision of the Auctioneer, be put up again and re-sold, which shall be a final settlement of any disputed lot. The Auctioneer reserves to himself the right to refuse the bidding of any person he pleases.

II.—No person to advance less than One Shilling ; above Two Pounds, Two Shillings and Sixpence ; and so on in proportion ; and no person shall withdraw a bidding once made.

III.—The purchasers to give in their names and places of abode, if required, and to deposit Five Shillings in the pound, in part payment of the purchase-money, such deposit not to be considered as a deposit on a single lot only, but to be applicable to all lots purchased by the same buyer.

IV.—Each lot at the fall of the hammer, shall be considered as delivered to the purchaser, who must thereafter take all risk and responsibility until cleared. 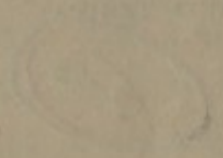
