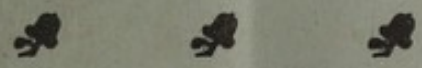

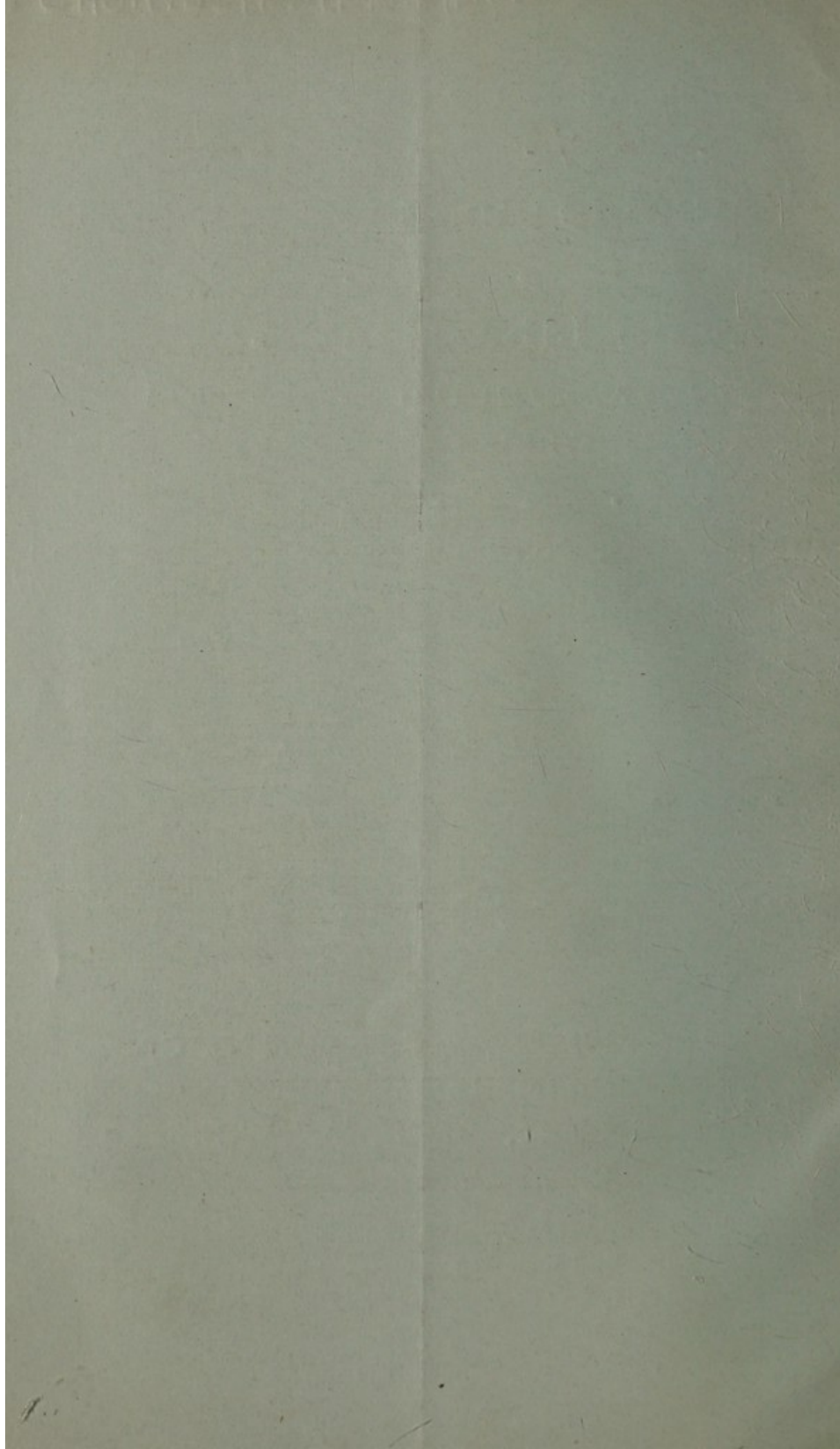

III.—All lots are offered subject to the right to sell at a reserve price, and subject also to the right of the vendor or the auctioneer to bid in respect of such reserve. The auctioneers reserve the right to offer any lots in this Catalogue as one lot.

IV.—The purchasers to give in their names and places of residence (if required), and pay down a deposit of 30 per cent in part payment of the purchase-money, in default of which the lot or lots so purchased will be immediately put up again and resold.

V.—The lots to be taken away at the purchaser's expense within two days after the sale ; in default of which Messrs. HODGSON & Co. will not hold themselves responsible for any lots lost or damaged, but they will be left at the sole risk of the purchaser.
