INTRODUCTION.

THIS Bill is intended to carry into Execution the Substance of the Plan proposed by the Resolutions of the House of Commons in the last Sessions, as far as it respects the Relief and Employment of the Poor.

The general Scope and Tendency of it, is, To make whole Counties, and alfo Ridings and Divifions, where they have feparate Commissions of the Peace and Quarter Sessions, and alfo all Cities and Towns which are Counties of themselves, contributory to the Relief and Employment of their Poor, by one General Fund arising from the Poors Rates, according to the Proportions in which they have been raifed within the several Parishes, Sc. on a Medium of the last Seven Years.

For the convenient Execution of this Plan, Perfons having £. 100. per Annum Estate in England, or £. 50. per Annum in Wales, are constituted Governors for the Counties, &c. where they refide.

The Plan is not to be adopted but in fuch Coun-A ties, ties, &c. where Two Thirds of the Governors, at a Meeting, after public Notice, shall approve of it.

If it be approved at fuch Meeting, the Governors prefent are to elect, by Ballot, a Committee of Nine Governors within fuch County, $\mathcal{C}c$. who are to divide the fame into fo many Diftricts as fhall be directed by the Act; but, in Counties where no fuch Direction fhall be given, into fo many Diftricts as the Committee fhall judge proper; and alfo to fix the Places where the Buildings are to be erected.

The Governors of each Diffrict are made a Corporation, and required at their First Meeting to elect by Ballot, a Committee of Eleven Governors, to be called *The Committee of Buildings and Rates*, who are to make the Contracts for the Lands, and to take the Care and Management of the Buildings and Furniture; and also to ascertain the Medium of the Poors Rates in each Parish, &c. for the last Seven Years; from which an Appeal is given to the Justices at their General Quarter Sessions.

The Governors of each Diftrict are also required at the fame Meeting, to elect by Ballot another Committee of Seven Governors, to be called *The Committee of Trade and Manufactures*; which Committee are to find proper Employment for the Poor, to provide neceffary Utenfils, Materials, and Instructors for that Purpose, and to superintend that very important Business.

Each of the faid Committees are to elect a Clerk to attend them, and are jointly to elect a proper Perfon to be Treafurer and Clerk to the Diffrict; they are alfo jointly to confult and agree upon the Plan for the Buildings. The

The Expence of the Purchafe of Lands, Buildings, and Furniture, is limited not to exceed Two Years and an Half's Produce of the Poor's Rates within each Diftrict, according to fuch Medium Sum; and the Money is to be borrowed on a Mortgage of the Poors Rates within the Diftrict, to be made by the Governors at their Quarterly Meetings.

The Committee of Buildings and Rates are to draw upon the Treafurer, from Time to Time, as the Money for the above Purposes shall be wanted; which Drafts he is to pay, upon Orders from the Governors at their Quarterly Meetings.

The Interest of the Money borrowed is to be paid out of the Poors Rates; and \pounds . 5 per Centum per Annum of the Principal, after Two Years from the Time the Buildings shall be completed, if the Rates shall be sufficient for that and the other Purposes.

To be Four Quarterly Meetings of the Governors of each Diftrict, in the Weeks next preceding each Quarter Seffions, and that next preceding the *Michaelmas* Quarter Seffions is to be the Annual Meeting.

The Governors at their Quarterly Meetings are to certify to the Quarter Seffions, an Account of the Receipts and Difburfements for each Diftrict, within the preceding Quarter, and the Ballance in each Treafurer's Hands.

There are also to be Monthly and Weekly Meetings of the Governors within each District.

A certain

A certain Number of Governors, to be elected by Ballot, fhall be obliged to attend the Monthly Meetings.

Every Governor fo elected, who shall refuse or neglect to attend the Monthly Meetings, and every Governor elected upon any Committee, and not attending, shall incur a Penalty, unless excused on the Terms mentioned in the Bill.

The Governors are, at their First Meeting after the Buildings shall be completed, and at every Annual Meeting, to nominate Guardians within each Diftrict, who shall be Rectors, Vicars, or Curates, or Perfons having Estates of \pounds . 25 per Annum, or occupying Lands of \pounds . 50 per Annum; which Guardians are to inspect the Overseers Accounts before they are sent to the Governors, and to check any Errors or Irregularities in their Proceedings.

The Governors are alfo, at their faid Meetings, to elect by Ballot a Committee of Seven Governors, which shall be *The Committee of Trade and Manufactures*; and another Committee of the like Number, which is to nominate Officers for the House, and to fill up Vacancies when they happen.

The Juffices at their Quarter Seffions, from the Time the Buildings shall be completed, are to order the Assessment to be equally made within each Parish, & according to the Medium Rate so to be assessment, with Liberty of Appeal to the Quarter Seffions by any Person aggrieved; and the Oversers of the Poor are to make and collect such Assessess and pay the Money to the Treasurer of the District.

Medium Sums first fixed, till it shall appear from the Accounts returned to the Quarter Sessions that a Reduction may be afforded, and then the Justices are to direct a Meeting of Governors from each District to confult about it, and to fix the proposed Reductions; which shall be observed in all surre Affessments, till further Alterations shall be found necessary.

After a Reduction of the Affefiments shall be made, if the Inhabitants of any Parish or Place shall make it appear, on Appeal to the Court of Quarter Sessions, that the Medium Sums so first afcertained exceeded 4 s. in the Pound of the full Annual Value of their Lands, $\mathcal{C}c$. the Court may reduce them to that Rate.

After the Buildings shall be completed, the Governors are to order the Poor into the House, and to see that they are properly accommodated, and that the Rules, Orders, and Regulations, are duly observed and enforced. The Children are to be placed out Apprentice when of proper Age.

The Governors of every Diftrict are, at their Annual Meetings, to return to the Two Houfes of Parliament, a State of the Proceedings, in the Form prefcribed by the Bill.

A Committee of Governors from each Diftrict are to meet Annually in every County, to confult about the State of their Affairs, and the further Execution of the Act.

To prevent Difputes amongst the Governors about the Rules and Orders to be observed in the Government

ment of each House, they are intended to be established with Certainty, and inferted in a Schedule to the Bill, and not to be varied but by Parliament.

An Eftablishment is made for Charitable Donations, 'to be employed in giving Portions on the Marriage of young Men or Women, who have been educated in any of these Houses, and have behaved well; and a Committee is to be elected by Ballot, to have the Care and Management of this Charity.

There are Claufes to fix the Settlements of the Poor, within Counties, Diftricts, and Places incorporated under this, or any other Act of Parliament, where they have refided Twelve Months without being chargeable; in order to prevent their being harraffed by frequent Removals,—and to avoid Litigations.

I know this Bill has many Defects, and ftands in Need of much Alteration and Amendment; but the Speaker, and many Members, of the Houfe of Commons, to whom it has been communicated, have been pleafed to give their Sanction and Countenance to it, and to recommend the printing and diffributing it amongft the Members, as the beft Means of having it maturely confidered, and improved by proper Amendments, before it fhall be prefented to the Houfe.

It is hoped the Introduction of Select Committees, and Monthly Meetings, for transacting the material Bufiness, and enforcing the Attendances upon them by Penalties, will remove many Objections, and render this very extensive Plan practicable, without laying too great a Burden on any Individual.

It has been my Study, in forming this Bill, to guard it, as much as possible, against all Frauds and Abuses whatfoever in the Execution of it; to have the Poor well accommodated, and treated with great Humanity, but kept under a strict Conformity to the Rules and Orders of the Houfe; to encourage good Behaviour, Sobriety, and Industry, by proper Rewards, and to find fuitable and proper Employment, under prudent and careful Inspection, for all who are able to work; to eafe the Magistrate in the more trivial Parts of his Duty, but to call forth his Affiftance and Support, his Authority and Dignity, in the more effential Parts of it; to reftrain the Overfeers from any Extravagance or Partiality; and alfo to make the Bill as concife as the Nature of the Bufinefs, and the Courfe of legal Proceedings, will admit.

There are feveral Provisions necessary for completing this Work, which are not introduced into this Bill, (but fome of them may probably be thought fit Objects for it); viz.

- The Care, Prefervation, and Maintenance, of Baftard Children :
- The establishing proper Hospitals for Lunatics ; which may be done at the joint Expence of Four or Five adjacent Counties :
- The Enquiries into, and Application of, particular Charities, which are given to the Poor of certain Parishes or Places; as those Poor will be relieved under the general Provisions of this Bill.

Alfo the Bill for explaining and amending the Act,

Act, paffed in the 17th of King George the Second, relating to Rogues, Vagabonds, and other idle and diforderly Perfons, and to Houses of Correction.

The Rules, Orders, and Regulations, for the Government of the Houfes of Industry, are not yet prepared; the Substance of them will be collected from the Returns made by the feveral Houfes of Industry, and will require much Confideration in fettling; but they, together with the Forms of Proceeding, and an Abstract of the Returns, made pursuant to the Orders of the House of Commons concerning the Poor, and also concerning Vagrants and Houses of Correction, are intended to be printed as an Appendix to this, and distributed as soon as conveniently may be.
