4. The Purchaser to give his name and address, and to pay a deposit of five shillings in the pound, or more, or the whole of the purchase-money, if required.
5. The lots to be taken away and paid for, with all faults, imperfections and errors of description, at the Purchaser's risk and expense the day after the sale, W. E. In cases where a buyer purchases more than one lot the whole must be paid for before any one lot is delivered.
6.
