INTRODUCTION.

A LTHOUGH it is univerfally agreed that the Public have reaped some advantages by the Acts of the 4th Geo. II. c. 26. and 6th Geo. II. c. 14. requiring all Law-Pleadings, Deeds, &c. to be thereafter written in English; yet the Tax growing from those advantages is become so excessive, that few persons are now to be found capable of reading or explaining old Deeds and Charters, with any satisfaction to themselves or others.

This great inconvenience must have arisen from the Acts above mentioned; for, it being vainly imagined that after the paffing of those Acts, Court-Hand and Latin were unnecessary accomplishments for a Lawyer, young gentlemen were frequently articled to Attornies and Solicitors without the knowledge of either: and even called to the Bar without learning to read the Court-Hand, or the Abbreviations of it. The inconveniencies brought on by this neglect were in some measure salved pro tempore by Old Practitioners then living, who were in Business when the Law Pleadings were in Latin, and were familiar with the contractions: but time having gradually deprived the Law of those valuable Gentlemen of the profession, I believe it may with truth and modesty be affirmed, from the numerous applications that are made to me on that subject, that the Reading of the old Law-Hands is at this day very nearly (if not altogether) become obsolete, though useful. I make this declaration with some concern; for although it is not necessary, as the Law now stands, to write the Court

or any other of the old Law-Hands; yet, as Records written in those hands are daily produced in Evidence in the Courts of Law, the being able to read them with propriety and certainty cannot be an unnecessary accomplishment; not only for young Students, Stewards of Manors, and others, but also for the most dignified characters in the profession; as, in cases of Quo Warranto's and Election Business, Records and old Charters are almost constantly referred to: and he who best understands the Abbreviations, bids fairest for a true explanation of the matter in question. Gentlemen of liberal education and large property might perhaps not find it disadvantageous to be acquainted with old writings; as by that means they would be enabled to preferve the large Honours, Manors, Royalties, and Demesnes, descended to them from their Noble Ancestors, which are too often liable to be incroached upon by defigning men; and not be reduced to the necessity of taking upon trust the declarations of some of the profession, who call every old Deed useless because they do not understand it; though the old writing, treated with this amazing ignorance and temerity, may be a material Title Deed of a very antient and extensive Manor, or Lordship, or part thereof. Nor would the knowledge of the Old Hands, as I humbly conceive, be unacceptable to the learned Historian; who, when in fearch of materials to authenticate his productions, would be able (especially as the Law Contractions are well known to be in some degree in imitation of the old Monkish Writers) to examine his Copies with the Records themselves, and not depend intirely upon the Copying Clerk, who might, by an error in transcribing, lose the true meaning of the original; an event equally dangerous to truth, property, and to liberty itself.

Many young gentlemen of the Law, whose studies are much interrupted by large fortunes, and perhaps a natural gaiety of disposition, will, will, I make no doubt, in order to palliate their inattention to the know-ledge now contended for, fay, that numbers of the Records in the king-dom have been copied into the Works of many learned men, and therefore are as good evidence as the originals: In this I must beg leave to differ, and to remind the learned of the following Cases (amongst others), wherein Camden's Britannia, Sir William Dugdale's Baronage, and Monasticon, although valuable productions, were refused to be admitted as Evidence.

- 1. Camden's Britannia was offered in evidence to prove a particular Custom, but refused; for the Court was of opinion that a general History was not sufficient to prove a particular right or custom.
- 3. It being a question in the Exchequer, whether the Abbey de Sentibus was an inferior Abbey or not, Dugdale's Monasticon was produced for Evidence; and refused, because the original Records might have been had in the Augmentation Office. 1 Salkeld, 281. 7th Wm. Stainer and the Burgesses of Droitwich.—See also Skinner, 624.
- 4. On a trial at Bar for lands in Com. York upon Ejectment, the Lessor of the Plaintiss made out his Title under a gift in tail made by B 2

Richard the IId, to Robert de Clifford, and the heirs of his body; and in order to prove himself heir of the body of the said Robert, he produced a Pedigree by which the descent appeared: Sir William Dugdale and other Heralds, being sworn, declared, that the Pedigree had been deduced out of Records and ancient Books in the Heralds Office; but the Court would not allow that for evidence, without shewing the Records and Books from whence it had been extracted; and afterwards they produced an ancient book ending in the Year 1582, which was allowed for evidence, and confirmed the Pedigree. King against Foster. Sir Thomas Jones's Reports, so. 224.

From all which it may be reasonably concluded, that although the works of those great men are highly beneficial to consult in the first in-stance, yet, where there is a possibility of producing the original Record; the Court always requires the best evidence that the nature of the Case will admit: and therefore it is highly necessary that all Gentlement of the Law should be able to read them in their original state.

In order to obtain this end, and to avoid the prolixity and inconvenience that must attend the giving separate Tables or Plates for the Contractions of each particular Hand, I have pitched upon the Court-Hand and its Contractions, as the best and most difficult of the Old Law Hands; a perfect knowledge of which will, with a little application, soon gain absolute dominion over the rest.

The 1st and 2d Plates contain large Court-Hand Alphabets, with some Contractions; and in Plates 3d and 4th, will be found the Chancery-Hand, and small Court-Hand Alphabets, with specimens of both. The Alphabetical Contractions of the Court-Hand will be found in Plates 5th, 6th, and 7th; and Christian Names, as they have been usually

usually contracted, in Plates 8th and 9th; and such Words as were commonly contracted in old Charters, &c. Plates 10 to 15 inclusive. The Counties of England and Wales, and also the Bishops of England, in the manner they are usually written in old Records, in Plates 16th and 17th. And lastly, a General Alphabet, with Specimens of very antient Charters, Deeds, &c. Plates 18, 19, and 20. All which are collected from Manuscripts in my own possession, and the Contractions made as I really found them in the different originals from whence they are extracted. The reason of my troubling the Reader with a general Alphabet is, that many of the ancient Writings differ extremely from the Court and Chancery Hands. The different Characters are therefore placed in one view; and if the Letter in doubt cannot be found in the Alphabets of the Court and Chancery Hands, it is more than probable it may be found in the general Alphabet N° 18.

Let me here obviate some objections that may be made by Writing-Masters and others; that the intention of this Work is not to teach Gentlemen to write but to read the old Law-Hands with facility and accuracy, which is more likely to be obtained from seeing the Hands and Contractions, as they are really to be met with, than by giving specimens of Writing too sine to be either authentic or indeed practicable in the general run of law business.

But, notwithstanding I have done every thing in my power to make the way easy to such as may choose to favour this production with their attention, yet, after the Reader becomes acquainted with the following. Plates, he must use some industry of his own in practising the Reading of old Writings in various Characters; a single half-hour in the day dedicated to that purpose, with the assistance I now offer, will soon complete him, as he will bring with him a thorough knowledge at what Letter.

Letter or Syllable a contraction may be expected; for, though the old-Clerks who wrote well were strictly rigid in their abbreviations, yet there were others (as at this day) very incorrect, who, substituting ignorance in the room of learning and genius, boldly claimed a privilege of departing from all Rule and Order: Nothing therefore but application, and a desire for knowledge, can overcome their irregularities, or indeed make a man accomplished in any department of life, particularly in the Law.

The utility of the Appendix is fo very apparent, that it will be need-less to trouble the Reader much on that head, being exactly correspondent to that of the Tables and Plates. There was something partly on the plan of the Appendix formerly published, in which the names of places were confined to England only, and many of the alias dictums omitted; but, as in my own practice I have met with Records and Charters relating to the very antient Kingdom of Scotland, and also to Ireland, for the sake of more general use I have collected, from Camden, Hector Boëthius, Buchanan, Archbishop Usher, and other learned Antiquaries and Historians, as far as leisure would at present permit, the antient names of places in those Kingdoms; to which I have added an Alphabetical List of antient Surnames, which I have experienced to be very useful. In short, I have endeavoured as much as possible, that at the same time the young Student finds sufficient for his purpose, the learned Antiquary may not go away quite disgusted and distatissied.


When I first set down a list of the Law Contractions to assist me in my practice, I had not the least intention to make them public; but, it being intimated to me by a learned Gentleman of the Law that I ought



If this performance should meet with a favourable reception from the Public in general, or the Gentlemen of the Law, for whose use it was particularly designed, I shall then reap the fruits of many years close application; and have the heart-felt satisfaction that my labour has not been in vain: If otherwise, I shall still draw my consolation from this noble source of reslection, that my intentions were good, however I may have failed in the execution; and that Camden, Selden, Dugdale, Spelman, Lambart, the great Lord Coke, and many others, whose names will remain venerable to the latest posterity, did not, nor does the very learned Author of the Commentaries, treat this fort of knowledge with neglect.


