In cases where a buyer purchases more than one lot the whole must be paid for before any one lot is delivered.
6. Any Purchaser neglecting to pay for and take away any lot or lots purchased within one day after the sale (not having been re-sold in accordance with the seventh condition) shall pay, in addition to the purchase-money, the sum of one shilling per week for warehouse-room, and also at the rate of five per cent. per annum interest on the purchase-money, to be reckoned from this day.

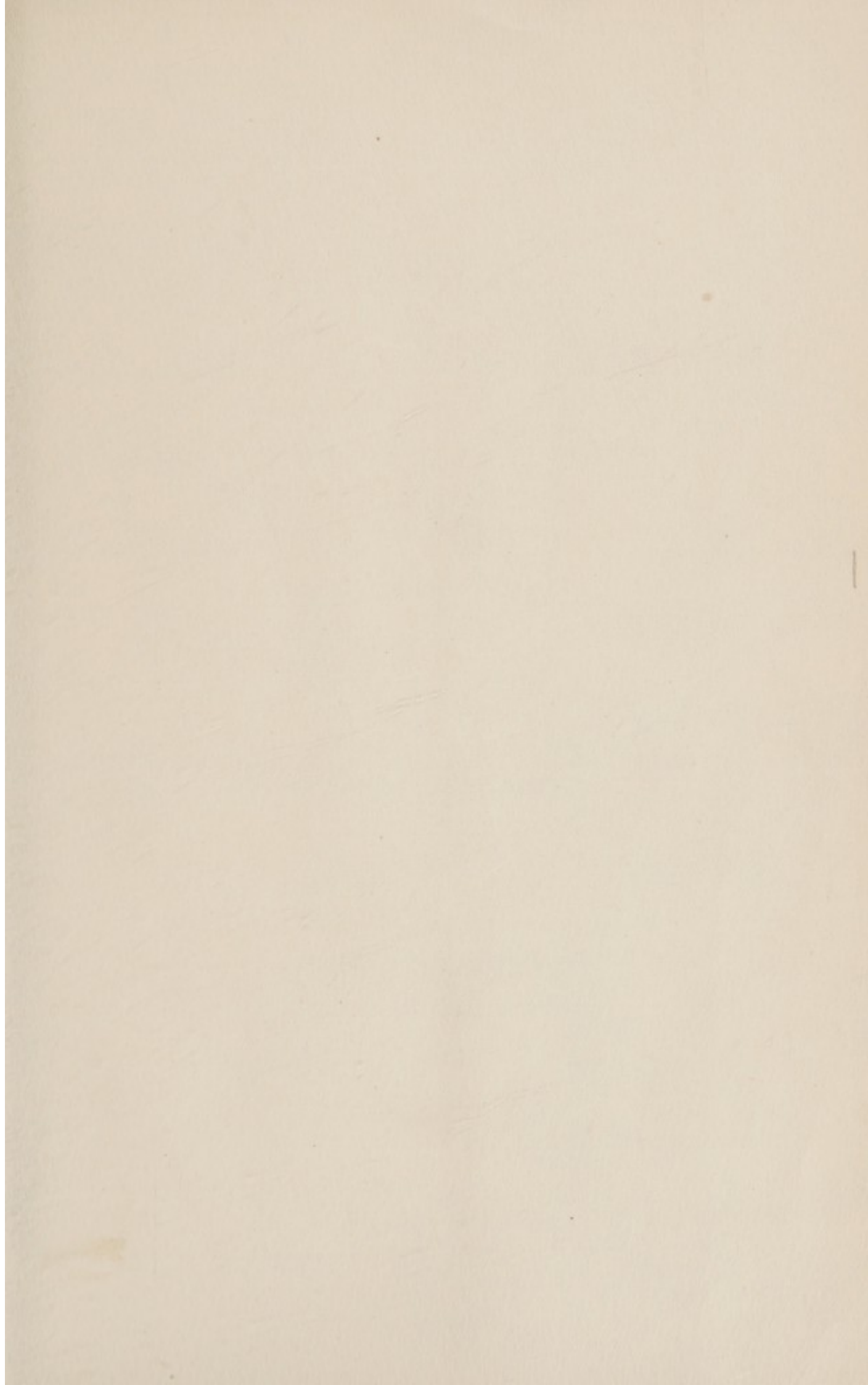
