The Auctioneers reserve the right of refusing any bidding or of withdrawing any lot or lots from the sale.

VII.—To prevent inaccuracy in delivery, and inconvenience in the settlement of the purchases, no lot can be transferred nor can any lot be removed during the time of sale, and the remainder of the purchase-money must absolutely be paid on the delivery. After one week from date of sale, interest at bank rate will become payable on uncleared goods from date of purchase to time of clearance or re-sale.
